PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 30 games over .500 with an overall 73-43 record (.629 winning percentage).

- 73 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, just behind 74 from the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .629 winning percentage overall this year is the 2nd-best in the Minors ... the top team in Minor League Baseball is Sugar Land (74-43 / .632).
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- Omaha is currently on pace for 93 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season ... over 54 seasons of Triple-A Omaha baseball, there have been seven 80-win seasons, most recently the 2012 (83 wins) and 2015 (80 wins) Storm Chasers.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

70 of Omaha's 116 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less (60%), including 27 of 43 losses in 2024, with 14 of 43 losses by just one run (33%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 12 of its last 24 save opportunities, since June 5 (50%).
- Omaha is 22-14 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as tied for the 4th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... two teams lead MiLB with 24 1-run wins.
- Omaha's 32 saves are tied for the most in the league, tied 2nd-most at the Triple-A level and tied 8th in the Minors ... Evan Sisk has recorded the team's last 6 saves.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 643 to 514 this season, a +129 run differential.

- A +129 run differential this year ranks as the both the mark in the International League and at the Triple-A level as well, well ahead of Tacoma (+100).
- Omaha is 6th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers lead the Minors in run differential at +145 (571 to 426).

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 40 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (55%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- Omaha has trailed for 3 innings or more in 16 of the 40 comeback wins.
- The Storm Chasers have 6 wins where the club had to overcome multiple deficits.
- Omaha has 11 victories in games where the Chasers trailed after the 6th inning.
- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 11 occasions.

KICKSTART MY GAME

Storm Chaser starting pitchers have been some of the best in Triple-A in August.

- Omaha's starters have combined for a 2.12 ERA (17 ER in 72.1 IP) over 14 games this month, best in Triple-A this month ... a 0.98 WHIP is also the best in Triple-A.
- Omaha has a quality start in 6 of 14 games this month, with 2 each from Daniel Lynch IV and Noah Cameron ... 10 of 14 August starts have been at least 5.0 innings.
- 72.1 innings this month from Omaha's starters rank as the 5th-most in Minor League Baseball ... in the 2nd half, 27 of Omaha's 43 starts have been at least 5.0 innings.

WEEKEND AT STORMY'S

Throughout 2024, weekend games have been Omaha's strongest time of the week but especially so recently.

- Omaha has combined to go 30-7 in Saturday & Sunday games in 2024.
- Over the last five weeks, the Storm Chasers have gone a perfect 10-0 on Saturday and Sunday dating back to July 13 and the team has gone 12-1 on those two days in the second half of the season.
- Since July 13, Omaha has outscored its opponents 83-23 in the weekend games.
- Omaha has won Saturday AND Sunday in 13 of the team's 16 6-game series this year.

TODAY'S START

- Champlain is making his 14th start with Omaha, his 15th Triple-A appearance and his 21st overall start this season ...
Chandler opened the season at Double-A and made 7 starts for NW Arkansas before being promoted to Omaha on May 20.
In 2024, ranked tied 1st among Royals Minor League pitchers in starts (20), 3rd in innings pitched (105.0) and tied 3rd in strikeouts (103) ... he is 10th among Royals full-season qualifiers in WHIP (1.30).

LAST START: SUNDAY, AUGUST 11 vs. IOWA

Came one out shy of a quality start, allowed just 1 unearned run over 5.2 innings and took a no-decision ... struck out 9, his most in a start with Omaha this season ... opened the game with 2 scoreless innings, including a 1-2-3 inning in the 2nd ... an error and two singles plated a run for the Cubs in the 3rd ... worked scoreless 4th and 5th innings, then got the first two outs of the 6th but issued a two-out walk that ended his start ... that baserunner was caught stealing once the reliever entered to end the inning.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Struggled in his season debut in Double-A on April 7 vs. Tulsa (LAD), tied a career-high with 8 runs allowed in just 2.2 innings, but threw at least 5.0 innings and did not allow more than two runs in each of his final 6 Double-A starts, including three quality starts.
At the time of his promotion to Triple-A, ranked 4th in the Double-A Texas League in strikeouts (48) and 2nd among qualifiers in WHIP (0.92) ... ranked 2nd on the Naturals staff in ERA (3.50), opponents' average (.203) and strikeouts (48).
Worked career-best 12.1-inning scoreless streak that spanned his last two starts in Double-A, May 9 vs. Springfield (STL) and May 15 @ Arkansas (SEA), a stretch where he allowed 6 hits and 1 walk while striking out 17.
Has thrown 7 quality starts this year in his 20 total starts, 3 at NW Arkansas (AA) and 4 for Omaha (AAA) ... 3 of his 4 quality starts with the Storm Chasers have come at Werner Park, those 3 came in his first 6 Triple-A appearances.
Made his first relief appearance with Omaha August 7 vs. Iowa, allowed a run on a homer over 2.0 innings and earned the win.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023
Split the season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA), combined to go 11-8 with a 3.33 ERA (50 ER in 135.1 IP) and 125 strikeouts over 25 starts.
Totalled 13 quality starts of his 25 starts across two teams in 2023, the most of any Royals Minor League pitcher and tied for the 3rd-most among all Minor League pitchers ... the closest in the organization was Brady Singer's 9 quality starts in the big leagues.
Opened the year in High-A and made 6 quality starts of his 11 with the River Bandits, including 7.0 shutout innings on June 16 at Beloit (MIA), his final outing before being promoted to Double-A on June 20.
Fired a pair of scoreless starts with NWA, including 6.0 hitless innings on July 27 at Arkansas (SEA) ... combined no-hit-effort continued into the 9th before a leadoff single ended the bid ... recognized as the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for this start.
Threw a season-high 8.0 innings with 8 strikeouts on August 2 at Springfield (STL), holding the Cardinals to 2 runs on 98 pitches.
2022
Pitched 16 games (15 starts) for the Tampa Tarpons (A) before being acquired by the Kansas City Royals with RHP Beck Way and LHP T.J. Sikkema in exchange for OF Andrew Benintendi ... finished the year in Quad Cities (A+), where he pitched 8 games (7 starts) ... between the two teams in his first pro season, pitched 24 games (22 starts) with a 5.98 ERA (70 ER in 105.1 IP) and 116 strikeouts.
Threw a season-high 6.1 innings in the Minor League Field of Dreams Game on August 9 vs. Cedar Rapids (MIN) in Dyersville, Iowa ... allowed 2 runs on 6 hits with no walks and 7 strikeouts, pitching for the "Davenport Blue Sox" in the nationally televised game on MLB Network ... said after the game, "In my baseball career, it was the best day of my life."

- 2021
Drafted by the New York Yankees is the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft, out of the University of Southern California (USC) ... did not pitch professionally in his first summer after the draft, instead worked with the Yankees to refine his pitches.

COLLEGE (2019-21)
Pitched collegiately at the University of Southern California and went 5-8 with a 5.31 ERA (75 ER in 127.0 IP) and 107 strikeouts in 36 games (21 starts) over three years on campus with the Trojans (Pac-12).

MISCELLANEOUS

- 2018: Graduated from Santa Margarita Catholic High School (Calif.), where he played three years of varsity baseball and was a three-time All-Trinity League selection ... as a senior, hit .387 and had 63 strikeouts in 58 innings on the mound.
Named a 2017 Under Armour All-American and pitched a scoreless 7th inning under the tutelage of National Team Manager Wes Helms in the game on July 29 at Wrigley Field ... opposed Bobby Witt Jr., who played on the American Team.
Selected by the Los Angeles Angels in the 38th round of the 2018 MLB Draft but elected not to sign and instead pursue his education and play collegiately at Southern California ... was the 120th-ranked prospect in the 2018 draft class.
In college, listed his hobbies as surfing, fishing, golfing and spending time with friends, also noting he hopes to one day visit every MLB stadium.
