

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn settled for a split of the home-and-home series against Hudson Valley, dropping the finale on the road, 5-4...The Cyclones trailed 4-1 entering the seventh but tied the game on a 3B **Mateo Gil** solo home run, a IB **Kellum Clark** single, and a wild pitch...The Renegades took the lead for good in the bottom of the seventh thanks to four walks, including a bases-loaded free pass to C **Antonio Gómez**...Clark snapped a 1-for-37 slide at the plate with the first three-hit game of his Cyclones career...Gil added a two-hit night of his own...IB **Omar Martinez** went 2-for-3 and reached base three times for Hudson Valley, driving in two...3B **Brenny Escanio** added a two-run double of his own for the Renegades.

Stewart goes 3-for-5 with six runs batted in, clubbing a two-run shot in the first, a three-run blast in the fifth, and a solo clout in the seventh...In 2006, future New York Mets RHP Adam Ottavino tossed 6.0 innings of one-hit shutout ball for the State College Spikes, defeating Brooklyn on Coney Island, 3-0...In 2011, LF Travis Taijeron broke a two-all tie in the top of the eighth with an RBI single, as Brooklyn won 3-2 at Connecticut...In 2023, tied at two entering the eighth, the Cyclones scored four runs in the top of the frame, capped off with a two-run double by SS César Berbesi in Brooklyn's 7-2 win at Wilmington.

WIZARD OF PAZ: OF **Karell Paz** is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is 8-for-23 (.348) at the plate in six games...Paz has scored three runs and picked up two doubles, a home run, four runs batted in, and a pair of stolen bases...His OPS is .913 during that span.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision last Wednesday night in Aberdeen and threw 5.0 spotless innings to earn the win on Tuesday vs. Hudson Valley...Over his last three starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-0 with an 0.56 ERA (I ER in 16.0 IP), allowing only five hits and six walks (10.0 BB%), while striking out 25 (41.67 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit in strikeouts (63)...He is also tied for second in batting av-erage against (194), third in ERA (3.02), and fifth in WHIP (1.22)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is third in FIP (2.18), fourth in strikeout rate (36.3%), ninth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (99).

TALK 2 'EM: RHP **Kade Morris** has started to find his stride at the High-A level... Since his start on June 21 vs. Jersey Shore, the 22-year-old holds a 1-1 record with a sparkling 1.96 ERA (4 ER in 18.1 IP)...He has yielded just 11 hits and eight walks (10.67%) while striking out 19 (25.33 K%)...Since June 20, Morris and RHP **Jonah Tong** have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, Tong is second in the circuit in ERA (0.56) and Morris (1.96) is eighth...Tong and Morris are also first (25) and tied for fifth in strikeouts (19), respectively...Ad ditionally, Kade is third in innings pitched (18.1), sixth in batting average against (.169), and eighth in WHIP (1.04)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is third in the league in batting average against (.223), tied for fourth in innings pitched (42.0), and seventh in ERA (3.86) and WHIP (1.24).

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: On Monday, RHP **Eric Orze** became the 101st former Brooklyn Cyclone to make his Major League debut and the 67th to do so with the New York Mets...The 26-year-old had his contract selected by the New York Mets from Triple-A Syracuse on Saturday...In 26 relief appearances with Syracuse in 2024, Orze holds a 3-0 record with a 3.76 ERA (16 ER in 38.1 IP), two saves, 22 walks (13.3 BB%), and 56 strikeouts (33.9 K%)...The University of New Orleans alum made 13 appearances out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2021...Orze went 1-2 with a 4.05 ERA (9 ER in 20.0 IP), one save, six walks (7.0 BB%), and 26 strikeouts (30.2 K%). He is the third former. Brooklyn pitcher to debut this season joining 2 K%)...He is the third former Brooklyn pitcher to debut this season joining Christian Scott (5/4) with the Mets and RHP Michel Otañez (6/10) with the Oakland Athletics

NICK SQUARED: OF **Nick Morabito** and IF **Nick Lorusso** have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...Lorusso is eighth in the South Atlantic League walks (40), ninth in OPS (.837), and tied for ninth in total bases (122)...Lorusso is third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in OPS (.837) and slugging (.471)...He is also fourth in batting average (.266), tied for fourth in home runs (11) and triples (3), fifth in total bases (122) and RBI (41), and tied for fifth in hits (69) and extra-base hits (28)...Morabito is 10th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (36)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is third in the circuit in stolen bases (25), tied for fourth in hits (56), and tied for sixth in runs scored (36)...On the year, the 21-year-

vs. WILMINGTON: After a two-day break, Brooklyn travels south for a six-game series against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks boast three of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Jarlin Susana (10), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (23), and INF T.J. White (25). The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Wilmington in the first meeting on Coney Island (April 23-28), but the Blue Rocks swept the season-opening series at Frawley Stadium (April 5-7) winning the last two games in walk-off fashion... Brooklyn was 9-9 at home and 7-5 on the road against the 'Rocks in the 2023 for a 16-14 record...Since 2021, the Cyclones are 46-43 all-time against Wilmington (.517).

old is ninth in the league in batting average (.284) and stolen bases (25), and 10th in on-base percentage (.368)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.316), on-base percentage (.418), and stolen bases (36)...He also is second in hits (87) and runs scored (50), fourth in OPS (.825), tied for fourth in triples (4), and fifth in walks (41).

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with last Tuesday's game in Aberdeen, the Cy-clones have just six home games over the next 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 4-8 in the stretch...The Cyclones will play three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...Brooklyn is also amid their longest stretch without an off day during the 2024 season...After Sunday's series finale, the Cyclones will play Mon-day, July 1, through Saturday, July 6, with three games on Coney Island and another three in Hudson Valley before back-to-back days off on July 7 and 8.

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League with 29 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer**'s (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (66) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (66) and is fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (138).

In swiped bags (138). **ZILCH, ZERO, NADA:** RHPs **Kodai Senga** (2.2 IP) and **Kade Morris** (6.1) com-bined on a four-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked the Renegades, 4-0, on Wednesday...A night before, RHPs **Jonah Tong** (5.0 IP), **Ben Simon** (3.0), and **Jake Stevenson** (1.0) combined on a two-hitter in a 7-0 triumph vs. Hudson Valley...Cyclones pitching threw 20.1 consecutive scoreless innings between OF **Garrett Martin**'s solo home run in the eighth inning on Monday and DH **Omar Martinez**'s three-run blast in the first inning on Thursday...Brooklyn's longest scoreless stretch of the year is 23.2 frames from June 1-5 at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season... The Cyclones then erned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aber-deen, respectively...Each of Brooklyn's last three victories has come in shutout fashion...RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (6.0 IP) and **Josh Hejka** (3.0) united on a three-hit blanking in a 7-0 rout at Aberdeen last Friday...With Wednesday's win, Brooklyn now has 10 shutouts, the second most by a South Atlantic League pitching staff in 2024 trailing only Rome (13)...It is also tied for third most throughout Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones' single-season shutout record is 11 set during the 2023 campaign. campaign.

campaign. LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...INF Nick Lorusso has mashed at Maimonides Park...In 30 home contests, the 23-year-old is hitting .367/.444/.661 with a 1.105 OPS on Co-ney Island with six home runs, 18 RBI, and 14 walks to 17 strikeouts...Lorusso leads all South Atlantic League qualifiers in home batting average (.367) and on-base percentage (.444) and trails only Greenville's OF **Brayan González** in slugging (.661) and OPS (1105)...In 38 road affairs, Lorusso hits .193/.311/.333 with a .644 OPS, adding five home runs and 23 RBI with 26 walks to 43 K's...On the other hand, OF Nick Morabito loves his time on the road...He is hitting .322/.414/.438 with a .852 OPS, adding two home runs, eight RBI, and 23 stolen bases...Since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (39) and stolen bases (23) in the circuit...He is also third in runs scored (27)...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collect-ed a .224/.289/.250 line with a .539 OPS, two extra-base hits, two RBI, and two stolen bases over 18 games...INF Junior Tilien has also thrived at home posting a .309/.366/.455 mark with a .821 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 31 games... On the road, Tilien is hitting .169/.270/.246 with a .516 OPS, a home run, and seven runs batted in over 33 contests.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF Jesús Báez (9), RHP Jonah Tong (15), RHP Kade Morris (23), RHP Jack Wenninger (26), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), Wilfredo Lara (24), and OF Nick Morabito (26).

PROSPECT RANKINGS: Wenninger is ranked as the New ^{6/}_{6/} York Mets' No. 26 prospect at mid-season by *Baseball* ^{6/} America.

FLORIDA STATE FIRE: Wenninger was among the best pitchers in the Florida State League prior to joining the Cyclones on Monday...At the time of his promotion, the 22-year-old ranked second in the FSL in strikeouts (89)... Wenninger was also tied for fifth in innings pitched (71.2), seventh in WHIP (1.26), eighth in batting average against (.238), and ninth in ERA (5.02)...He was also first in xFIP (3.06), third in strikeout rate (28.7%) and strikeout-to-walk rate (21.3%), sixth in walk rate (7.4%).

2023: Wenninger signed with the Mets for \$225,000 on July 14...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 22...Tossed a scoreless inning of relief, striking out one, that day at the FCL Cardinals...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 5...Started vs. Daytona that day...Took a no-decision after allowing two runs on one hit, walking two, and striking out three, in 1.1 innings.

ILLI-NOISE: Wenninger had an outstanding final campaign at the University of Illinois, transferring in after spending his freshman season at Murray (Ky.) State University in 2021...During the 2023 season, the Barrington, Ill. native posted a 6-4 record with a 4.59 ERA (41 ER in 80.1 IP), 28 walks (8.30 BB%), and 76 strikeouts (22.55 K%) in 15 appearances (14 starts) for the Fighting Illini...Wenninger was All-Big Ten Second Team in 2023.

MLB DRAFT LEAGUE: Prior to being drafted by the New York Mets, Wenninger made three starts for the Williamsport (Pa.) Crosscutters in the MLB Draft League in 2023... The Crosscutters were a former foe of the Cyclones in the New York-Penn League...The 22-year-old accrued an O-1 mark with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP), seven walks, and 19 strikeouts.

FAMILY TREE: Wenninger is far from the only member of his family to play collegiate baseball...Jack's grandfather, **Robert Eckl Sr.**, and his uncle, **Robert Eckl Jr.**, both played baseball at the University of Wisconsin...The Badgers' baseball program, however, was discontinued following the 1990-91 school year.
