**LAST TIME OUT:** Starting right-hander Janson Junk tossed eight perfect innings as Rocket City defeated Biloxi 4-3 Saturday evening. Junk was three outs away from a perfect game before allowing a leadoff single to Tristan Lutz in the ninth to break up the perfect game and no-hitter. Later in the inning, he allowed a two-out, three-run homer to Koray Howell which pulled the Shuckers to within one and ended Janson's night. However, closer Kolton Ingram picked up the save by striking out David Fry with the tying run at first to end the game. Janson wound up going 8.2 innings and allowing three runs on two hits with a walk and eight strikeouts to get the win. Rocket City scored two in the third to take the lead. Leftfielder Luis Aviles Jr. reached first on a throwing error from Howell to leadoff the inning. The next batter, Ray-Patrick Diddy, then ripped an RBI triple. Diddy would score on a groundout to second from the next batter, Orlando Martinez. The Trash Pandas added key insurance runs in the eighth and ninth. In the eighth, Aviles singled, went to second on a groundout, stole third, then scored with two out on a passed ball by Fry. In the ninth, Mitch Nay singled, advanced to second and third on wild pitches, then scored on a one-out RBI single from Anthony Mulrine to put Rocket City up 4-0. Saturday and Sunday's games were canceled due to Hurricane Ida's impact on the Gulf Coast before Tuesday and Wednesday's games were canceled due to COVID-19.

**4x4:** No matter what is said of the 2021 Rocket City Trash Pandas, never say they were inconsistent as the team has worked in a 4x4 philosophy. The team has never been more than four games below or above .500 for the first 98 games of the year.

**GETTING K'S:** The pitchers are racking up the strikeouts against opposing hitters whiffing 1,005 batters through the first 98 games. That is good enough for first in AA-South. The most the Trash Pandas have struck out in a game was 19, which happened on 6/26 against Chattanooga when former starting pitcher Reid Detmers set a new season-high for Rocket City pitchers with 16Ks followed by reliever Ryan Clark who punched out three more Lookouts. Twice the Trash Pandas have struck out 16 batters. First on 5/11 when they K'd 16 Smokies in a 10-inning loss, then on 6/16 when they shutout Biloxi. They also struck out 15 Smokies in a shutout win on 5/13, 15 more against Birmingham on 5/25, another 15 against Chattanooga on 6/5, then 15 more on 7/22 against Tennessee. Detmers still leads the way with 97K's after his 16-strikeout performance. Janson Junk got strikeout number 1,000 as part of his bid for perfection with eight strikeouts over eight perfect innings on 8/27 at Biloxi.

**READY FOR LAUNCH:** The Trash Pandas have lived up to the Rocket City moniker by launching 146 homers, which is tops in AA-South and all of AA. 13 of those dingers came in the 7/20-7/26 series against Tennessee, which is the most in any series this season. Earlier in the year, Rocket City lifted 12 longballs against the Smokies in the 5/11-5/16 series, including two grand slams in the series finale on 5/16. Another 12 came in the series against Montgomery (7/6-7/10) with six provided by infielder Luis Aviles Jr. Rocket City also hit 12 during the Chattanooga series 8/17-8/22. Third baseman Mitch Nay leads with way with 22, which is first in AA-South, with rightfielder Izzy Wilson sitting in second at 21. In fact, the Trash Pandas possess four of the top 10 homerun hitters in AA-South on the team. Luis Aviles Jr. is tied for seventh with 15 dingers along with Orlando Martinez.

**PROSPECT RANKINGS:** The Trash Pandas' current roster features six of the Angels' Top 30 prospects (according to MLB.com): shortstop Livan Soto (No. 13), right-handed pitcher Robinson Pina (No. 21), right-handed pitcher Davis Daniel (No. 22), right-handed pitcher Janson Junk (No. 23), outfielder Orlando Martinez (No. 27), and left-handed pitcher Ryan Smith (No. 28).

**BACK-TO-BACK ON BACK-TO-BACK:** Rocket City also has an eye-popping nine instances of back-to-back home runs this season. It began during the first Tennessee series (5/11-5/16) and...ironically...it happened on back-to-back days (5/14-5/15) and in the same inning (3rd). On 5/14 it was outfielders Torii Hunter Jr. and Orlando Martinez doing the job against the Smokies' Javier Assad. The next night, infielder Gavin Cecchini and outfielder Izzy Wilson went yard; first against starter Luis Lugo, then reliever Scott Effross. Rocket City went back-to-back for the third time when Wilson and Cecchini teamed up for the second time, this time against Chattanooga right-hander Randy Wynne on 6/5. It was then Wilson and Ibandel Isabel going yard in the fourth inning against Montgomery on 7/8. The shot by Isabel was measured at a mammoth 471 feet, the longest in Toyota Field's brief history. Rocket City blasted off by going back-to-back for the fifth time this season when Wilson and Nay teamed up on 7/23. The homers gave the teammates the AA-South lead in round-trippers at the time with 16. All five back-to-back drives have come at Toyota Field this season. The Trash Pandas upped that number to six when Aviles and Brendon Davis went back-to-back in the fourth inning on 7/28 against Birmingham. Rocket City went back-to-back for the first time on the road this year when Davis and MacKinnon did the trick at Tennessee on 8/13. It was then MacKinnon and Wilson who gave Rocket City eight back-to-backs when they did it against Chattanooga at Toyota Field on 8/19. Number nine came just two days later when Wilson and Nay did the trick in the fifth inning against Chattanooga.

# WHAT IS A TRASH PANDA?

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunatics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds.

More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far - the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball. The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).



## NEW MiLB RULES FOR 2021

*Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 11, 2021*

Major League Baseball (MLB) announced today the testing of a variety of experimental playing rules at various levels of the Minor Leagues during the upcoming 2021 season. These experimental playing rules have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee. MLB will closely monitor and analyze the impact of each rule change throughout the 2021 season and report to Clubs on their effects for further analysis. Consistent with the preferences of our fans, the rule changes being tested are designed to increase action on the basepaths, create more balls in play, improve the pace and length of games, and reduce player injuries.



Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2021 Minor League season:

**Double-A (Defensive Positioning):** The defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, each of whom must have both feet completely in front of the outer boundary of the infield dirt. Depending on the preliminary results of this experimental rule change, MLB may require two infielders to be positioned entirely on each side of second base in the second half of the Double-A season. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to increase the batting average on balls in play.

### NOTEWORTHY

**THE SMITH FILE:** LHP **Ryan Smith** joined the Trash Pandas on July 28 for his Double-A debut after a strong start of the season for Low-A Inland Empire and High-A Tri-City. In his third start of the season for the 66ers, Smith recorded a career-high 13 strikeouts over 6.0 scoreless innings in a win vs. Modesto. He was named Low-A West Pitcher of the Week for that dominant outing. In the month of May for Inland Empire, he was 2-1 with a 1.66 ERA (4 ER/21.2 IP) with six walks and 37 strikeouts to start the season. He was promoted to High-A Tri-City on June 5 and won his High-A debut on June 11 at Hillsboro with 6.0 scoreless innings and nine strikeouts. He pitched at least 5.0 innings in seven of his eight starts for the Dust Devils before his promotion to Rocket City. In his Double-A debut, he threw a quality start but took the loss with three earned runs over 6.0 innings on July 31 against Birmingham. In his first Double-A road start, he got rocked for eight earned runs at Chattanooga on August 6 for his second straight loss. He then threw a quality start in his last away outing on August 12 at Tennessee, giving up just two runs in his best Double-A outing to date. Smith followed with another solid start, giving up two runs in his second straight no-decision on August 18 vs. Chattanooga. Smith finally got his first Rocket City win in his last start at Biloxi on August 24. He is currently ranked as the Angels No. 28 prospect according to MLB.com

**VS. TENNESSEE:** Smith threw his second Double-A quality start against Tennessee on August 12, giving up two runs over 6.0 innings.

### MORE NOTES

**PRO DEBUT:** Smith made his debut for Rookie-Level Orem in 2019 and made 19 appearances out of the bullpen for the Owlz. He pitched a season-high 2.1 scoreless innings at Rocky Mountain on August 21 and set a season-high with four strikeouts. He's transitioned into a starter for the 2021 season.

**NCAA NOTES:** Pitched four seasons for Princeton from 2016-19 and went 8-10 with five saves and a 4.52 ERA (83 ER/165.1 IP) to go with 166 strikeouts over 47 appearances (21 starts). During his senior season in 2019, he led the team in starts (11), innings (75.2), strikeouts (76), and ERA (3.45). His 76 strikeouts were the seventh-most in a single-season in program history while his career total (176) tied for ninth at the time of his graduation. He transitioned from a reliever to a starter during his junior year in 2018.

**HIGH SCHOOL NOTES:** Graduated from Garden City High School on Long Island in 2015. Lettered in volleyball, basketball, and baseball. In baseball, he was a 2015 All-County and Nassau County All-Star. He was also named a Perfect Game Pre-Season All-American Honorable Mention and named All-Conference in 2014.
