NEWS AND NOTES

HIT CITY START: Left-hander **Shane Drohan** will make his first career Sounds start tonight against the Charlotte Knights at First Horizon Park. Drohan appeared in 15 games (14 starts) between two minor league teams during the 2025 season and posted a 5-1 record with a 2.27 ERA in 47.2 innings pitched with Triple-A Worcester. The Brewers' no.25 prospect was briefly sent on a rehab assignment while recovering from injury and started in three games for High-A Greenville, posting an 8.53 ERA in 6.1 innings.

I AM SPEED: The Nashville Sounds baserunning has been a thing of beauty to watch and has been highlighted by top-prospect **Jett Williams**. The Sounds baserunning have recorded nine steals during the Opening Weekend-series at Norfolk, including a team-high four stolen bases in Sunday's 6-2 win over the Tides. Williams and newly-acquired **Greg Jones** have made their mark early in the season, leading the team in stolen bases (3) and are tied for 1st in the International League with Cole Carigg (ABQ), Max Clark (TOL) and Braiden Ward (WOR).

PUTTIN' ON THE JETTS: **Jett Williams** continues to be a catalyst on the basepaths, recording a stolen base in each of the Sounds' first three games of the season. He is now tied with teammate Greg Jones for the International League lead with a steal in three straight games. The Brewers' No. 3

prospect has a proven track record of speed. In 2025, he appeared in 130 games between Double-A Binghamton and Triple-A Syracuse, swiping 34 bases. His most productive season came in 2023, when he totaled 45 stolen bases across three levels in the Mets organization.

THAT'S PRATT OF THE DEAL: Infielder Cooper Pratt continued his early-season dominance and extended his hit-streak to three consecutive games as he went 1-for-5 on the day against Norfolk. The Brewers' No. 4 prospect is currently tied with No. 3 prospect, Jett Williams, in recording the most consecutive games with a hit on the team. The last time Pratt recorded a hit in three consecutive games this early in the season was last season from April 12-15 with Double-A Biloxi. His career-high hit streak was nine games dating back to August 2-15, 2023 with the Arizona Complex League Brewers. 2026 campaign, allowing just one run on a hit and a walk while striking out two. A former Norfolk Tide (2023-2024), Stallings faced his old team with poise, building on his previous outings against them, which included one career win. Born in Heathsville, VA, just a couple hours from Harbor Park, the right-hander grew up an Orioles fan—and he showed plenty of hometown pride in taking the mound against his former club.

HIT OR BE HIT: The Sounds' offense found multiple ways to generate traffic on the bases Sunday. Along with seven hits, Nashville batters were hit by pitches four times — including three to lead off innings — helping set the tone offensively. It marked the first time since July 21, 2019, against the Iowa Cubs that the Sounds had four players hit by a pitch in a single game.

ROSTER MAKE UP: Nashville's Opening Day roster featured **10 of the top 30 prospects** in the Brewers' farm system, including a pair of Top 100 prospects in baseball in **INF Jett Williams (#3/#51)** and **INF Cooper Pratt (#4/#64)**. Williams was acquired by Milwaukee as part of the trade that sent RHP Freddy Peralta to the New York Mets on January 21 while Pratt is a homegrown prospect the Brewers took in the 6th round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft. Other top prospects including in Nashville's Opening Day Roster include: **RHP Logan Henderson (#7)**, **C Jeferson Quero (#8)**, **OF Luis Lara (#12)**, **1B/3B Luke Adams (#13)**, **LHP Robert Gasser (#17)**, **3B Brock Wilken (#22)**, **LHP Shane Drohan (#25)**, and **RHP Coleman Crow (#27)**. Half of the 28 active players to begin the season with Nashville appeared with the Sounds during the 2025 campaign.
