#### **TUESDAY'S RECAP**

The Chesapeake Baysox fell 6-1 to the Erie SeaWolves on Tuesday night. **Max Wagner** tallied a pair of hits, while **Reed Trimble** tripled and scored on a sac fly from **Doug Hodo**. Erie scored all their runs in the first three innings. The Baysox got five shutout innings from their bullpen on Tuesday, including two in a team season debut for **Kyle Virbitsky**.

#### LEADING THE WAY AS OF LATE

**Anthony Servideo** leads the team with a .811 OPS this month. On the mound, right-hander **Gerald Ogando** has allowed just one earned run over his last seven outings (0.93 ERA)

#### LEAVE THE RETZ TO ADAM

C/1B **Adam Retzbach** is having a career year with the Baysox. Retzbach currently has career-highs in average (.260), OBP (.367), slugging (.447) and OPS (.814). Additionally, he is one home run away from matching a career-high from last season, in 36 fewer games played. This past week, Retzbach homered three times in four games for the first time in his professional career. Sunday was the fourth-career three-hit game for Retzbach, matching a career-high.

#### **READY TO 'RIQUE HAVOC**

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** has reached base in 23 of 28 games played to start the season after missing 32 games from April 11 - May 19 due to a left hamstring injury. The Orioles No. 2 prospect posted the highest OBP (.542) of any Eastern League player with at least 20 plate appearances this past week. Bradfield drew the most walks (8) and tallied the second-most stolen bases (5) in Double-A this past week.

#### THEY'RE JUST TRAVELLERS

The Baysox have been particularly strong on the road in 2025. Chesapeake has posted a record of 19-13 on its travels this season. The Baysox have won three-consecutive series on the road and have won five of six road series they have played so far this season.

#### **ONE RUN WONDERS**

Chesapeake has won 15 one-run games this season - which is tied for most in the Eastern League (Binghamton). The Baysox have played 27 one-run games this season, which is tied for the most in full-season MiLB (Reading).

#### **BULLPEN BEASTS**

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.79 ERA, which is third-best in Double-A and fifth-best in full-season MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 328 hitters, which is third-most in all of Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

#### SCOUTING THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie SeaWolves - Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers - enter Wednesday with a 42-22 record. The two-time defending Eastern League champions currently hold a half-game lead over Akron for the first-half title in the Southwest division, with each team having six games remaining in the first half. Erie's roster includes nine of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB.com - C/1B Thayron Liranzo (5), LHP Jaden Hamm (7), LHP Jake Miller (15), RHP Joseph Montalvo (17), OF Roberto Campos (20), OF Justic Bigbie (25), RHP RJ Petit (28), and RHP Yosber Sanchez (30).

#### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Jaden Hamm is this afternoon's projected starter for Erie. Hamm is currently the No. 7 Tigers prospect, per MLB.com and the top-ranked Detroit pitching prospect by the outlet. He has not pitched deeper than five innings in an outing in his first season at Double-A. He faced the Baysox in April, allowing a pair of runs on five hits through four frames. Hamm was a fifth round pick of the Tigers in 2023 out of Middle Tennessee State.

2025: Has gone five innings in six of his 11 starts this year. Went five innings in only four outings total last year. Holds a 8.22 ERA in four career starts against Erie. Baysox are 5-6 when Long starts. Posted a 5.87 ERA in month of May in 23 IP. Has been better on the road (3.76 ERA) than at home (5.56 ERA). Recorded a 2.41 ERA in 18.2 IP with 16 K over just 3 BB in April. First scoreless start of season with 5.0 IP on 4/15 @ RIC. Enters third season with Chesapeake.

2024: Spent most of the season in Double-A Bowie with a one-game stint in Triple-A Norfolk. Split time as a starter (14 starts) and as a tandem reliever (10 relief outings). With Baysox, threw 93.0 IP and struck out 79 over 34 BB to a 5.03 ERA. Pitched 3rd -most IP on the team. Tied for 3rd in Eastern League in HR allowed (18). Fared better as a reliever (4.10 ERA) than as a starter (5.66 ERA). Right-handed batters hit only .196 against him. Went at least 4.0 IP in half of his outings on the season. August was best month as he recorded a 3.55 ERA in 12.2 IP across three appearances. Made AAA debut on 8/23 vs Worcester, threw 4.2 IP, and gave up 7 R on 8 H. Threw season-high and matched career-high with 6.0 IP on 7/23 @ Akron. Struck out season-high seven batters in 4.0 scoreless innings on 4/25 @ Richmond. Was his first scoreless start of Double-A career.

Career Notes: Started '23 season in High-A Aberdeen. Made 15 appearances (6 starts) and struck out 71 over 60.2 IP over a 2.52 ERA. Promoted to Bowie on 7/14. Posted a 6.51 ERA in 47 innings over 12 appearances (6 starts). Pitched for Great Britain in the 2023 World Baseball Classic, where he allowed one run across 4.0 innings. Pitched 1.2 innings against Team USA in pool play that included a strikeout of 3x MVP Mike Trout....Spent all of '22 with Single-A Delmarva, starting 10 of his 21 appearances. Named Shorebirds Player of the Year after leading the team in wins, along with the 3rd-most IP and K....Debuted professionally '21 between FCL - Orioles Orange and Black.

College: Spent four seasons at Div. III Pomona-Pitzer in Claremont, CA. First Sagehen drafted since 2017.

Personal: Drafted by the Orioles in the 17th round of the 2021 Draft out of Pomona-Pitzer. Native of Woodinville, WA

#### **ROBERTO MERCADO**

#### Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
