HOW IS IT ALREADY AUGUST?: After picking up the first win of this 12-game South Carolina road trip, the FredNats aim to even the series with the Columbia Fireflies (Kansas City Royals) in the first game of August. The road trip has reached the quarter mile mark, and tonight, RHP Luke Johnson makes his third FredNat start and second since becoming a full-time FredNat a couple weeks ago. Johnson threw four scoreless innings in his first road FredNat start in Salem in June. He faces Columbia righty Jose Gutierrez. Fredericksburg enters play today 2.5 games out of first place in the Carolina League North in the second half.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The FredNats got four scoreless innings from Liam Sullivan in his second start back with Fredericksburg, and the FredNats leaned on the outfield veterans Elijah Green and Brenner Cox to deliver a 5-2 win, Fredericksburg's first of the road trip. Cox opened the scoring with an RBI double in the 3rd, and then Green's bases-clearing double in teh 5th was the big swing. Kevin Dowdell and Merrick Baldo threw scoreless relief outings for Fredericksburg.

JULY RECAP: For the second straight month, Fredericksburg finished three games over .500 with a 12-9 record in July. Fredericksburg had its best month offensively in July, posting a .643 team OPS. Fredericksburg's bullpen continued to excel, posting the sixth-best ERA in July in Single-A baseball (3.31). Cristhian Vaquero and Jorgelys Mota paced the FredNats offensively in the month, with Vaquero hitting .329 with a .914 OPS, and Mota hitting .404 with a .956 OPS.

WHY TRY IT?: After picking up two more caught stealings last night, Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 77. Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB by seven with 50 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 42% of would-be base stealers. Bazzell also had his best month of the season offensively in July, hitting .288 with a .383 on-base percentage.

**THE GREEN MONSTER**: Elijah Green hit his first home run since returning to Fredericksburg Tuesday night, traveling 414 feet to the deepest part of the cavernous Segra Park. Since returning to Fredericksburg, Green has cut his strikeout rate by 15%, and in this series, he has that aforementioned home run, an RBI triple, and in last night's game, his three-run double was the difference in a 5-2 win for Fredericksburg. Overall, half of Green's hits since coming back to Fredericksburg have gone for extra bases.

**THIS BULLPEN IS INSANE**: The FredNat bullpen has been central to the team's efforts all season, but the group has taken it to a new level since June 1. Since then, FBG's bullpen ERA is 2.67, which is currently number four in professional baseball (150 total teams). Fredericksburg is 35-1 when leading after seven innings this season, and 29-1 when leading after eight innings. Fredericksburg's 15 saves in that time frame is also tied for the fourth-most in Minor League Baseball.

**HE'S INEVITABLE**: FredNat outfield prospect Cristhian Vaquero picked up his MiLB-leading fourth walk-off hit of the season Saturday night, and overall, he's enjoyed a very strong second half of the season offensively, pairing his hot bat with his exceptional outfield defense. In 26 second half games, Vaquero is hitting .340 (3rd in CL) with four home runs (3rd), and he leads the league with a .948 OPS in the half. He also leads the league in the second half in slugging (.563), total bases (58), and he's tied for second in hits (35). Since the All-Star break, Vaquero is 15-for-31 (.484) with a 1.112 OPS.

**THE STAFF:** After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

**LUKE WARM:** Lucas Emanuel Johnson...promoted to Fredericksburg for the second time this season on 7/23. The Nationals selected Johnson in the 10th round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC).

**LAST TIME OUT:** In his second career FredNat start, Johnson allowed six hits and three earned runs in 3.1 IP against the Fayetteville Woodpeckers last week. Johnson got the loss, the first in his Single-A career, in an eventual 5-0 defeat.

**PALM BALL:** In two long stints, Johnson excelled in the Florida Complex League to begin his professional career this year. The righty made 14 appearances and two starts, posting a 1.23 ERA across 36.2 IP. He allowed only five earned runs, tallying 36 strikeouts to just 14 walks. He won the FCL's Pitcher of the Week award at the end of May.

**GOLDEN RETRIEVER:** Johnson pitched four seasons for the UMBC Retrievers, completing his career as UMBC's all-time program leader in strikeouts. He won the America East Pitcher of the Year award twice, becoming the only player in the award's 34-year history to win it outright twice. He posted a career 4.61 ERA in 288.2 IP with 279 K's. As a Junior in 2023, he had an ERA of 2.96 in just under 80 innings. His selection marked the first time a Retriever was selected in the MLB Draft since 2016.

## **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



#### JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



#### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



#### LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
