RIDERS DOWN WIND SURGE IN SERIES OPENER:

RIDERS DOWN WIND SURGE IN SERIES OPENER: The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Wichita Wind Surge 8-5 on Tuesday evening from Riverfront Stadium. Frisco (12-7, 56-32) started the scoring against Wichita (5-14, 36-52) starter Marco Raya (0-3) in the top of the first inning when **Cody Freeman** delivered a base hit that plated **Alejandro Osuna**. Trailing 1-0 in the bottom of the second inning. Carson McCusker worked a leadoff walk against **Ryan Garcia** (7-4) and later came around to score on an RBI single by Ben Ross, evening the game at 1-1. The RoughRiders then sent nine batters to the plate in the top of the third inning. Josh Hatcher highlighted the frame with a three-run homer, his seventh long ball of the season. **Keyber Rodriguez** capped off the four-run frame with an RBI single, scoring **Abimelec Ortiz** to give Frisco a 5-1 advantage. Wichita got a run back in the bottom of the fifth with an RBI double by Jefferson Morales, cutting the Riders lead to 5-2. Garcia gave way to **Skylar Hales** following the fifth inning, finishing his day after surrendering two runs on four hits and three walks with five punchouts across 5.0 innings. **Aaron Zavala** notched a two-out double in the top of the seventh inning, later scoring on an RBI single by **Maximo Acroat Frainver Chavez** extended the Firso lead to 8-2 with a two-run double Hales worked scoring on an RB single by **Maximo Acosta. Frainyer Chavez** extended the Frisco lead to 8-2 with a two-run double. Hales worked a 1-2-3 inning with a pair of strikeouts before handing the reins over to **Robby Ahlstrom**, who tossed a scoreless bottom of the seventh. In the bottom of the ninth inning, Tanner Schobel worked a bases loaded walk against **Seth Clark**. Tyler Dearden added an RBI single to cut the Riders lead to 8-5, but Clark ended the threat with a strikeout to secure the win. Offensively, Frisco notched 12 hits with Hatcher, Ortiz, Acosta and Chavez each collecting two-hit nights. Hatcher's three RBI paced the Riders as Chavez also drove in a pair of runs.

THANK YOU, KELLEN:

On Saturday, Kellen Strahm was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock after spending the last two and a half years in Frisco. The outfield-er finished his RoughRiders career ninth in franchise history in games played (294), ninth in hits (279), second in runs scored (197), T-10th in 2B (44) and second in walks (174). Over his time with Frisco, he slashed .265/.371/.373/.744.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 31-13 at Riders Field this season. Their 31 wins and .705 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and second among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +71 run differential, a 3.70 ERA and is averaging 5.7 runs per game with a .749 OPS. OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 14 games, he is hitting .316 (18-for-57)/.381/.579/.960 with five doubles, two triples, two home runs and eight RBIs. Over his last 11 games, he is batting .341 (15-for-44)/.420/.636/1.056 with five doubles, two triples, two home runs and 11 RBIs. Two Fridays ago, he went 2-for-5 with a triple and a home run, tying his career-high with five RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .417 (5-for-12) with three doubles and a 1.167 OPS for the Riders.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman has been one of the best hitters on the RoughRiders this season. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.288/.437/.735), he has been hot in July. Over his last 11 games, he is hitting .302 (13-for-43)/.367/.465/.832 with four doubles, a home run, 10 RBIs and four runs scored. This season, he has a career highs in average (.276), slugging percentage (.457) and OPS (.789) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (72) and home runs (17).

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.09 ERA, which is also the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Both in their series opener and series finale against Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday and Sunday, the bullpen allowed six runs. Those six runs were the most the the bullpen had allowed in a game since April 23rd against Amarillo. That tied for the second-most allowed, with nine runs allowed in the second game of the season (4/6 at Wichita) marking the most. In that series against Northwest Arkansas, Frisco had a bullpen 4.99 ERA while their 4.45 ERA out of the bullpen in July is their highest out of a single month all season.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

-Signed in 2020 for \$10,000 at age 18 (which is much older than the normal 16-year-old international signing age for most Dominican players).

-Routinely touches triple digits with his fastball.

-Comps to Yordano Ventura because of small frame and electric stuff. Changeup has splitterlike action to it.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation and as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization according to MLB.com

-After allowing four runs over 2.2 innings in first start, has gone 2-0 with 1.20 ERA over last six starts (4ER/30.0IP).

-He allowed two doubles in his first start and did not allow any extra-base hits after until 5/26, when he surrendered a solo home run.

-Tied career-high with 11 strikeouts on 6/16 vs. AMA.

-Participated in the 2024 Futures Game. As the starter for the American League at Globe Life Field, he became the first pitcher in Futures Game history to throw two perfect innings, retiring all six batters he faced on 14 pitches (6 in the first inning, 8 in the second) with one strikeout.
