**RHP Andre Sanchez (0-3, 6.43 ERA) vs. RHP Christian Zazueta (3-1, 3.03 ERA)**

**TODAY'S GAME:** Welcome to LoanMart Field! Earlier today, local little leaguers enjoyed a free baseball clinic with Quakes' players and coaches, thanks to U.S. Bank! Kids will also "Run the Bases" after today's game, thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. Game time is 2pm. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE 66ERS:** Today's game is the 12th of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the sixth of 12 here at home. Last year, the Quakes went 7-5 here at home against the 66ers, 17-7 overall. Four out of five in this series, coupled with five of six in San Bernardino in late-April gives the Quakes a 9-2 mark against the 66ers through 11 games.

**LAST GAME:** Inland Empire held Rancho to a series-low three runs on just six hits, earning their first win of the series with a 7-3 victory over the Quakes on Saturday night at LoanMart Field. Despite the presence of rehabbing Dodger Teoscar Hernandez, the Quakes left 12 men on base and saw their six-game win streak snapped. Angels' rehabbing reliever Robert Stephenson (1-0) worked a 1-2-3 fourth inning and was credited with the win, while Rancho reliever Felix Cabrera (1-4) got hit with the loss. Jorge Ruiz had three hits and two runs scored for the 66ers. Samuel Munoz had two hits and a run scored for Rancho. Despite the loss, the Quakes have already won the series (four-of-five).

**TEOSCAR RECAP:** Dodger outfielder Teoscar Hernandez becomes the first rehabbing player of 2025. Hernandez has been sidelined since May 6 with a left groin strain and finished last night's game with two walks and a strikeout in three total plate appearances. He's expected to be activated on Monday. The Dodgers signed him in 2024 to a one-year deal, before winning the World Series and then resigning him to a three-year deal with a club option in 2028. Hernandez played for the Lancaster JetHawks in the Cal League back in 2014, where he hit .294 with 17 homers and 75 RBIs.

**ALL GOOD THINGS...:** Last night's loss snapped Rancho's six-game win streak overall and a separate six-game win streak at home. The Quakes still have the best record in the Cal League at 27-11, a home record of 16-4 and have won 18 of their last 22 games overall. Rancho's best record in a single half was in the second half of the 2018 season, when they went 52-18 and finished a whopping 15 games ahead of second-place Lancaster. That 2018 season also marked their last Cal League Championship, their third in franchise history and second as a Dodgers' affiliate.

**OFFENSIVE OUTBURST:** The offense slowed down on Saturday with just three runs on six hits, but the Quakes put up some remarkable numbers offensively over the first four games in this series. They set a franchise record with 25 runs in Tuesday's series-opener and scored a total of 55 runs on 59 hits over their first 32 offensive innings this week. They also scored in 21 of those 32 innings prior to last night. Rancho's offense is currently first in the league with a team average of .274 and a league-best 33 home runs in 38 games.

**CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA:** Right-hander Christian Zazueta makes his eighth start of the year and his third against Inland Empire. In two games against the 66ers, he's 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA, including a win in his last start this past Tuesday, when he allowed three runs on three hits over five innings. Last year in Rancho, Zazueta went 1-5 with a 6.36 ERA over 14 games (11 starts) and 52.1 innings. Zazueta signed with the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico and then was traded to the Dodgers in February of 2024 in the trade that saw former Quake Caleb Ferguson go to the Yankees.

**ANDRE SANCHEZ:** Right-hander Andre Sanchez makes his ninth appearance, his eighth start, and his third start against the Quakes. In two games against Rancho, he's 0-1 with a 14.03 ERA, including a loss this past Tuesday, when he allowed 10 runs (eight earned) on seven hits over just 3.1 innings. In 2024, Sanchez went 3-8 with a 6.88 ERA over 24 games (19 starts) for the 66ers. The Angels signed Sanchez out of Cordoba, Mexico in May of 2022.
