Mets RHP Carlos Carrasco to Make Rehab Start: New York Mets right-handed pitcher Carlos Carrasco will begin a rehab assignment with the Rumble Ponies tonight. Carrasco is in his third season with the Mets organization after being traded to New York from Cleveland in 2021, alongside shortstop Francisco Lindor. The 36-year-old made his major league debut for Cleveland in 2004 and is in the middle of his 14th season in the big leagues. He has made three starts for the Mets this season and tied Chris Bassitt with a team-high 15 wins on the mound in 2022.

Here's How The "Cookie" Crumbles: Carlos "Cookie" Carrasco was the 2019 American League Comeback Player of the Year and Roberto Clemente Award winner. Carrasco spent 11 seasons with Cleveland (2009-2020) before coming to New York. He is 104-87 with a 3.92 ERA in his MLB career. Carrasco was honored following the 2019 season after being diagnosed with chronic myeloid leukemia in June of that year. After missing two and half months, he returned to the mound on September 1st. He was traded to the Mets with Francisco Lindor, which sent INF Andrés Giménez, INF Amed Rosario, RHP Josh Wolf, and OF Isaiah Greene to Cleveland.

Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Somerset Patriots 11-2 in the series finale at TD Bank Ballpark on Sunday afternoon. Brandon McIlwain and Agustin Ruiz drove in the two Ponies runs and McIlwain had a multi-hit game.

JT Against the Yard Goats: First baseman JT Schwartz exploded in the series at Hartford last month. He went 8-for-21 (.381) in five games with two home runs, a double, eight runs batted in, and four runs scored. He finished the series with a .435 OBP, .714 SLG, and 1.149 OPS.

Upcoming Schedule: Binghamton will continue its series with the Yard Goats on Wednesday at Mirabito Stadium. The Ponies and Goats will play a doubleheader with the first game starting at 5:00 PM. The games will be broadcast on WNBK News Radio 1290 AM and 92.1 FM, and MiLB.TV and the Bally Live App.

BACKGROUND: The 2019 American League Comeback Player of the Year and Roberto Clemente Award winner joined the Mets after he and Francisco Lindor were traded from Cleveland to New York in January of 2021. Carrasco is in the midst of his third season with the Mets. Carrasco, 36, spent 11 seasons with Cleveland (2009-2020) before coming to the Mets. He is 104-87 with a 3.92 ERA in his MLB career.

Carrasco was honored following the 2019 season after being diagnosed with chronic myeloid leukemia in June of that year. After missing two and half months, he returned to the mound on September 1st. The Roberto Clemente Award is awarded annually to the player who best represents the game of Baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field.

2022: Made 29 starts for the Mets and went 15-7 with a 3.97 ERA. His 15 wins in 2022 were his most in a single season since 2018 (17 wins) and it marked the third-most wins he's ever had in a single season. Carrasco tied Chris Bassitt for the team-lead in wins and ranked third on the team in innings pitched (152.0) and strikeouts (152).

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo.
