FRISCO SHUTOUT FOR SECOND TIME THIS SEASON IN LOSS TO ARKANSAS:

The Frisco RoughRiders saw a three-game winning streak come to an end Thursday night as they fell to the Arkansas Travelers at Dickey-Stephens Park, 9-0. The RoughRiders were led offensively by catcher **Matt Whatley** with his sixth multi-hit night of the season, finishing 2-for-3 at the plate. The Travelers were powered by two home runs from designated hitter Joe Rizzo, who leads the Texas League with nine home runs this month. Frisco (34-32) starter **Cody Bradford** gave up seven runs on eight hits in his 4.2 innings of work before departing the fifth inning. Bradford (5-4) entered the fifth with only two runs in on three hits given up before Arkansas brought in five runs on five hits in the fifth. Rough Riders reliever Seth Nordlin relieved Bradford for the final out in the fifth and threw two innings after, giving up two runs on two hits in the sixth before a scoreless seventh. **Nick Starr** made his second appearance of the week with his lone inning of work in the eighth in Thursday's game, striking out a batter. Travelers (35-31) starter Taylor Dollard (6-2) tied a season high with 7.1 shutout innings at Dickey-Stephens Park Thursday night, giving up four hits and striking out three. Arkansas reliever David Ellingson threw the final 1.2 innings and didn't allow a run on a hit and walk down the stretch. RoughRiders second baseman **Justin Foscue** recorded his 16th double of the season to try and begin a scoring push in the top of the ninth, his third double in his last four nights.

PLAYOFFS? YOU WANT TO TALK ABOUT PLAYOFFS?

The Riders loss on Thursday, Frisco is 2.0 games out from first in the South Division with three games remaining in the first half of the season. Frisco does not own the tie-breaker over San Antonio, who has played two fewer games than the Riders this season, so the Riders must jump San Antonio. The Frisco elimination number is now one, meaning that a San Antonio win or a Frisco loss would clinch a playoff spot for the Missions. Frisco has won five of its last seven games to pull close to the Missions, but over that same span, San Antonio is 4-3. June has made the biggest difference as San Antonio has gone 12-7 in June, while the Riders have gone just

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder Jonathan Ornelas has been on fire at the plate all season long, but recently, he has been even better. Over his last 10 games, Ornelas is hitting .381 (16-for-42)/.400/.595 with a double, a triple, two home runs, nine RBIs and four runs. This season, he leads the Riders with 26 multi-hit games and 13 games with three or more hits. Ornelas is leading all active hitters in Double-A with a .336 batting average while he is first in hits (82). His batting average is the 10th-best in the minors and he is sixth hits in MiLB.

Since coming back from the Injured List, **Jax Biggers** has been on fire for Frisco. Biggers had a 14-game hitting streak snapped on Wednesday, batting .362 (21-for-58)/.403/.466 with three doubles, a home run, four RBIs, eight runs, three walks and two stolen bases. Over his last 16 games, the former Arkansas Razorbacks infielder is hitting .344 (22-for-64)/.391/.438. Biggers played 91 games with Frisco in 2021, hitting .224/.287/.321 with 12 doubles, four home runs and 14 steals.

SENDIN' IN BRENNAN:

Riders pitcher Tim Brennan has been lights out since coming to the RoughRiders from Extended Spring Training. After joining the team in mid-May, Brennan is 1-1 with a 1.42 ERA over 19.0 innings. In his seven outings, including a start on Sunday, Brennan has allowed just three runs on 12 hits with 16 strikeouts and just three walks. Opponents are hitting just .179 against him while a ridiculously high 61.5 percent of balls put in play against him have been on the ground, leading to a .200 BABIP.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder Kellen Strahm started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Since May 27th, over his last 20 games, Strahm is hitting .406 (26-for-65)/.506/.563 with four doubles, two home runs, 12 walks, 13 runs and five RBIs. His .406 average since May 27th is the best in Minor League Baseball among qualifiers. In that stretch, Strahm has raised his average from .148 to .262 and his OPS from .528 to .763. In his last 26 games, he is batting .349/.451/.465/.916. Among those with at least 180 PA in the Texas League, Strahm is sixth in walk rate (16.6 percent).

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 4-19 when scoring three runs or fewer and 17-2 when allowing three runs or fewer.

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 66 games, Frisco has hit 91 long balls (1.3 per game) which is the second-most in the Texas League and 10th in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 190 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (topping 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). Out of their 66 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 46 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 2.0 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 20 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 8-12. **Blaine Crim**, Dustin Harris and Trey Hair are tied for the team lead while being tied for seventh in the league with 12 home runs.



-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com. He is listed as the No.1 prospect in the Rangers organization as well.

-Leiter dazzeled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen is a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
