#### **SHRIMP HOLD ON FOR 4-3 WIN**

Matthew Etzel homered and reached base four times as Jacksonville toppled Memphis 4-3. Mike Antico got the scoring started with an RBI single in the second for the Redbirds. Etzel's two-run homer in the fourth put the Jumbo Shrimp ahead. Connor Norby added a sacrifice fly in the fifth and an RBI ground out in the seventh to make it 4-1. Memphis plated two runs on Cesar Prieto's double in the ninth, but the Redbirds could not get any closer as Josh White picked up his third save of the season. Matt Pushard tossed 2.0 scoreless innings of relief as well.

#### THE BOOK OF MORGAN

It took Morgan McSweeney 22.0 innings to finally allow his first tally with the Jumbo Shrimp, the best scoreless streak for a Jacksonville pitcher since Sixto Sánchez went 24.0 consecutive scoreless frames in 2019. Through 11 outings with Jacksonville. McSweenev has only vielded 11 earned runs in 50.0 innings (1.98 ERA). Among the 309 IL pitchers who have logged at least 30.0 innings this season, McSweeney has the seventh-lowest swinging-strike rate (7.7 percent), 11th-lowest line drive rate (17.4 percent) and 14th-lowest BABIP (.233). That said, he ranks 12th in ERA.

#### **DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS**

While the club has made 121 errors, the fifth-most in Triple-A, Jacksonville's rangy defense has helped the club yield the second-fewest hits and second-fewest runs at the level this season. The Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A in defensive efficiency, which simply measures how many batted balls put into play that are turned into outs, at .714, meaning they have turned 71.4 percent of balls put in play into outs. That figure would also rank 10th in MLB.

#### FOR IT'S ONE, TWO, THREE STRIKES, YOU'RE OUT

The Jumbo Shrimp have recorded double-digit strikeouts in 20 of the 34 games the club has played since August 5. During this stretch, Jacksonville has racked up 346 punchouts (10.2 per game), the second-most in Triple-A. Thirteen of the club's top 27 strikeout games this season have come in the last 34 games. The Jumbo Shrimp registered 17 strikeouts on September 6 at Charlotte, their most in a game since August 10, 2024, when they compiled 18 punchouts at Toledo

#### FORMULA ONE

With a 29-14 (.674) record in one-run games, Jacksonville is tied with Indianapolis for the most one-run victories in all of Minor League Baseball. The 29 one-run triumphs are the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp are 54-32 (.628) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 64.3 percent of their 84 victories have come by those slim margins.

#### AHOY, EIGHTY(-FOUR)!

At 84-57 (.596), Jacksonville's 84 wins are the most in Triple-A. Those 84 triumphs are Jacksonville's most in a season since 2006, when the Jacksonville Suns registered an 86-54 (.614) record. Jacksonville's .596 winning percentage this season is also the club's best since those 2006 Suns.

#### THE CHICKS DIG IT

Thanks to Matthew Etzel's home run on Thursday, Jacksonville has now bashed long balls in 12 consecutive games dating back to August 30, their second-longest streak this season. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp have bashed 18 round-trippers, the most in Triple-A. Comparatively, the club hit just 16 home runs in the 23 games from August 2-28, the fewest at the Triple-A level.

#### YOUTH IS SERVED

Among position players on the club's active roster, only three Jumbo Shrimp (Jacob Berry, Devvison De Los Santos and Joe Mack) have played in more than one-third of Jacksonville's 140 games thus far in 2025. The other nine non-rehabbing players have combined for a total of just 151 games in Triple-A this season. Eight of those nine players have been called up from Double-A Pensacola since August 2, and none of those eight have tallied more than 30 games. thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp.

#### SHRIMP BITES

With 289 stolen bases, Jacksonville ranks second in Triple-A and ninth in MiLB in steals. The Shrimp mustered only 86 steals in 2024, 29th in Triple-A and 119th in all of MiLB... After six losses in seven games, the Jumbo Shrimp have won eight of their last 11 contests... Kemp Alderman is batting .317/.356/.805/1.161 in his first 10 Triple-A games.

#### **ABOUT MORGAN**

- -McSweeney was originally drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 17th round of the 2019 draft out of Wake Forest University.
- -In high school, the right-hander was cut from the team at St. John's High School (Shrewsbury, Mass.) prior to his junior year. He transferred to Worcester Academy, where he earned two letters and a scholarship to Wake Forest.
- -During his college career, McSweeney pitched in 57 games, including 22 starts. He posted a 10-10 record and 5.24 ERA. His 12 K/9 in a season is the 12th-best in Wake Forest school history.
- -From 2019-24, McSweeney pitched in 137 games in the Baltimore Orioles' organization, all in relief. He was released on July 10, 2024 and finished that campaign as a starter with Gastonia of the Independent Atlantic League (2-1, 4.19 ERA in eight starts). He began the 2025 campaign with Staten Island in the same league, going 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA in 10 starts before signing with Miami.

#### 2025 SEASON

- -Went 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA in 10 starts for the Staten Island Ferryhawks in the Atlantic League.
- -As Ferryhawks ace, posted 41 punch outs in 54.0 innings.
- -Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on June 26, 2025. In his first start for Jacksonville on June 28 vs. Nashville, went a career-high 6.2 shutout innings, striking out four and scattering four hits and one walk. The start was his first in the minor leagues after 137 career appearances in relief.
