YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Somerset Patriots, 7-6, on a walk-off single by **Vince Fernandez** in the bottom of the 11th inning. Fernandez finished the game 4-for-5 with a homer, a double, a walk and five RBIs. Somerset opened the scoring in the top of the second on a throwing error. Fernandez gave the Flying Squirrels a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the second with a two-run homer. The Patriots tied the score, 2-2 with a homer in the third by Oswald Peraza. Fernandez put Richmond back in front, 3-2, with an RBI double in the fourth. In the sixth, Michael Beltre evened the score again with a solo homer. Somerset took a 6-3 lead in the top of the eighth with an RBI double by Jason Lopez and an error that allowed two runs to score. In the bottom of the eighth, Fernandez hit an RBI single and **Diego Rincones** evened the score at 6-6 with a two-run single. Both teams were held off the scoreboard in the 10th inning before Fernandez ended the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. This series marks the first-ever trip for the Patriots to The Diamond. From June 15-20, the Patriots won five-of-six in Bridgewater against the Flying Squirrels. This series marks the final set between the two teams this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won eight of their last 11 games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 3.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked eighth in the league with a .237 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked fourth in the league with a 3.84 ERA for the season.

THE PATRIOTS have gone 7-5 over the last 12 games. They currently lead the Northeast Division by 2.0 games over Portland. For the season, the Somerset offense has hit .243, which is sixth in the circuit. The pitching staff has a 2.93 ERA, which leads all of Minor League Baseball. Somerset is playing its first season as an affiliated team after playing in the independent Atlantic League as a founding member of the circuit from 1998-2020, winning six championships. The Somerset roster includes four players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects, including SS Oswald Peraza (No. 4, No. 97 overall), RHP Luis Medina (No. 7), LHP Ken Waldichuk (No. 27) and RHP Hayden Wesneski (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Caleb Kilian** makes his nine Double-A start and his second against Somerset. He last pitched in the first game of a double-header on Friday at Bowie and rolled through a complete-game shutout, the first in the Double-A Northeast this season, allowing just three hits. After that performance, Kilian was named Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Week on Monday. He last faced the Patriots on June 16 in Bridgewater and allowed three runs over 7.0 innings in a no-decision with nine strikeouts. He opened the season with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.25 ERA in four starts with 32 strikeouts in 21.2 innings. He was named High-A West Pitcher of the Week twice in the three weeks he spent with the Emeralds. He was drafted by the Giants in the eighth round in 2019 out of Texas Tech, where he was a First-Team All-Big 12 pitcher. **For more on Kilian, see page two.**

NO FREE PASSES: Among pitchers in the Double-A Northeast this season with at least 40.0 innings pitched, **Caleb Kilian** is ranked first in walks per 9.0 innings pitched at 1.14. He is also first in K/BB (7.83) and first in BB% (3.3). In his career, Kilian has issued just nine walks over 85.0 innings of work since his debut in 2019.

FOR SOMERSET: Left-hander JP Sears makes his sixth start of the season and his 13th overall appearance. He last pitched last Friday against Erie and allowed two runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision. Sears has faced the Flying Squirrels twice this season, both times in Bridgewater. On June 15, he worked 1.0 scoreless inning with two strikeouts. On June 18, he pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with seven strikeouts. Overall, he has struck out nine batters in 4.0 innings of work against Richmond this year. On June 6, he was named Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Week after picking up 10 strikeouts in a 5.0-inning start against Reading on June 1. Sears was drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the 11th round in 2017 out of The Citadel. That year, he was selected as an MiLB.com Mariners Organizational All-Star after posting a 0.65 ERA in 17 appearances for short-season Everett and Low-A Clinton. He was traded to the Yankees on Nov. 18, 2017 along with RHP Juan Then in exchange for RHP Nick Rumbelow.

POWER SURGE: Over the last eight games since July 6, the Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs, which is the most in the Double-A Northeast. **Vince Fernandez** has hit four homers in his seven games played during that stretch. **Heliot Ramos** and **Frankie Tostado** each have two home runs. **Andres Angulo**, **Sandro Fabian**, **Brandon Martorano**, **Andy Sugilio** and **David Villar** have each homered once in that stretch. For the season, the Flying Squirrels rank tied for seventh in the circuit with 64 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 124 home runs this season in 120 games. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Villar and Fernandez lead the team with 11 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season.

RAMOS RAKING: **Heliot Ramos** is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak. In that span, he is batting .357 (10-for-28) with three home runs, four doubles and eight RBIs while scoring seven runs. He began the season hitting .314 with three homers and 12 RBIs in 22 May games. In June, he posted a .155 batting average and homered twice with three RBIs in 26 games. Ramos is back with the Flying Squirrels this week after missing two games last weekend while traveling to Denver for the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game as part of MLB's All-Star Week festivities.

TOASTY: Over his last 29 games since June 6, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .330 (37-for-112) with seven homers, eight doubles and 30 RBIs. Last Tuesday, he hit a two-run homer in the series opener at Bowie. He has at least one extra-base hits in 10 of his last 15 games. Tostado also has two hits in each of his last two games.

BREAKING OUT: After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, **David Villar** has hit .337 (30-for-89) with six homers and 14 RBIs over his last 24 games since June 16. He added a three-run homer on Saturday night at Bowie to put the Flying Squirrels ahead in the eighth inning. For the season, Villar is tied for the team lead with 11 home runs.

SWINGING FOR THE VINCE: In his last 10 games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .500 (17-for-43) with four home runs, two doubles and 13 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked tied for first on the team with 11 homers this season and third with 29 RBIs. He has picked up multiple hits in six of his last 10 games. On Wednesday against the Patriots, Fernandez went 4-for-5 with a homer, a double, a walk and five RBIs, capping his performance with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th inning. It was the 18th five-RBI performance by a Flying Squirrels hitter in the franchise's history and the second this season.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with nine hits, six walks and six RBIs by pitchers at the plate. On the year, Richmond has gone 26-14 (.650) against National League affiliates, but have gone 6-11 (.353) against affiliates of American League clubs. After back-to-back series against National League affiliates Hartford and Binghamton, the Flying Squirrels now face American League clubs for the remaining four sets in July and will use the designated hitter.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for eighth in the Double-A Northeast with 40 RBIs and sixth with 60 hits. **Shane Matheny** is tied for fifth with 28 walks. **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for seventh in the circuit with five saves. **Joey Marciano** and **Frank Rubio** are ranked tied for fifth with 21 games pitched. **Caleb Kilian** is ranked first with two complete games and first with one shutout.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 34-28 record is tied for the second-best record in the franchise's history through 62 games, even with 2013 and 2015 and trailing only a 36-26 mark in 2014.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13), **Sean Hjelle** (14) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Five players, including Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
