The South Bend Cubs split their 6-game set with the Beloit Sky Carp, but had to do it in comeback fashion as South Bend lost 3 of the first 4 games. With wins on Saturday 9-1, and Sunday 10-2, the Cubs stormed back in the series. Each win of the series for the Cubs came by exactly eight runs.

ROAD WARRIORS

Going back to the MWL Playoffs Series the Cubs have won 6 straight on the road.

FIRST PLACE CUBS

With their 2 straight wins to end the weekend, South Bend finds themselves back in first place in the Midwest League West Division. Beloit is a game back, and due to Cedar Rapids being postponed on Sunday, the Kernels are a half-game back of South Bend..

HIGHWAY ROBBERS

Through the initial 9 games of the season, the South Bend Cubs lead the Midwest League in stolen bases with 22.

GOOD MEMORIES HERE

This week's series in Midland marks the first time that the South Bend Cubs have played at Dow Diamond since winning the MWL East Division Pennant there on September 8, 2019. It was win the Cubs posted before taking on and beating the Clinton LumberKings in the Championship Series that September. Righty Derek Casey was the starting pitcher for SB in Great Lakes that night.

ICE KOHL'D

In his first start in 2023 on Wednesday, Kohl Franklin sent the Sky Carp packing with four shutout innings and seven strikeouts. Last year, Franklin faced Great Lakes at Four Winds Field in South Bend and allowed four runs in two innings, but it was while he was still fully recovering from injury.

CHAMPIONS RETURN

On the 2023 South Bend Cubs Opening Day Roster, 15 players who are 2022 Midwest League Champions return. That list includes Brad Deppermann, Kohl Franklin, Richard Gallardo, Adam Laskey, Luke Little, Joe Nahas, Sheldon Reed, Didier Vargas, Jarod Wright, Casey Opitz, Kevin Made, Scott McKeon, Fabian Pertuz, Bradlee Beesley, and Yohendrick Pinango.

FAMILIAR COACHING STAFF

Manager Lance Rymel, who has now won back-to-back championships from the Arizona Fall League in 2021, and the Midwest League in 2022, is back as South Bend Cubs Manager. He is joined by returning hitting coach Dan Puentes, and bench coach D'Angelo Jimenez. New to the staff is pitching coach Clayton Mortensen, who was the pitching coach last year with Low-A Myrtle Beach. Mortensen was the St. Louis Cardinals' first round pick in 2007. He made his MLB debut with St. Louis on June 29, 2009. In total, Mortensen pitched in 74 Big League games and struck out 112 batters with the Red Sox, Athletics, Rockies, and Cardinals.

HI KEVIN

Chicago Cubs #2 overall prospect Kevin Alcantara headlines the 2023 Opening Day Roster. Alcantara, who was traded for Anthony Rizzo away from the New York Yankees in 2021, is ranked as a top-100 prospect in baseball. He had his best day as a South Bend Cub so far on Saturday, going 3/4 with 2 doubles, a homer, 2 RBI, and 4 runs scored.
