PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.
Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 28 games over .500 with a 62-34 record (.646 winning percentage).
62 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, trailing 63 from the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .646 winning percentage overall this year is once again the 3rd-best the Minors, just behind Sugar Land (.63-34 / .649) and the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (.59-32 / .648), Milwaukee's High-A team.
The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
Omaha is currently on pace for 96 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

61 of Omaha's 96 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 22 of 34 losses in 2024, with 12 of 34 losses by just one run (36%).
Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 10 of its last 19 save opportunities, since June 5 (52%).
Omaha is 19-12 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as tied for the 5th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team.
As a team, Omaha's 3- saves are tied for the 5th-most of any Minor League team and 2nd-most in Triple-A and the top mark in the league ... Will Klein's 9 saves individually rank tied for 4th in the International League, this season, while seven different Storm Chasers pitchers have 2 or more saves in 2024 ... Evan Sisk has recorded the team's last four saves in his last four appearances.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 543 to 440 this season, a +103 run differential.
A +103 run differential this year ranks as the best mark both in the International League at the Triple-A level.
Omaha is 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +157 (595 to 438).
The franchise record for run differential in a season is +163 in the inaugural 1969 season ... Omaha has finished over +100 six times, including 3 straight years, 2010-12.

DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.
Over Omaha's last 40 games (since June 5), a .988 fielding percentage (17 errors in 1,381 total chances) is the BEST in Minor League Baseball over that span.
Overall this year, a .981 fielding percentage is tied 7th in the league, tied 9th in Triple-A and tied 12th of the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
The Storm Chasers have not made an error in 15 of the team's last 23 games ... Omaha went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7, with a stretch of errors in 6 straight games from June 29 to July 4 ... a 2-error game this past Sunday was Omaha's first game with more than 1 error in exactly 2 months.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 36 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (58%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.
The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 14 of the 35 comeback wins, with 6 victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 9 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning, including Sunday's victory when trailing from the first pitch of the game, into the bottom of the 9th inning.
Two of Omaha's longest deficits of the season have come in the last two games ... the Chasers trailed from the top of the 1st inning into the bottom of the 9th Sunday vs. Indianapolis (8.5 innings) ... the Storm Chasers trailed for 5.5 innings Tuesday, from the bottom of the 2nd into the top of the 8th inning, taking a lead in the 9th.
