YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 6-0. Wil Jensen started and threw four scoreless innings. Altoona took a 3-0 lead in the fifth with a three-run homer by Jackson Glenn. Lolo Sanchez added an RBI double in the sixth and a run scored on a passed ball in the seventh to open a 5-0 lead. In the eighth, Sanchez hit a solo home run, pushing the Curve lead to 6-0. Richmond went 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position and stranded 10 runners on base. Altoona starter Sean Sullivan threw five scoreless innings. Relievers Omar Cruz, Cameron Junker and Tahnaj Thomas covered the last four innings in the shutout.

TŪDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from May 2-7 and split another six-game set in Richmond from June 6-11. This series marks Richmond's only visit to Altoona this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 24-13 in their last 37 games since June 18. They went 5-1 last week against the Sea Dogs after going 4-5 on the previous road trip to resume play out of the All-Star Break. Over the last 42 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.94 ERA (52 ER/159.1 IP) and have allowed 11 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.76 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 360.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 491.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.48 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and the fifth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE CURVE are 5-7 in their last 12 games since July 21. In that stretch, they are averaging 2.7 runs per game (32 runs/12 games). They have scored three-or-less runs in nine-of-their-last-12 games. Altoona's roster includes four of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 6), OF Matt Gorski (No. 12), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 13) and RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 14). Gorski is rated by Baseball America as the Pirates' best power hitter and best outfield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes four Curve players, including Solometo (No. 5), Gorski (No. 15), OF Matt Fraizer (No. 20) and Ashcraft (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his fourth Double-A start. He last pitched on Saturday against the Sea Dogs and worked five innings, allowing three runs (two earned). Bertrand did not allow an earned run over his final two starts for the High-A Eugene Emeralds, spanning 10 innings of work. In his last five High-A starts, Bertrand went 3-0 with a 0.72 ERA (2 ER/25.0 IP). During his time with the Emeralds from May 9-July 13, Bertrand led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.95) and BAA (196), held the second-best ERA (2.92), was second in wins (5) and ranked fourth in innings pitched (49.1). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five relief appearances. Bertrand pitched three seasons at Furman before spending his final two seasons at Notre Dame. Last year, he was an All-American with the Irish before being selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Braxton Ashcraft makes his seventh Double-A start. Last time out, he worked three innings and allowed five runs (three earned) in a loss against the Senators on Friday. In his first five Double-A starts, he did not allow an earned run, spanning 11.0 innings. Ashcraft began the season with Low-A Bradenton and worked two scoreless starts before making nine starts for High-A Greensboro, going 0-2 with a 3.76 ERA. He was promoted to Double-A Altoona on June 20. Ashcraft was selected in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of Robinson High School in Waco, Texas. He made 10 starts in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery, which caused him to miss the entire 2022 season.

STARTING STRONG: In this week's series, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to throw 13 innings without allowing an earned run. On Tuesday, **Carson Seymour** held the Curve scoreless through five innings, allowing one hit with a season-high nine strikeouts. **Spencer Bivens** threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit, in his start on Wednesday night. On Thursday, **Wil Jensen** allowed two hits over four scoreless innings, his third scoreless outing in three starts this season.

BERICOTO BOUNCING BACK: In this week's series in Altoona, **Victor Bericoto** is batting .500 (4-for-8) with a double, a triple, two RBIs and a run scored. He went 2-for-5 with a two-run triple on Wednesday. On Thursday, he went 2-for-3 with a double. In his first 13 games with Richmond prior to this series, Bericoto hit .116 (5-for-43) with two homers and three RBIs. For the year, Bericoto leads all Giants minor league players with 18 home runs, including 16 with High-A Eugene and two with Richmond.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his 12 games since returning from the IL, Ismael Munguia is batting .333 (15-for-45) with two doubles, three walks and seven RBIs. He picked up four hits in his three games in his first series back on the road in Akron from July 21-23. He had nine hits and two walks over six games in last week's series against the Sea Dogs. He entered as a pinch-hitter in the ninth on Saturday night and tied the game with an RBI single, later scoring the winning run. He is batting .182 (2-for-11) and has been hit by a pitch twice in this week's series against the Curve. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 18 games since July 6, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .300 (18-for-60) with two homers, six doubles, 12 RBIs and eight walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On Saturday against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is 2-for-10 with a double and two walks in this week's series in Altoona.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 20 times in his last nine games since July 25 (11 hits and nine walks), posting a .500 on-base percentage and a .355 batting average. On Sunday, he hit a three-run homer and finished the afternoon with four RBIs. He went 4-for-5 with three runs scored on Wednesday night against the Curve. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 117 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

TAKE A WALK: Hayden Cantrelle has walked 64 times this season, which is second-most in the Giants organization and is second-most in the Eastern League. His 19.4% walk rate is the second-highest in the league this season. He also has the third-best on-base percentage (.401) in the league this year. His 64 walks this season are the second-most in a single year in Flying Squirrels franchise history, moving ahead of 62 by **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mark Minicozzi** (2013). The single-season record of 80 was set by **Jacob Heyward** in 2019. Cantrelle is on pace for 89 walks this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 4 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 13), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 14 - on IL), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 24) and RHP Jose Cruz (No. 26). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes seven Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Brown (No. 5), Roupp (No. 10), Seymour (No. 14), Murphy (No. 23), Birdsong (No. 25) and Cruz (No. 26).

Drew Hutchison started for the Fisher Cats and struck out seven in 4.1 innings.
