vs. the Durham Bulls (Tampa Bay Rays) at Coolray Field. It is the eighth of 18 games between the two clubs this season, and the second of 12 games to be played in Georgia. Today is Summer Splash Down (special 162:05 PM game for area youth camps).

VS. DURHAM: Gwinnett is 63-60 (.512) in 123 games vs. Durham all-time at Coolray Field, but winless in its last three contests dating back to 8/14/21 (outscored 21-4 in that stretch). The Stripers are 7-4-1 in season home series vs. the Bulls dating back to 2009, including 2-0-1 over the last three seasons (2018-21).

SCORING DROUGHT: The Stripers enter play looking to snap a 19.0-inning scoring drought. Gwinnett hasn't scored since Pat Valaika's solo home run led off the eighth on Saturday vs. Charlotte (5-3 win). It's the team's longest scoring drought since a Gwinnett-record 29.2-inning stretch from 4/15-4/20, 2022 (had 3-straight shutout losses).

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead the International League in strikeouts with 852 in 85 games (10.02 SO per game). That's 20 behind Round Rock of the Pacific . Coast League (872 SO in 85G) for the most in Triple-A. Gwinnett has not led Triple-A in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1,223 SO in 143G). Kyle Muller (1st, 110), Tucker Davidson (4th, 83), Huascar Ynoa (T-6th, 77), and Bryce Elder (T-16th, 66) all rank among IL leaders in strikeouts.

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. went 1-for-4 with a single last night, meaning he has reached base safely in 48 of 58 games (82.8%) with a plate appearance this season. He's batting .267 (44-for-165, 6 2B, 1 HR, 25 R, 16 RBI, 742 OPS) in his first season with Gwinnett, leading the club in both stolen bases (18, T-9th in IL) and walks (42, T-12th in IL).

DEMERITTE ALWAYS ON: Travis Demeritte has reached base safely in 173 of 204 career games (84.8%) with Gwinnett since 2019, batting .277 (195-for-705, 51 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 131 R, 139 RBI, 17 SB, .913 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

TARNOK MAKES TRIPLE-A DEBUT TODAY: RHP Freddy Tarnok, Atlanta's No. 6 prospect according to MLB.com, makes his Triple-A debut as the Stripers' starting pitcher today. Tarnok was promoted to Gwinnett from Double-A Mississippi on 7/8 after going 2-2 with a 4.31 ERA (30 ER in 62.2 IP), .228 BAA, and 10.77 SO/9.0 IP ratio (75 SO) in 15 starts. Over his final four starts with the M-Braves from 6/18-7/7, he went 1-0 with a 1.71 ERA and .184 BAA.

• Triple-A Debuts: Tarnok will be the seventh player to PROSPECTING: Gwinnett's active roster features six listed make his Triple-A debut for Gwinnett this year, joining OF Justin Dean, OF Greyson Jenista, INF Braden Shewmake, RHP Victor Vodnik, RHP Allan Winans, and RHP William Woods

TODAY: The Stripers play game two of a six-game series **TUI TO THE FUTURES GAME:** On 7/7, MLB announced the rosters and coaching staffs for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game on 7/16 at Dodger Stadium. Stripers manager Matt Tuiasosopo has been selected as the third base coach for the National League Team, led by former MLB manager Mike Scioscia. Tuiasosopo will be the first active Gwinnett coach to particiate in a Futures Game.

> THE ELDER STROLLS: Bryce Elder matched his career high with 8.0 innings on 7/9 vs. Charlotte (6 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 SO), earning the win. It was his second career 8.0-IP outing, first since 5/30/22 vs. Louisville (2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 8 SO in 2-0 win). Elder is the first Stripers pitcher to win consecutive starts this season (2-0, 2.63 ERA, 4 ER in 13.2 IP, 1.10 WHIP, .200 BAA in last 2 starts since 7/2).

> **MULLDOZING:** Kyle Muller recorded the fourth complete game of his career on 7/8 vs. Charlotte (G1 of DH), logging 7.0 IP (6 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 8 SO) for the win. It was his first CG since 7/23/19 with Double-A Mississippi at Jackson (6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 6 SO in 2-0 loss).

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (110) and ranks among the top five in ERA (2nd, 2.95), WHIP (2nd, 1.08), complete games (T-2nd, 1), BAA (3rd, .217), innings (3rd, 88.1), and starts (T-5th, 15).
- Pitcher of the Month: On 7/7, Muller was named the IL Pitcher of the Month for June All five of his starts during the month were quaity outings, and he went 2-1 with a league-low 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), .171 BAA, and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO).

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin threw 1.2 innings (2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 3 SO) on 7/8 vs. Charlotte, extending his team-best scoreless innings streak to 12.2 IP spanning his last 12 outings. In that stretch, he's posting a 0.71 WHIP (6 H, 3 BB), .136 BAA, 14.92 SO/9.0 IP ratio (21 SO), and three saves (3-for-3). In 26 games overall, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 1.98 ERA (6 ER in 27.1 IP), .186 BAA, 14.82 SO/9.0 IP ratio (45 SO), and six saves (6-for-7, T-11th in IL).

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel notched a gamewinning two-run single in the sixth of the Stripers' last-atbat 3-0 win on 7/8 vs. Charlotte (G2 of DH). It was just his seventh single this season, as 13 of his 20 hits (65.0%) have gone for extra bases (5 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR). For his Gwinnett career, 49.1% of his hits have been for extra bases (27 of 55, including 11 2B, 1 3B, 15 HR).

GO-GO GETTING ON TRACK: Ryan Goins is batting .400 (20-for-50, 6 2B, 6 R, 9 RBI, .984 OPS) over his last 15 games since 6/14. He has notched six multi-hit games in that span, raising his average from .143 to .216.

WATERS MOVING ON: On 7/11, the Atlanta Braves traded top prospect OF Drew Waters to Kansas City as part of a deal to acquire the No. 35 pick in the MLB Draft. The 23-year-old switch hitter batted .246 (173-for-702, 34 2B, 4 3B, 18 HR, 113 R, 64 RBI, 36 SB) in 178 games with Gwinnett since 2019. This season, Waters hit .246 (47-for-191, 7 2B, 3 3B, 5 HR, 26 R, 16 RBI, 5 SB) in 49 games.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) . In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... On 7/7/22, was selected as the third base coach for the NL Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game (7/16 at Dodger Stadium) ... Began his career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year.

TODAY'S START: Freddy Tarnok makes his Triple-A debut and 16th overall start of the season in game two of a six-game series vs. Durham.

- 7th to Debut: He is the seventh player to make his Triple-A debut for Gwinnett this year, joining OF Justin Dean, OF Greyson Jenista, INF Braden Shewmake, RHP Victor Vodnik, RHP Allan Winans, and RHP William Woods.
- 12th to Start: He is the 12th different starting pitcher for Gwinnett, and the second to make a start for his Triple-A debut this year (Winans, 4/8 at MEM).

PROSPECTING: Tarnok is ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 6 prospect by MLB.com. He is the fourth-highest ranked pitching prospect on Gwinnett's active roster, behind LHP Kyle Muller (No. 1), RHP Bryce Elder (No. 2), and LHP Tucker Davidson (No. 5).
