Leading Off

Reading continues a six-game series and 12-game homestand tonight against New Hampshire. The Fisher Cats lead the season-series 15-7.

Reading fell 7-1 last night to fall down 3-1 in this week's series. New Hampshire scored one in the third and two in the fifth, then broke the game open with four runs in the eighth. Reading avoided the shutout with a run in the ninth. Oliver Dunn had two hits for Reading, including his team-leading 25th RBI of the season. Chad Dallas was excellent for New Hampshire, going seven innings and 11 strikeouts.

R-Phils.

Reading finsihed the month with a 13-12 record, marking its first winning month of the season. Reading finished the month hitting 40 home runs, which lead the Eastern League for the month. Reading's pitching staff was third in the league in strikeouts this month with 274. Oliver Dunn finished the month hitting .299, with ten homers and 29 RBI in August. Dunn's ten home runs and 29 RBI are tied with Somerset's Ben Rice for the Eastern League lead. David Parkinson's 1.26 ERA this month leads the league and Mick Abel's .188 average against ranks second this month.

The First Fightin

David Parkinson gets the start tonight for Reading and he'll look to continue his red-hot stretch. In August, Parkinson was 3-1 with a 1.26 ERA and dating back to July 7, he is 6-1 with a 1.58 ERA over nine starts. His Eastern League ranks in 2023 are the following: ERA (3rd), Wins (T5th), SO (9th), IP (5th), BAA (7th), WHIP (8th) and WPCT (T3rd).

Welcoming the Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight with a 22-30 record in the second half, which is last in the Eastern League, and 57-63 overall record. Last week, New Hampshire won just one-of-five games with Binghamton and Sunday was cancelled. Next week, the Fisher Cats remain on the road at Bowie before finishing the season at home against Somerset. Five of the Blue Jays top-30 prospects are on New Hampshire: Ricky Tiedemann (1), Alan Roden (7), Chad Dallas (14), Damiano Palmegiani (19) and Mason Fluharty (28). Tiedemann ranks No. 33 on MLB Pipeline's Top 100.

Luis Quinones gets the start tonight for New Hampshire. It is his 26th appearence and 10th start in 2023. Overall, he is 4-4 with a 5.02 ERA (71.2 IP, 55 H, 27 BB, 87 SO). It's Quinones' fourth appearence against Reading this season and second start. He went five innings in a start on August 9 and earned the win going five innings and allowing three runs. In his two releif appearences, he allowed a combined four runs over 5.2 innings on May 30 and June 4. He last pitched on Aug. 22 and suffered the loss, allowing five-earned runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings. He did start last Sunday against Binghamton too, but the game was cancelled after it began. Quinones was drafted by the Blue Jays with the 34th pick in the 2019 draft out of San Jacinto Junior College in Texas.
