JUMBO SHRIMP OPEN SERIES WITH 7-3 WIN

Deyvison De Los Santos homered and Agustín Ramírez had two hits, an RBI, run scored and stolen base to help Jacksonville win their series opener 7-3 over Lehigh Valley. After the IronPigs plated a pair of runs in the first, De Los Santos' two-run shot tied the game in the bottom of the inning. In the fourth, Troy Johnston's RBI double and Ramírez's RBI single gave Jacksonville a 4-2 lead. Jonathan Davis added an RBI ground out in the fifth. In the sixth, Ramírez stole third and scored on an error. Javier Sanoja's RBI double made it 7-3 in the seventh.

ROCKET MAN

Still at just 21 years old, Deyvison De Los Santos has had a monstrous 2024 season between Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo. Currently, De Los Santos leads all of full season MiLB in home runs (30), RBIs (88), slugging (.644), OPS (1.025) and total bases (228), He's also ranked third in hits (116) and tied for third in extra-base hits (50). Of the top 100 exit velos in the minors in 2024, the Dominican has hit four of them, trailing Jhonkensy Noel (6x), Orelvis Martinez (6x) and Pedro León (5x).

IT'S TEARIN' UP MY START WHEN I'M WITH YOU

In 2005, Jacksonville starting pitchers ranked just 25th in Double-A with 741.0 innings, which represented 60.6 percent of the club's 1223.2 innings. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp's starting rotation has worked 51.6 percent of the club's innings, a total of 458.1 out of 888.2 frames. That figure is the eighth-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville lid-lifters also lead the level in ERA (4.30; next-closest is Memphis at 4.62) while ranking second in WHIP (1.36) and BAA (.252). fifth in OPSA (.769) and ninth in walks (183).

GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 25-17 (.595) in their last 42 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 29 of those 42 affairs (69.0 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in fewest runs allowed (152: next-closest is Indianapolis at 174) FRA (3.48: next-closest is Indianapolis at 3.90), WHIP (1.32) and OPS against (.722) while ranking second in hits allowed (323) and fourth in BAA (.239).

QUIT PLAYING GAMES WITH MY START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 36 of the last 41 games, with 27 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and 14 being without an earned run. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 79 runs, 72 earned, on 168 hits (8.4 H/9) in 179.1 innings for a 3.61 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 183 strikeouts (9.2 K/9) against 82 walks (4.1 BB/9) during this stretch. Rather remarkably, the Jumbo Shrimp have started 17 different pitchers over these 41 contests.

SOULJA TROY

Heading into play on May 25, Troy Johnston, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 53 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 64-for-198, slashing .323/.390/.510/.900 with 13 doubles, three triples, six homers, 28 RBIs, 20 walks and 35 runs scored. Johnston has 16 multi-hit games in his last 34 contests and is the season's IL leader in hits (111) while also ranking tied for third in doubles (25) and 23rd in batting average (.282).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 59 of his last 69 games, notching 24 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 86for-268 (.321/.392/.489/.881) with 21 doubles, three triples, six home runs, 40 RBIs, 33 walks and 37 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks fifth in batting average (.300), tied for seventh in doubles (23) and 13th in hits (92).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville is 8-4 in their last 12 games... Griffin Conine ranks in a tie for 15th in the IL in homers (17) and tied for 18th in extra-base hits (36)... The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in eight of the last nine games after doing so just three times in the previous 10 contests... Will Banfield is batting .348/.387/.636 in his last 19 games.

ABOUT YONNY

-A native of Bachaquero, Venezuela, Chirinos signed with the Tampa Bay Rays for 10,000 as an international free agent from Venezuela in June 2012.

-On March 25, 2018, the Rays announced that Chirinos had made the Opening Day roster. Chirinos made his opening debut in a long relief role against the Boston Red Sox on April 1. He worked four scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. Chirinos set a franchise record by pitching his first 14 2/3 innings without allowing an earned run.

-Chirinos pitched for Tampa Bay on August 16, 2020 against the Blue Jays. His start that night followed a stint on the injured list due to right triceps inflammation. A week later, he underwent Tommy John surgery. Chirinos' rehab and recovery process was stalled in September 2021 when he fractured his elbow while throwing batting practice. The injury required surgery and, as it turned out, set him back another year. He wound up going 752 days between appearances for the Rays, finally returning to the mound on September 8, 2022. Chirinos allowed four hits, one walk and struck out four while blanking the Red Sox during a three-inning stint. When he took the mound in the fourth in relief of Jeffrey Springs, the game was scoreless. When he exited after the sixth, the Rays had a 1-0 lead. That is how the game finished and Chirinos had his first win since August 4, 2019.

-After more than a decade in the Rays' organization, Chirinos was claimed off waivers on July 23, 2023 by the Atlanta Braves. Atlanta non-tendered Chirinos in November and he signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins in February.

2024 SEASON

--Had his contract selected by Miami on June 19 and made six starts before getting designated for assignment on July 23 and outrighted to Jacksonville on July 25.

2023 SEASON

-With both Tampa Bay and Atlanta, when pitching with the bases empty, opponents posted an .832 OPS in 224 appearances. In 138 plate appearances with runners on base, that figure dropped to .794. Additionally, in 87 plate appearances with runners in scoring position, opponents compiled a .742 OPS.

-According to Baseball Savant, Chirinos was in the 87th percentile in offspeed run value (+4) while also ranking in the 71st percentile in ground ball percentage (46.3 percent).
