SERIES RECAP:

The Reading Fightin Phils split last week's series with the Altoona Curve (Pirates), the first of two-straight homestands. The R-Phils won the second game of a doubleheader on Wednesday as well as on Thursday and Friday. They dropped the first game of the doubleheader and lost on Saturday and Sunday. Erik Miller, Brian Marconi and Ethan Lindow tallied wins on the mound for the R-Phils. Aldrem Corredor led the team at the plate over the series as he totaled a six hits and four RBIs. Vito Friscia, Jhailyn Ortiz and Josh Ockimey each had five hits against Altoona. The Phillies' No. 4 prospect Logan O'Hoppe led the team with five RBIs and four runs scored.

JACK ATTACK:

Wendall Rijo is back on the Reading Fightin Phils' roster after spending over a month on the injured list. The infielder hit the injured list on May 6. He stayed on the bench and cheered his Reading teammates on before he started his rehab assignment on June 7. Rijo played one game with the Gulf Coast League Phillies (Rk.) and four games in Clearwater (A). Through his four appearances in Clearwater, Rijo tallied two hits and one walk. Before his injury, Rijo played 20 games with the R-Phils. He posted a .213 batting average and a .298 on-base percentage along with 16 hits, 13 runs and 12 EBIs. Despite not playing with the team since early May, Rijo still leads the team with seven stolen bases. Before he got injured, Rijo was in the midst of a seven-game on-base streak.

FRISCIA FIRST:

Vito Friscia heated up at the plate recently. In his last 10 games, Friscia batted .364 with a .447 on-base percentage. Friscia's currently riding a seven-game on-base streak. He found himself in the leadoff spot in four of the six games against Altoona. In Friday's win, Friscia crushed the first pitch he saw to right field for a leadoff home run. Friscia has the most appearances in the leadoff spot in 2022 with 16. On the season, he has a .254 batting average with a .408 on-base percentage, 33 hits, 23 runs scored and 23 RBIs.

RYAN'S REHAB:

Ryan Sherriff will play with the Reading Fightin Phils this week as he continues a rehab assignment. The Phillies claimed the left-handed pitcher off waivers from the Rays on November 5, 2021 and placed him on the injured list on April 4, 2022 with a left shoulder strain. Sherriff started his rehab on June 9 in Clearwater, where he made two relief appearances. He gave up no runs and one hit while striking out four. The reliever, who was drafted in the 28th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Cardinals, will come out of the bullpen for the Fightins.

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies got back to their winning ways on Monday. Rhys Hoskins delivered a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the ninth inning to give the team a 3-2 victory over the Marlins at home. Hoskins and Kyle Schwarber each finished with two hits. The Phillies scored the first run of the game but fell behind in the seventh after the Marlins scored a run each in the fifth and seventh. Didi Gregorius delivered an RBI single with two outs in the bottom of the eighth to tie the game. Seranthony Dominguez, who earned the win on the mound, kept the Marlins hitless and scoreless in the top of the ninth. Aaron Nola was the starting pitcher for the Phillies. He struck out six batters and gave up two runs on six hits through seven innings of work.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

June 14, 2016: At Reading, the Phils beat Hartford, 8-6, rallying from an early 4-0 deficit. Rhys Hoskins becomes the 3rd Fightin Phils player in June to tally 6 RBIs in a game, going 3-for-4 with a home run, 2 doubles and 6 runs batted in. Reading plays as the visiting team in a game that was moved to FirstEnergy Stadium due to the Yard Goats' ballpark not being ready.
