ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They made the Midwest League playoffs seven times between 2007 and 2019. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

GREAT LAKES IN 2021: The Loons went 63-57 and missed the playoffs. Great Lakes had an opportunity to make the playoffs in the final week of the season, but the Timber Rattlers won five of six games from the Loons at Down Diamond to knock Great Lakes out of the playoff picture

GREAT LAKES IN 2022: The Loons are in second place in the Eastern Division. They won the final five games in a series at first place Dayton prior to starting this series with Wisconsin to cut the deficit from 8-1/2 games to 3-1/2 games. They are now 4-1/2 games out of first.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has seven current Loons on their list of Dodgers prospects: Diego Cartaya (#1), Eddys Leonard (#8), Jorbit Vivas (#9), Nick Nastrini (#13), Jose Ramos (#14), Carlos Duran (#16), and Alex De Jesus (#20). Hyun-il Choi (#28) is on the Great Lakes Injured List.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYNE MOORE: The Brewers selected Moore in the 18<sup>th</sup> round of the 2021 draft out of Old Dominion University.

**THE MONARCH:** Moore went 9-1 with a 3.16 ERA in seventeen games – fourteen starts – in his final season at ODU. He was also named a Second Team All-Conference USA selection in 2021.

**AM I BLUE?** Moore began his professional career with Milwaukee's Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League after signing his professional contract. He made six appearances – two starts – and allowed a run on four hits over 12-2/3 innings for Brewers Blue.

IN MY MIND I'M GOING TO CAROLINA: Moore started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 0-1 with a 2.31 ERA in six starts in the Carolina League. Moore walked eleven and struck out 38 over 35 innings for the Mudcats.

**WELCOME TO WISCONSIN:** Moore joined the Timber Rattlers on May 12, 2022.

**LAST START:** Moore <u>won at Beloit on June 9</u>. He allowed a run on two hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over seven innings.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Tonight is the first time Moore will face the Loons. He made the start against the Arizona Complex League <u>affiliate of the Dodgers on September 10, 2021</u>. Moore allowed two hits and two walks with one strikeout over 2-2/3 scoreless innings for a no decision in that game.

#### **BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:**

RHP CARLOS DURAN: Signed with the Los Angeles Dodgers as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on March 8, 2018

**SWEET SIXTEEN:** Duran is rated as the #16 prospect in the Dodgers system by MLB Pipeline.

ROOKIE LEVELS: Duran started his pro career with the Dodgers Robinson affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2018 and moved to the Dodgers Shoemaker affiliate in the Dominican Summer League to start 2019. Duran was 0-2 with a 1.50 ERA, three walks, and 30 strikeouts over 42 innings pitched with Robinson in 2018. He was 1-0 in five starts and a 0.43 ERA with Shoemaker before a promotion to the Dodgers Lasorda affiliate in the Arizona League to finish 2019. Duran was 0-4 with an 8.38 ERA in eight starts in the AZL in 2019.

**CALIFORNIA DREAMING:** Duran made twenty appearances – eighteen starts – for the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 5.25 ERA and 109 strikeouts over 73-2/3 innings before a brief promotion to Great Lakes at the end of the season. Duran was 0-1 in two starts for the Loons last season.

**BACK AT IT:** Duran started this season back in Arizona and made a one-inning start for the ACL Dodgers before joining the Loons tonight.

**LAST START:** Duran had a <u>no decision against the Royals on June 9</u>. He hit a batter and struck out a batter over a scoreless, hitless inning.

VS. WISCONSIN: Duran has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. The last time he pitched against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers was <u>August 26, 2019 against the Brewers Gold affiliate</u>. Duran allowed two runs on four hits with two walks and no strikeouts over two innings and was charged with the loss.
