### PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### KICKSTART MY GAME

**Anthony Simonelli** will serve as Omaha's opener today in a bullpen game.

- Today is Omaha's 14th bullpen game in 2024 ... the Chasers are 10-3 in bullpen games this year, with 10 straight wins in bullpen games between May 11 and August 25.
- The chasers threw 2 bullpen games last week vs. St. Paul, August 27 and September 1 ... both were losses and **Austin Cox** served as the opener each time.
- Cox has opened 5 bullpen games this year, while **Anthony Veneziano** has opened 3 ... **Walter Pennington** and **Jonah Dipoto** have each opened 2 ... 13 of 14 openers this year have gotten through 2.0 innings, while 4 have worked through 3.0
- Today is Simonelli's 1st Triple-A start, his 8th career Minor League start ... he started 5 games in 2022 and twice in 2021, every time working as an opener ... he has thrown at least 2.0 innings in 20 of 38 outings this year, with 2 games of 3 innings.

#### IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today 28 games over .500 with an overall 81-53 record (.604 winning percentage).

- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .604 winning percentage overall this year is the 7th-best in the Minors ... two teams are tied for the best record in Minor League Baseball: Palm Beach and Tennessee are both 81-47 (.633 winning %).
- 81 wins are tied for the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, 3 behind Sugar Land ... Omaha is 1 of 5 Minor League teams with 80+ wins.
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- The 2024 Storm Chasers are on pace for 89 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990, the team is 6 wins away from breaking that record.
- The best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (.85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season.

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

80 of Omaha's 134 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less (60%), including 32 of 53 losses in 2024 (60%), with 17 of 52 losses by just one run (33%).

- Omaha is 25-17 in 1-run games this season are the Chasers are tied for the 5th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... Akron leads the Minors with 31 1-run wins.
- Omaha's 37 saves are tied for the International League lead, tied for the 2nd-most at the Triple-A level and ranked tied 9th in Minor League Baseball ... **Evan Sisk's** 12 saves overall this year ranked 4th in the league ... he has 10 of the team's last 11 saves.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 718 to 592 this season, a +126 run differential.

- A +126 run differential this year ranks both as the best mark in the International League and at the Triple-A level, ahead of Sugar Land (+115).
- Omaha ranks 9th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Midland Rockhounds lead the Minors in run differential at +163 (636 to 473).

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 3.63 ERA, 1.33 WHIP and .216/.322/.341 opposing slash line ... the .216 opponents' batting average tied for 12th among all 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 38 games this year (including 11 times in August), roughly one in every 3.53 games in 2024 ... the bullpen also has 19 games without a walk this season, including 10 times in the 2nd half of the season.

#### HOME OF BLUES, SOUL & BEAUTIFUL STORM CHASERS

Two Storm Chasers players will be taking trips down memory lane this week, back to their hometown of Memphis Tennessee for the first time as a professional.

- Tyler Gentry** grew up just 30 miles outside of Memphis in Arlington, TN ... he went to Arlington High School then to Walters State Community College in East Tennessee.
- Jonathan Bowlan** is also a native of Arlington ... he spent three years at Arlington HS before transferring to Bartlett HS for his senior year ... went on to play three years of college baseball at the University of Memphis and pitched 4 games at AutoZone Park.
