TODAY'S START

- Cameron is making his 8th start with Omaha and his 24th overall start this season ... after opening the season in Double-A with NW Arkansas, Noah made 16 starts for the Naturals before being promoted to Omaha on Sunday, July 28.
Threw a quality start in his first 6 Triple-A starts ... named International League Pitcher of the Month in August (5 QS).
In 2024, ranks 1st among Royals Minor League pitchers in strikeouts (139), tied 2nd in starts (23) and 5th in innings pitched (118.2)... among qualified Royals full-season arms, ranks 3rd in ERA (3.26), 5th in WHIP (1.22) and 6th in opponents' average (.243).
Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 12 Royals prospect ... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 14 Royals prospect.

LAST OUTING: SEPTEMBER 9 @ MEMPHIS

For the first time in Triple-A, did not throw a quality start, but finished 6.0 innings for the 7th time in as many outings with Omaha ... worked a 1-2-3 inning in the 1st, but allowed a solo homer to Matt Koperniak to open the 2nd inning ... worked around a walk in the 3rd, but two singles in the 4th led to a 3-run homer from Gavin Collins ... two more runs scored in the 5th for the Redbirds on a sacrifice fly and solo homer from Nolan Gorman ... worked a scoreless 6th to end his day ... tied a season-high with 6 R, career-high with 3 HR.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Started opening day for Double-A Northwest Arkansas, but took the loss, allowed 2 earned runs over 4.2 innings on April 5 vs. Tulsa (LAD) ... finished 5.0 innings in 10 of 16 starts with the Naturals, including five straight after the season opener.
On the Injured List from May 10 to May 30 with left forearm tightness, missed 18 games with NW Arkansas.
Threw a pair of quality starts with NWA: June 29 @ Wichita (MIN) and July 19 vs. Tulsa (LAD), both within the span of his last 5 at the Double-A level ... struck out 7+ on 6 occasions ... worked 3 scoreless starts with NW Arkansas.
Compiled a streak of 29.1 inning without allowing a batter between July 11 (3rd inning) and August 13 (3rd inning) ... streak spanned 4 full starts (last 2 in AA, first 2 in AAA) and parts of 2 more starts ... his previous best in 2024 was 8.0 innings in April.
Named the International League's August Pitcher of the Month ... went 2-1 with a 1.71 ERA (6 ER in 31.2 IP) over five starts (all quality starts) as he allowed 8 walks while striking out 36 ... held opponents to a .180 average.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023
Spit the season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA) and combined to go 5-12 over 24 starts between the two levels, with a 5.28 ERA (63 ER in 107.1 IP) and 132 strikeouts to just 35 walks (3.77 K/BB).
Ranked 3rd among Royals Minor League pitchers in strikeouts (132), tied 4th in starts (24) and tied 9th in innings pitched (107.1) ... among those in the system with at least 100.0 innings pitched, ranked 1st in K/9 (11.07) and K/BB (3.77).
Made the first 4 quality starts of his professional career, two with each the River Bandits and Naturals ... in his Double-A debut on May 24 at Tulsa (LAD), threw a career-high 7.0 shutout innings with just 3 hits and 1 walk allowed and 6 strikeouts.
After taking a no-decision in his Double-A debut, lost his next seven NWA starts, between May 30 and July 20 ... in that span where he went 0-7, produced a 8.03 ERA (22 ER in 24.2 IP) with a .317 opponents' average (32-for-101).
2022
Made his professional debut and largely split the season between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), with a stint on the 7-Day Injured List and rehab stint with the ACL Royals (R) as well ... between the three levels, combined to go 2-3 across 19 starts, with a 3.56 ERA (26 ER in 65.2 IP) with 16 walks to 99 strikeouts (6.19 K/BB).
Named a Royals MiLB.com Organization All-Star, tied for 7th in the system in strikeouts (99) ... among Royals Minor League pitchers with at least 60.0 innings, ranked 1st in K/9 (13.57), K/BB, K% (36.7%) and had the 2nd-lowest WHIP (1.13) and 3rd-lowest ERA.
In his High-A debut on May 22 at Dayton (CIN), set a career-high with 12 strikeouts over 4.0 innings of work ... all 12 outs he recorded came via the punchout, working around 3 hits (1 homer) and a walk that produced 2 runs.
After 6 starts with the River Bandits, landed on the 7-Day Injured List on July 4 with a minor shoulder injury, before being activated August 14, missing 32 games ... made 3 rehab starts with the ACL Royals between August 2 and 11 with a 3.18 ERA (2 ER in 5.2 IP).

Drafted by the Royals in the 7th round of the 2021 MLB Draft, out of Central Arkansas ... did not pitch professionally after being drafted (or during the college season), underwent Tommy John surgery in August 2020 ... one of three local products KC drafted in '21.

Pitched in two seasons for the University of Central Arkansas, going a combined 7-3 with a 2.86 ERA (39 ER in 122.2 IP) and 122 strikeouts to 21 walks across 18 starts for the Bears (Southland Conference).
Made 3 starts with the William Stingers in the Northwest's League during the summer of 2020 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in August 2020, which kept him out of action in 2021.
Named a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball in 2019 and earned second-team All-Southland honors.

2018: Graduated from Central High School (Mo.) where he was a three-time First-Team All-Conference pitcher and first baseman ... a four-sport athlete in high school was also a punter in football, goalie in soccer and shooting forward in basketball.
Grew up a Kansas City Royals fan, just an hour north of Kauffman Stadium in St. Joseph, Missouri and would attend two or three games a year at the "K."
