RETURN OF ROYCE: The Minnesota Twins sent Royce Lewis to St. Paul on Major League rehab on Saturday. Lewis is the ninth Major League rehab player to join the Saints this season. He joins Josh Winder, who has thrown 9.0 innings, allowing six runs (five earned) on nine hits, walking four and striking out eight, with his last appearance coming on May 24.

\$\sigma\$ In 46 career games with the Saints, Lewis has hit .324 with 11 home runs, owning a 1.004 OPS. Six of his 11 home runs came in 12 games with the Saints last year. He's also gone 15-for-18 in stolen base attempts in his Triple-A career.

BULLPEN BRINGING IT: Over the last 10 games, the Saints bullpen has been locked in, going 4-1 with a 2.81 ERA, the third-best in the IL, in that span. The 48.1 innings the bullpen has thrown in that stretch are the third-most of any staff in Triple-A. Their 19 walks issued are the fourth-fewest in the IL, sporting a league-best 1.15 WHIP, trailing only Round Rock's 1.09 WHIP, who's bullpen has thrown only 34.0 innings.

SAINTS MARCHING ON THE BASES: Alex Isola's stolen base in the eighth inning on Friday marked the 11th consecutive game the Saints have swiped a bag, their longest streak of the season and the longest streak in franchise history. It is also the longest active streak in the IL and the second-longest streak in the league in 2024. The Saints are 53-for-60 in stolen bases this year, successful in 88.1% of their attempts, which is the highest rate in Triple-A and third-highest among full-season minor league teams vs. West......16-22 league teams.

GOING FOR A REALLY LONG WALK: In the Saints 18-3 victory in Wednesday's game, they drew a franchise-record 15 walks. LAST APPEARANCE: 5/17 v OMA...made ninth start of the season, throwing 4.0 innings in a rain-shortened start...allowed two runs on four hits, one home run, walking two and striking out four...first run allowed scored in the second inning on a wild pitch...surrendered a solo home run to CJ Alexander in the fourth inning...rain arrived in the bottom of the fourth inning, suspending the game with a 2-2 score...did not factor into the decision in a 4-2 Saints victory.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 5/11 @ TOL...made eighth start of the season and his first career appearance against Toledo...struck out 10 batters to tie the franchise record for the second time in three starts...allowed leadoff singles in the third and fourth...struck out the side in the second inning, his only clean inning...recorded 23 whiffs, tied for the second-most in a single game by any AAA pitcher this year (per Baseball Savant)...did not factor into decision as game was scoreless going into the ninth, Toledo walked-off the Saints in a 1-0 final.

A PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES: In just his ninth professional pitching appearance, Festa was a major part of a no-hitter. On May 10, 2022 with Fort Myers, he threw 6.0 no-hit innings, striking out a career-high 11 batters in a combined no-hitter for the Mighty Mussels. Jaylen Nowlin followed with 2.0 perfect innings and struck out three. Hunter McMahon tossed 1.0 hitless inning to finish it off, a 3-0 win.

ONE, TWO, THREE, YOU'RE OUT!: On July 24, 2022, Festa allowed three consecutive singles between the third and fourth innings. The final two batters of the third inning reached, as did the first of the fourth. Festa got three outs, but did not retire a batter because promptly picked off each of the three batters, one after the other.
