Syracuse Mets News and Notes

Turning It Around: Since May 24th, the Syracuse Mets rank seventh in the 20-team International League with a .260 batting average and rank second with 156 runs scored in 25 games. From the beginning of the season to May 23rd, the Mets were last in the league with a .205 batting average and ranked second to last with 154 runs scored in 40 games.

Giveaways: Syracuse leads the International League with 79 errors this season. Indianapolis and Norfolk are tied for second with 69. The Mets have allowed the third-most unearned runs in the League with 51 of 364 total runs allowed being unearned. Indianapolis leads the lead with 62 unearned runs allowed out of 321 total runs.

Streaking: Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 24 of his last 28 games, including hits in 21 of 28. During his last 28 games, Blankenhorn is hitting .301 (31-for-103) with 15 RBIs, three home runs, eight doubles, eight walks, 27 strikeouts, and a .357 on-base percentage.

From the beginning of the season to May 11th, Blankenhorn hit .167 with 12 RBI, 4 homers, three doubles, four walks, 28 strikeouts, and a .216 on-base percentage.

Power Surge: Since May 2nd, **Mark Vientos** is hitting .308 (32 for-104), with 23 RBIs, ten home runs, three doubles, 11 walks and a .385 on-base percentage in 26 games. Vientos was on Syracuse's 7-day Injured List from June 3rd until he was activated on June 12th, hitting four home runs in his first three games back.

From the beginning of the season to May 1st, Vientos was hitting .164 (9-for-55) with seven RBIs, a home run, four doubles, a triple, nine walks, 22 strikeouts, and a .288 on-base percentage in 18 games.

Do the Palka: Since reaching a season-low batting average of .205 on May 28th, **Daniel Palka** has reached base in 20 consecutive games. During this stretch, the 30-year-old is hitting .367 (29-for-79) with 20 RBIs, five home runs, six doubles, 16 runs scored, nine walks, 21 strikeouts, and a .432 on-base percentage.

From the beginning of the season to April 29th, Palka hit .288 (15for-52) with 20 RBIs, six home runs, five doubles, 13 runs scored, 11 walks, 12 strikeouts, and a .413 on-base percentage.

From April 30th to May 28th, Palka hit .150 (12-for-80) with seven RBIs, four home runs, ten runs scored, nine walks, 27 strikeouts, and a .236 on-base percentage.

Timelier Hitting: The Syracuse Mets are 14th in the league hitting with runners in scoring position out of 20 teams with a .245 batting average with runners at second and/or third. Syracuse has been trending better the last five series: Last week at Norfolk: 22-for-77 (.286) Two week vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre: 13-for-47 (.277) Three weeks ago at Worcester: 31-for-74 (.419) Four weeks ago vs. Rochester 10-for-41 (.244) Combined since May 24th: 76-for-239 (.318)


