Cheers to the Bootleggers!... Bowling Green sports their Bootleggers alternate identity for the final time this season on Thursday night against the Greenville Drive. Bowling Green holds an 8-1 record as the Bootleggers this season. The identity honors the rich history of bourbon throughout The Bluegrass State with over 35 active distilleries.

Loud and Heavy... Outfielder Ryan Cermak belted two home runs in Wednesday's defeat, driving in five runs. Cermak has now blasted eight homers in his last 11 games since August 20 against the Greensboro Grasshoppers. He leads all South Atlantic League batters in homers, RBI (19), SLG (.927) and OPS (1.367) during that time frame.

You've Got A Fast (Team)... The 2026 Bowling Green Hot Rods are up to a franchise-record 285 stolen bases. The Hot Rods have swiped six bases in this series against the Drive. Nine different Bowling Green players have delivered 20-plus steal campaigns.

Line 'Em Up, Knock 'Em In... Infielder Tony Santa Maria enters Thursday's contest on a career-long five-game RBI streak. The 24-year-old is tied for the most RBI amongst active Hot Rods players with 66 driven in this season. Santa Maria is batting for a .346 AVG (37-for-107) with runners in scoring position this season.

No Runs Nation... Reliever Garrett Gainey pitched a 1-2-3 inning on Wednesday. Gainey has not allowed a run over his last 6.0 innings dating back to August 18 against Greensboro. The southpaw has punched out eight batters and allowed just five base runners during that time.

Phone, K's, Wallet... Right-handed pitcher Trevor Harrison toes the rubber for the Bootleggers on Thursday night. The Tampa Bay Rays' No. 21 prospect excelled during Bowling Green's last home series, striking out a career-best 10 batters against Greensboro on August 18 and 16 overall over two starts.
