PAPILLION, NEBRASKA – For the second straight game, the Omaha Storm Chasers beat the Iowa Cubs in extra-inning, walk-off fashion, as a sacrifice fly in the 10th inning secured a 7-6 win for Omaha to improve to 2-0 in 2024.

- Similar to the night before on Opening Day, Iowa controlled the first half of the game, as the Cubs led 2-0 at the halfway point in the game, through the middle of the 5th inning ... starting pitcher **Anthony Veneziano** held the I-Cubs to one run over three innings, then relief pitcher **Luis Cessa** behind him surrendered just one run in 2.2 innings of work.
- Logan Porter** opened the bottom of the 5th inning with a single, then **John Rave** promptly tied the game with a two-run homer ... after **Drew Waters** singled and stole second, **Nick Pratto** singled him in to give the Chasers their first lead of the afternoon.
- Omaha added three more runs in the 6th inning, as **Cam Devanney** doubled home **Mike Brosseau**, then **Ryan Fitzgerald** and **Tyler Gentry** drew bases-loaded walks for a 6-2 Storm Chasers lead.
- Behind Veneziano and Cessa, **Jonah Dipoto** and **Evan Sisk** combined for 2.1 scoreless innings and Omaha led by four going into the 9th inning ... **John McMillon** struggled in his Storm Chasers debut, as he put on four baserunners of the five batters he faced, with all four coming around to score ... **Sam Long** inherited two baserunners from McMillon that both scored, to tie the game at 6-6 and force extra-innings.
- Jacob Wallace** stranded the inherited runner on base in his Triple-A debut, with a scoreless 10th inning and it only took five pitches for Omaha to win the game in the bottom of the 10th ... **Devin Mann** opened the inning as the placed runner on second base and after a wild pitch moved him to third, Brosseau ended the game with a sacrifice fly to center field that scored Mann for another one-run victory.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

EXTRAS, EXTRAS, READ ALL ABOUT IT

- The Storm Chasers have played extra-inning games each of the first two games this season, the first time the club has played back-to-back extra-inning games since 2019
- Omaha played back-to-back extra-inning games July 2 and 3 @ Round Rock, both games they lost ... the Express beat the Storm Chasers 7-6 in 10 innings on July 2 and Omaha lost 9-8 in 10 innings on July 3.
- Twice in 2017, Omaha played back-to-back extra inning games but lost both games, both times ... the last time the Storm Chasers won back-to-back extra inning games was July 6, 2016, when Omaha won both games of a day/night doubleheader in Iowa against the Cubs ... the Chasers won the first game, 4-3 in 8 innings, then won the second game, 7-5 in 9 innings.

DÉJÀ VU

A win today would give the Storm Chasers a 3-0 start to the 2024 season, matching the start the team had to last season.

- Omaha started the 2023 season hot, winning the first three games of the season in Indianapolis ... the Chasers beat the Indians 8-6, 12-1 and 8-3 with the first and third games of that weekend series being comeback wins.
- A three-game winning streak to open the season is tied for the longest winning streak to open the season in the Storm Chasers era (since 2011) ... along with the 2023 Chasers, the 2006 Omaha Royals also opened the season with wins in the first three games of the year.
- The best general start to a season in the Storm Chasers era comes from the 2012 Chasers, who were 7-1 through their first 8 games, with a 6-game winning streak after going 1-1 over the first two games.

WALK (OFF) IT LIKE I TALK IT

Omaha has won the first two games of the season in walk-off fashion, something the team has not done since 2019.

- The last games the Storm Chasers walked off consecutively was July 17 and 18, 2019 vs. New Orleans ... on July 17, **Jackson Flores** brought home **Brett Phillips** on a sacrifice fly, for an 11-10 win in 9 innings ... on July 18, **Erick Mejia** scored **Chase d'Arnaud** on a sac fly as well, for a 10-9 win in 10 innings.
- Last season, Omaha only walked off as winners four times, with the first walk-off win not coming until June 2 vs. Memphis ... the 2022 Chasers walked off 7 times, while the 2021 team had 6 walk-off wins and the 2019 Omaha club had 7 walk-off wins.

HE HAS RISEN

Nick Pratto has had a strong start to the season, an improvement from his starts with Omaha the last two years.

- Pratto has gone 4-for-8 (.500) at the plate to start the year, and has reached base in 6 of 10 plate appearances ... he has 2 doubles and 2 walks, with 1 RBI.
- Last year, Nick started 3-for-12 (.250) over his first three games, with 1 RBI, though he drew 5 walks in that stretch ... in 2022, he was 3-for-12 as well, but with 2 homers.
