Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth in a six-game series against the archrival West Michigan Whitecaps, the High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Nuts won the opener on Tuesday, handing the Whitecaps their first loss of the year, but West Michigan has responded with wins each of the last three nights, taking the all-time series lead, 217-215.

Starting Matchup: 2021 sixth-rounder **Grant Holman**, freshly off the Lugnuts' Injured List, is expected to pitch the first inning for Lansing today, followed by right-hander **Blake Beers**. West Michigan counters with **Garrett Burhenn**, who was selected in the ninth round from the Ohio State University in 2021.

Last Night: **Whitecaps 14, Lugnuts 6**. The Caps drew 12 walks and homered twice, romping on the shoulders of a four-run third and a six-run fourth inning. **Jonny Butler** homered in defeat.

Off the Field: Tonight is **Jackie Robinson Day** across baseball! The Lugnuts are wearing special Page Fence Giants uniforms, honoring the dominant barnstorming Black professional baseball team of the 1890s that was based out of Adrian, Mich., and won over 100 games for three consecutive seasons, posting winning percentages over .800 each year.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

RISPy Business: The Nuts went 2-for-13 with runners in scoring position last night and are 3-for-39 with runners in scoring position the last three games, leading to defeat on all three occasions. Contrast those performances with a 5-for-11 showing with RiSP in the series opener. Lansing had struggled situationally during the season-opening three-game series at Great Lakes (2-for-12, 2-for-12, 1-for-4) but overcame those issues to win all three games.

Streiking: **Jack Winkler** and **Caeden Trenkle** have each reached base in all six Lugnuts games they have played this year. After going 0-for-4 in the opener, Winkler has hit safely in the last five games. Trenkle is third in the league with a .381 batting average and tied for third with a .500 on-base percentage.

Welcome to the Show: 2022 Lugnuts lefty **Hogan Harris** debuted in relief for the Oakland Athletics last night, becoming the 175th Nuts alumnus to reach the Major Leagues and the second this year. Harris was optioned back to Triple-A Las Vegas today.

Rocket Man: Throwing 100+ mph with over half of his pitches, 2022 Nuts right-hander **Mason Miller** rolled into Triple-A Las Vegas last night and fired five hitless innings, striking out 11. The only batter who reached base against him did so on a dropped third strike / wild pitch. Miller had previously struck out eight batters in 3 2/3 innings in his first start of the season, suiting up for Double-A Midland. His next start? It might be in the Major Leagues.

Doubling Their Pleasure: West Michigan (19) and Lansing (15) are the top two teams in the league in doubles, with the teams each hitting three two-baggers yesterday. Three Lugnuts players (**Max Muncy**, **CJ Rodriguez** and **Jack Winkler**) are tied for second in the league with three doubles, trailing only West Michigan's **Ben Malgeri**.

Transaction: Yesterday, the Nuts added pitchers **Grant Holman** and **John Beller** to the active roster. Holman, the 2022 Opening Day starter, was reinstated from the Injured List and takes to the mound tonight. Beller, a member of the Peoria Chiefs last season, was signed as a Minor League free agent and promoted to Lansing from the Arizona Complex League; he joins the bullpen.

- 2008:** Kyle Ginley struck out 10 Burlington Bees in 6 2/3 shutout innings, scattering eight hits and a walk, in a 5-1 Lugnuts victory at Community Field
- 2015:** It was a bad night for Great Lakes second baseman Jimmy Allen, who committed three errors – and the third allowed the tie-breaking run to score with two outs in the ninth, giving the Lugnuts a 2-1 win at Dow Diamond.
- 2017:** Jose Medina hit three homers, the last in the ninth inning – touching off a benches-clearing brawl that led to multiple suspensions – and the Lake County Captains blasted the Lugnuts, 17-5, at Cooley Law School Stadium. The game included a ten-run Captains fourth inning.

In a Nutshell: Opened 2023 on the Injured List, but was activated yesterday and flew in from Arizona... received 2022 Opening game start for Lugnuts... listed as a "Sleeper Arm We're Watching" in the A's system by Eric Longenhagen and Kevin Goldstein for Fangraphs ("Holman, a two-way guy at Cal, [is an] arm strength flier right now. The hope is Holman can add movement to his fastball").

Little League Hero: One of the all-time great Little League World Series performers... coached by father Doug... 6'4, 166 lbs. at age 13, throwing 70s mph heat... opened up 2013 LLWS with an extra-inning no-hitter, crushing a game-winning grand slam to clinch the second game, and then delivering an extra-inning walk-off three-run homer in the third game... led Eastlake Little League to the LLWS championship game, where they fell 6-4 to Japan... Padres prospect Robert Hassell III also competed in the tournament as a member of the Southeast champ from Nashville.

High School: Recorded a 3.95 GPA at Eastlake H.S. ... career high school stats: 29-1, 1.10 ERA | .390 avg., 20 HR, 80 RBI... 2017 MaxPreps National Junior of the Year, 2017 California Mr. Baseball Runner Up... 2018 CIF SDS Pitcher of the Year... played one year on Eastlake H.S. varsity basketball team.

Bear Down: Starred as a two-way player at Cal... as a freshman, hit .272/.362/.456 as the DH while making 11 appearances, nine starts (37 1/3 IP, 4.82 ERA)... on May 4, 2019 at Utah, hit game-tying double, then pitched the 9th to notch the save... as a sophomore in Covid-shortened 2020, was Cal's starting first baseman and No. 2 pitcher, leading the Bears with 24 2/3 IP (3.28 ERA) while hitting .250/.333/.324... on March 10, 2020, after hitting his first home run earlier in the game, hit by a pitch in the face against San Jose State in the bottom of the 7th inning... that was his last ever at-bat in college baseball... named 2021 Baseball America Preseason All-America First Team, utility... as a full-time pitcher in injury-hampered junior year, 2021, delivered 10 weekend starts, 47 IP, 3.83 ERA, 20 BB, 46 K.

Evaluation: Rated by MLB.com as the No. 138 best prospect entering the 2021 draft... the MLB scouting report: "Holman has the chance to have a legitimate four-pitch mix, all coming from a strong, durable build that points to a potential starting-pitching profile. He touched 97 miles per hour as a reliever in the San Diego Collegiate League over the summer, and was regularly hitting 96 in bullpens this fall for Cal, throwing his fastball for heavy riding life. He already had a live slider and a splitter he uses as his off-speed offering and added a slower 12-to-6 curve that looks like it could be a usable offering as well. All of Holman pitches have a lot of action, and he has a feel to find the strike zone with all of them. But not a lot of track record yet given his split focus, but he is a college arm with some serious upside, one who could climb boards in a hurry."

Draft Day: Selected 188th overall in the 6th round by Oakland, 2021, the first Golden Bear to be drafted... signed for \$375,000, higher than the recommended slot of \$255,000... second pitcher drafted by the A's, following third-rounder Mason Miller (Gardner-Webb).

2021 - Professional Debut: Appeared in six games, four starts, for Low-A Stockton in 2021... made pro debut vs. Inland Empire, August 25... struck out five Modesto Nuts in 2 1/3 innings, September 14... finished with his best outing, tossing four scoreless two-hit innings vs. Modesto, whiffing four, on September 19.

2022 - Midwest League: Earned honor of Lugnuts' Opening Day start, though it was pushed back one day by terrible Michigan weather... started Game 1 of doubleheader, April 9 vs. Lake County, tossing four innings, six hits, two runs, no walks, two strikeouts; both runs were scored in the fourth inning; outdueled by Gavin Williams (4 IP, 0 H, 6 K) in Lugnuts 3-0 loss... tossed **immaculate inning** on April 14, Game 2, at West Michigan, whiffing nine in five innings... followed up with six scoreless innings April 21 vs. Fort Wayne, fanning seven; allowed leadoff runner to reach in five of six innings... returned from the Injured List August 2 vs. West Michigan and did not escape the first inning: faced eight batters (32 pitches, 17 strikes), allowing three hits, two walks, one home run (Bryant Packard two-run HR), and four runs, while recording only two outs... Lugnuts fell behind 10-1 in the 2nd inning, rallied within 10-8 in the 7th, but ultimately lost 15-8.

Draft Day: Signed for \$40,000 as the 578th pick in the 2021 draft... signing scout: Rich Sparks, the 2006 Dick Bogard Scout of the Year, who scouts Indiana/Kentucky/Michigan/Ohio and also signed A's catcher Sean Murphy, former Lugnuts Marty Bechina, Jeff Criswell, Max Schuemann and Jack Weisenburger... third Michigan Wolverine drafted in 2021, following southpaw Steven Hajjar (2nd round, Minnesota) and shortstop Benjamin Sems (15th round, Colorado).

What's in a Name? Besides Seth Beer, pitcher Clarence Beers saw action in one game in relief in 1948 for St. Louis... middle name of Ausweger is Blake's mother's maiden name.

Hometown: Manhattan Beach is in southwestern Los Angeles County, bordering the Pacific Ocean, with a beach stretching over two miles... motto: "Sun, Sand, Sea"... city name was decided by coin flip, with landowners George Peck and John Merrill arguing between the names Shore Acres and Manhattan; they flipped to decide the name, and Manhattan won... the postmaster added "Beach" to the end to differentiate it.

Glory Days: Attended Loyola High School (the "Cubs"), a private all-boys Roman Catholic prep school in Los Angeles that first opened in 1865... Loyola also produced Royals broadcaster Ryan Lefebvre, volleyball great Sinjin Smith, linebacker Anthony Barr, and New York Giants outfielder Fred Snodgrass, who played with Christy Mathewson on John McGraw's powerful Giants teams... Beers distinguished himself at Loyola, named a 2017 Perfect Game First Team All-State, First Team All-Region and Third Team All-American.

Hail to the Victors: Pitched four years at Michigan... in College of Literature, Science and the Arts... as a freshman, made two appearances: 1/3 IP vs. Army, 3 BB, 1 K, 4 R, and 0 IP vs. Western Michigan, 2 BB, 1 HBP, 3 R... finished with 135.00 ERA... sophomore year was better: 6.04 ERA, 14 G, 2 GS, 1 sv., 22 1/3, 24 H, 1 HR, 10 BB, 15 K, 5 HBP, 7 WP... as a junior, was at his best, though season was pandemic-shortened: 3.13 ERA, 4 GS, 23 IP, 15 H, 0 HR, 5 BB, 21 K, 6 WP... as a senior: 8.42 ERA, 13 G, 5 GS, 25 2/3 IP, 30 H, 2 HR, 20 BB, 21 K, 7 WP... notable Wolverines: Ted Simmons, Charlie Gehringer, Barry Larkin, George Sisler, Bill Freehan, JJ Putz, Mike Matheny, Chris Sabo, Ryan LaMarre and Jake Cronenworth.

Pro Ball – Better Late Than Never: Debuted on the very last day of the 2021 season, getting the start in the Arizona Complex League on September 18th... allowed one run (James Triantos HR) on two hits in one inning, striking out one; A's lost, 5-4, in a walk-off.
