ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones snapped a season-long six-game losing streak, beating the Aberdeen IronBirds 10-3 in front of 3,904 at Maimonides Park on DC Comics Superhero Night. INF **Justin Guerrero** hit his first Cyclones home run, a two-run shot in the bottom of the fifth to give Brooklyn a 3-2 lead. The Cyclones scored four in the seventh and three in the eighth to pull away and win the game. OF **Joe Suozzi** had an outfield assist and drove in two with an eighth-inning triple. RHP **Oscar Rojas** and the Cyclones pitching staff allowed a combined 12 hits but just three runs in the first win of the series.

BMAC ATTACK: OF **Brandon McIlwain** has been on base in 16 of his past 18 games, hitting .344 with a .444 on-base percentage during the stretch. McIlwain currently ranks first on the team with a 130 wRC+ and has already set a new career-high with nine stolen bases. His .370 on-base percentage leads all qualified Mets Minor Leaguers and he has five triples which is tied with Low-A St. Lucie OF **Alex Ramirez** for the Mets MiLB lead.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF **Rowdy Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State, has been well-rounded in his first full season. The Brooklyn outfielder leads the team with 70 total bases and 16 doubles to lead the entire Mets organization. On the league leaderboard, Jordan ranks tied for third, sitting three back of league leader Luis Mieses (Winston Salem, 19).

JUNIOR: RHP **Junior Santos** has erased a struggling start to the season with a powerful May and June. The righty posted an 8.03 ERA over four April starts. Since the start of May, Santos' ERA is 3.24 with a 20% strikeout rate. The No. 16 prospect, according to *MLB Pipeline* had just an 18% strikeout rate in April.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader

vs. ABERDEEN: The Baltimore affiliate comes to Coney Island for the first time this season for the second head-to-head series. Aberdeen has won nine of the 11 games. The 'Birds have the best record in the league and are home to seven of the Orioles' Top 30 MLB Prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline*. OF Colton Cowser (No. 4) and 3B Coby Mayo (No. 7) are in the top 10.

against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 19 home runs in the past 20 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

ARM ASSISTANCE: RHP **Mike Vasil** and RHP **Carson Seymour** joined the team in Bowling Green last week after earning their respective promotions from Low-A St. Lucie. Vasil, the No. 21 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*, was drafted out of Virginia in the 8th round last season, while Seymour was selected in the 6th round out of Kansas State last year. Vasil makes his home debut, pitching at Maimonides Park for the first time since joining the Cyclones in May.

'CLONES ON THE RISE: OF **Jake Mangum** and INF **Luke Ritter**, two Cyclones from both the 2019 and 2021 clubs, are now with Triple-A Syracuse, sitting just one more promotion shy of the major leagues. On the pitching side, RHP **Bryce Montes de Oca** and RHP **Michel Otanez** are also with the Syracuse Mets.

BIG WEEK IN BKLYN: Thursday night was Pride Night at Maimonides Park with 3,175 in attendance -- the largest home crowd of the season. Friday the team celebratee "The Nine Night," celebrating Black history in baseball in front of 3,806. On Saturday, it's DC Comics Super Heroes night with 2,000 bobbleheads of Superman. Sunday is Jewish Heritage Night.

SWACKING TOUR: Nick Zwack makes his sixth start with Brooklyn and the second one against the Aberdeen Iron-Birds, the team he made his High-A debut against on May 3.

SWEET STRIKEOUT SUCCESS: Zwack tossed just 12 2/3 innings with Low-A St. Lucie, making two starts and two other relief appearances, striking out 24 batters. The southpaw's strikeout rate was 46% in the Florida State League with a 3.8% walk rate.

YEAR ONE: After his draft selection mid-summer in 2021, Zwack reported to Florida to pitch for the Complex team, making five relief appearances with 13 strikeouts and two walks over just seven total frames.

BIG EAST BEST: Zack earned Big East Conference First-Team accolades after his 2021 campaign for the Xavier Musketeers, tossing a team-high 80 innings. He finished his Xavier career with the 12th-most wins in team history (15) and the sixth-most strikeouts in school history (214).

X MARKS THE SPOT: Xavier has been involved with two Hall of Famers -- Frank Robinson who spent 21 years in the Major Leagues with Cincinnati, Baltimore, Los Angeles (NL), California, and Cleveland. Robinson enrolled in Xavier after his first MLB season. On the pitching side, Jim Bunning, who pitched 591 games in the big leagues, represents the most famous arm out of the small Cincinnati college.

MINNESOTA! The left hails from Monticello, Minnesota where he played baseball, hockey, and was the quarterback on his high school football team. He is the only player from his high school -- Monticello High School - to ever play professional baseball.
