Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Indianapolis Indians play the fifth of a six-game set tonight at First Horizon Park. Bowden Francis tossed 7.0 dominant, shutout innings and the offense tallied a 5-run third inning, 4-run sixth inning and a 5-run eighth as the Nashville Sounds pummeled the Indianapolis Indians, 14-1, in front of a crowd of 9,541 Friday night at First Horizon Park. Right-hander Alec Bettinger starts for Nashville against right-hander Max Kranick for Indianapolis.

Alec Bettinger: 25-year-old Alec Bettinger makes his fourth appearance (third start) for Nashville. He has gone 1-1 with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER/8.1 IP). Bettinger was tagged with his first loss of the season on 6/6 at Charlotte. He pitched 2.1 innings and gave up two runs on four hits. The right-hander has made three appearances (one start) with Milwaukee and is 0-1 with a 14.00 ERA (14 ER/9.0 IP). He went 5-7 with a 3.44 ERA in 26 games (26 starts) in 2019 with Double-A Biloxi. The right-hander was named Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July after going 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA. Additionally, he finished among Southern League leaders in starts (T-1st), strikeouts (2nd), innings pitched (2nd), WHIP (2nd, 1.07), opponents batting average (4th, .223) and ERA (6th).

Max Kranick: 23-year-old Max Kranick starts for the Indians tonight. The right-hander is making his third start for Indianapolis. He has compiled a 0-1 record with a 4.82 ERA (5 ER/9.1 IP) to go along with 7 strikeouts. He has made 3 starts for Double-A Altoona this season going 1-0 with a 4.02 ERA (7 ER/15.2 IP) and 16 strikeouts. Kranick made 20 starts for Advanced-A Bradenton in 2019, he went 6-7 with a 3.79 ERA (46 ER/109.1 IP) with 78 strikeouts. He was selected by Pittsburgh in the 11th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 18, Second: 5, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

June Arms Race: As Nashville's winning streak took off in late May, the pitching has continued to have success in the month of June. The staff has a 6-4 June record and have recorded a league-best 2.96 ERA (28 ER/85.0 IP). They have combined for 100 strikeouts, a 0.98 WHIP and are holding opposing hitters to a .168 batting average. The WHIP and batting average against are the best marks in the Triple-A East in June.

Hiura We Go: Keston Hiura extended his hitting streak to 9 games last night, tied for the longest streak by a Sound in 2021 (Dee Strange-Gordon 5/4-19). He is hitting .500 (15-for-30) with 9 runs, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 10 RBI and 4 walks during the streak.

Bowden's Honor: Tonight's starter Bowden Francis was named the Milwaukee Brewers organizational Pitcher of the Month for May (along with RHP Taylor Floyd). The right-hander made 5 starts (4 with Double-A Biloxi, 1 with Nashville) and went 4-1 with a 3.81 ERA (11 ER/26 IP). Francis allowed 22 hits and 8 walks during the month of May to go along with 34 strikeouts, while holding opposing batters to a .220 average.

Big Margins: Last night's 13-run victory was Nashville's largest margin of victory in 2021. The previous was an 11-run win on 6/3 at Charlotte.

Home Field Advantage: The Sounds are 12-4 at First Horizon Park this season, which is the second-best home record in the Triple-A East, trailing only Omaha (15-3). Nashville has won 9 of their last 10 games at home.

Career-High for Westbrook: Jamie Westbrook matched a career-high last night with 5 RBI (2x, last - 8/2/19 vs. Omaha). Additionally, he has hit safely in four straight games, batting .500 (8-for-16) with 2 doubles, 2 home runs and 9 RBI.

Honors for Ashby: Aaron Ashby was named Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week for his play from 5/31-6/6. He joins Tyrone Taylor as Sounds players to win a weekly league honor. The left-hander's lone start was 6/4 at Charlotte, he struck out a season-high 11 batters and allowed 1 unearned run on 2 hits in 7.0 IP. Ashby was tagged with a tough-luck loss in Nashville's 1-0 setback. Ashby is among Triple-A East League leaders in batting average against (2nd, .168), strikeouts (3rd, 42) and ERA (8th, 3.34).

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,051-1,930. The 2,051 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 2019, Tim Dillard led the Sounds to a 2-0 win over the Las Vegas Aviators. He shutout Las Vegas over 5.2 innings and limited them to just 2 hits and 3 walks. Locke St. John, Jake Lemoine and Josh Fields finished the 2-hit shutout.
