PAULEY, MACK HOMERS HELP JAX WIN SERIES

Graham Pauley and Joe Mack each homered on Sunday as Jacksonville earned a series win with a 6-5 victory over Nashville. After Blake Perkins led off the game with a home run, Pauley cracked a three-run shot in the bottom of the first. After a Sounds run in the third, Victor Mesa Jr.'s fourth-inning RBI ground out made it 4-2. In the sixth, Mack's solo shot and a Mesa Jr. RBI double gave the Jumbo Shrimp a 6-2 advantage. Andrew Vaughn smashed a three-run homer in the seventh set the final margin at 6-5.

WHEN YOU'RE HOT, YOU'RE HOT

Jacksonville has now won 14 of their last 18 games heading into play on Tuesday. Since this stretch began on June 10, the Jumbo Shrimp have outscored their opponents by a whopping 113-66 (+47) margin. The club has yielded the second-fewest runs (66) in Triple-A while ranking third in ERA (3.32), tied for third in fewest hits allowed (131) and fourth in batting average against (.226). Offensively, Jacksonville ranks first in steals (34), third in home runs (30), fourth in both slugging (.495) and OPS (.854), tied for sixth in runs (113) eighth in both average (.276) and hits (170) and 11th in OBP (.359).

FOREVER 21

With a 51-30 record, Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2006 Jacksonville Suns began the season 54-27. Meanwhile, the 2025 Jumbo Shrimp have pushed their record 21 games over .500 for the first time since 2021, when they were 75-54 prior to the final game of the season. Should Jacksonville win their series opener at Charlotte on Tuesday, the club would be 22 games over .500 for the first time since their 73-51 mark on September 24, 2021.

MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, Jakob Marsee was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich., native has registered hits in 16 of his 18 starts, including nine contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 23-for-70 (.370/.440/.767/1.207 at the plate with four doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 15 RBIs, 10 walks and 15 runs scored. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (39) while sharing the league lead in both triples (5) and walks (51). He also ranks 24th in OBP (.373).

THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 81 games this season, the Shrimp have already used 24 different starting pitchers. Of the three lid-lifters to register double-digit starts for Jacksonville in 2025, only one is still in the rotation (Adam Mazur). Freddy Tarnok is now a member of the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen while Robinson Piña is a member of the Toronto Blue Jays' organization. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 315.0 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the fifth-fewest in Triple-A.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching and defense. The club ranks third in Triple-A with a 3.62 ERA, and their 325 runs allowed are the third-fewest at the level. Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff ranks only 16th in Triple-A in strikeouts (694), but their 576 hits allowed are the level's fewest, meaning the club has suppressed quite a few balls put in play. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 86.9 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the third-lowest in Triple-A. Opponents have barreled only 110 Jacksonville pitches, tied for the second-best at the level.

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered just a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 30 games on the season. The Queen Creek, Ariz., native has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 34 games, Berry has earned more walks (19) than strikeouts (17) while going 31-for-102 (.304/.419/.490/.909) at the plate with eight doubles, one triple, three home runs, 19 RBIs and 21 runs scored.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has won three consecutive series for the first time since the opening three sets of the season... The Jumbo Shrimp turned a season-high four double plays on Sunday against Nashville... Jacksonville has scored at least four runs in 16 of its last 18 games, including 14 contests with five tallies or more.
