TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play their lone series of the season with the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, this week at PNG Field. Manager Raul Dominguez is back to guide the Patriots for a third season after leading them to playoff appearances in each of the last two seasons. The Yankees prospect group is highlighted by OF Spencer Jones, ranked as the No. 2 prospect in their minor league system according to MLB Pipeline. Former Penn State Nittany Lion Bailey Dees is back with Somerset as well. No. 12 RHP Cam Schlittler, No. 17 C Rafael Flores, and No. 25 RHP Trystan Vrieling round out the prospect group.

Trent Sellers is the first to throw the rock today for Somerset. A Kennewick, Washington native, Sellers has allowed 6 runs in 7.1 innings to begin the year. Sellers attended Oregon State after two years at NAIA Lewis & Clark State and one year at Washington State. Sellers has swung back and forth between the rotation and bullpen as a professional, he started for much of his collegiate career and was a reliever at first with the Yankees. Sellers played hockey until he was 14, telling Hudson Valley Renegades broadcaster Joe Vasile that he was really small when he quit because he couldn't cut it physically on the rink. The good news is he looks forward to playing some beer league hockey with friends when his baseball career wraps up.

RAISIN BRAN: Infielder Jack Brannigan has reached base safely in 11-of-13 games played for the Curve and picked up the game-winning RBI with a run-scoring single in the 8th inning of Altoona's April 19 win over Somerset. Brannigan had two 3-hit games in his first 10 games played this season, he had three last season in 77 games at Greensboro.

YOU SIR, ARE A POSITION PLAYER ON THE MOUND: Altoona used a position player on the mound three times in their first 13 games this season. Tres Gonzalez (2x) and Hudson Head have stepped atop the mound in blowouts for the Curve and combined to toss 3.1 scoreless innings. In 2024, Altoona used a position player on the mound three times in 138 games (Brendan Dixon twice and Eli Wilson).

**JE-"BB"**: Curve utilityman, Mitch Jebb, entered play on Sunday, April 20, 2nd in the Eastern League with 11 walks drawn. Jebb has used his selective eye at the plate to give him more opportunities on the base paths where he's picked up 5 stolen bases in 6 tries to begin the season. He's reached base via hit or walk 19 times and has a .365 onbase percentage in 12 games.

**DAY GAME BATS**: Altoona earned 28 baserunners in a 10-1 win over Somerset on Wednesday, April 16. The team drew 11 walks, the most since May 25, 2018 against Harrisburg (12 BB), and picked up 14 hits. Four different Curve hitters had multi-hit games and everyone in the lineup reached base at least twice.

A YOUNG MAN'S GAME: Infielder Termarr Johnson became the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve, behind Jose Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve, when he arrived on August 27, 2024 in Curve, PA. This season, Johnson opens as the youngest in the Eastern League at 20 years old, just two days younger than Reading's Aidan Miller. Among Double-A players, he is the 7th-youngest player at the level; the youngest is San Antonio's Ethan Salas (SD, 18.8 years old). Johnson's 85 walks last season were 9th-most by a minor league player and he's reached base safely in 18-of-25 games with the Curve. Johnson has a hit in 9-of-11 games to begin the season.

**OUT FOR A WALK**: Altoona hitters are 3rd among all Double-A clubs with 71 walks in their first 14 games of the season.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START: Curve starters tossed 15 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel, Solometo, Chen). Overall, Curve starters have a 1.02 WHIP, 1st among Double-A staffs and 3.44 ERA, 5th among Double-A clubs.

THE TRACKS TO PITTSBURGH RIDE THROUGH ALTOONA: Three Curve alums, RHP Thomas Harrington (4/1, PIT), LHP Omar Cruz (4/1, SD), and INF Tsung-Che Cheng (4/9, PIT) have all made their major league debut this season, totaling 220 alumni who have gone onto the major leagues.

**WE'LL SEE THEM ALL**: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.



# **ALTOONA CURVE COACHING STAFF**

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

### Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

### Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.


