#### **JUMBO SHRIMP FALL 3-2**

The Jumbo Shrimp smacked 10 hits but fell short in a 3-2 loss to the Indians on Friday. Indianapolis opened up the scoring in the second inning when Matt Fraizer notched a two-run single. Jacksonville tied the score with a pair of runs in the bottom of the inning on RBI singles from Jonathan Davis and Javier Sanoja. The score remained deadlocked until the ninth, when Liover Peguero launched a solo home run. Emmanuel Ramirez tossed a season-high 3.0 scoreless innings of relief.

#### STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed scoreless outings in four of the last six games heading into play on Saturday. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only four runs, all earned, on 17 hits (6.0 H/9) in 25.1 innings for a 1.42 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 21 strikeouts against eight walks during this stretch. Not coincidentally, the Jumbo Shrimp are 4-2 during this run.

#### GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder **Griffin Conine** suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 33 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 35-for-hislast-108, slashing .324/.417/.694/1.111 with seven doubles, 11 home runs, 29 RBIs, 18 walks and 24 runs scored. He's homered in five of his last nine games entering play on Saturday. Among the 127 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks ninth in HR/FB (29.2 percent). The 26-year-old has has driven in at least one run in 19 of those 33 games, with multiple RBIs in eight contests.

#### **ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?**

Jacksonville's 13-24 (.351) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 17-13 (.556) road record is one of only eight winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 160 runs in 30 games (5.3 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (fourth-fewest in Triple-A) 142 runs in 37 games, 3.8 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 190 runs (11th-most) in 37 home games (5.1 per game) compared to 135 (tied for second-fewest) on the road (4.5 per game)

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 44 of Jacksonville's 67 games (65.7 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 26 of the club's last 36 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 22 of its last 29 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 19-25 (.432) in these affairs.

#### X MARKS THE SPOT

In 2023, Xavier Edwards registered one of the most illustrious seasons in Jacksonville's Triple-A/Double-A history (1962-present). His .351 batting average was the best in club single-season history, with his .429 on-base percentage ranking second. After an injury scuttled the beginning of his season, Edwards has picked up right where he left off in 2024. The Coconut Creek, Fla., native has hits in 12 of his first 15 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, compiling a remarkable seven multi-hit contests. In all, he is 20-for-60, slashing .333/.375/.433/.808 with four doubles, one triple, three RBIs, four walks and four runs scored.

#### LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 30 of his last 34 games, notching 16 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 49for-136 (.360/.408/.522/.930) with 10 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 24 RBIs, 13 walks and 19 runs scored. Among the 216 IL hitters with at least 110 PA, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (50.9 percent) and the fourth-lowest swinging-strike rate (3.9 percent).

#### SHRIMP BITES

Over their five road series in 2024, Jacksonville has won four of them with just one defeat. However, the Jumbo Shrimp are just 1-4-1 in their home sets with three consecutive home series losses. Over their last four home series which includes this current one, Jacksonville is just 5-17 (.227) at 121 Financial Ballpark... Troy Johnston is hitting .308/.408/.477/.885 over his last 18 games.

#### **ABOUT JONATHAN**

-Bermúdez was originally selected by the Houston Astros in the 23rd round of the 2018 draft out of Southeastern University in Lakeland, Fla.

-Bermúdez began his collegiate career at Miami-Dade College in 2014 before transferring to Polk State College (Winter Haven, Fla.) before transferring to Saint Leo University (St. Leo, Fla.). He concluded his career at Southeastern University (Lakeland, Fla.) in 2018.

-The Houston Astros' 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year, Bermúdez went 5-6 with a 3.24 ERA across 25 appearances, including 20 starts, between Double-A Corpus Christi and Triple-A Sugar Land In 111.0 innings, he ceded just 93 hits (7.5 H/9) and 34 walks (2.9 BB/9) while striking out 146 batters (11.8 K/9).

-In 2021, Bermúdez was second of Astros minor leaguers in total strikeouts (146) and innings pitched (111.0). His combined 3.32 ERA and 4.29 strikeout-to-walk-ratio were tops of any Astros minor leaguer to log at least 70 innings pitched. His ratio of 11.8 strikeoutsper-nine-innings was second-best of Astros minor leaguers with at least 70 innings pitched...

-Grew up a fan of the New York Yankees in Coamo, Puerto Rico. His favorite player was left-handed pitcher Andy Pettitte.

-In his spare time, Bermúdez enjoys cooking, and his favorite dish is arroz con pollo.

-Jonathan has one brother, John. They are the son of Juan Bermúdez and Marcy DeJesus.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Bermúdez was promoted to Jacksonville on June 9 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, Bermúdez was 11th among qualified pitchers in strikeouts (56) and 24th in innings pitched (48.0).

-With Pensacola, Bermúdez held right-handed hitters hit .188/.281/.376/.657 in 113 plate appearances. Left-handers batted .127/.267/.175/.442 in 72 plate appearances.

#### 2023 SEASON

-Over 251 plate appearances, right-handed hitters slashed .248/.350/.459/.809 against Bermúdez. Comparatively, Bermúdez help left-handed hitters to a .255/.314/.376/.690 line across 151 plate appearances.

-Bermúdez was released by the San Francisco Giants on March 27. He signed with the Marlins on Aprl 26.

#### 2022 SEASON

-On August 23, 2022, Bermúdez was claimed off waivers by the San Francisco Giants. On September 1, Bermúdez was removed from the 40-man roster and sent outright to the Triple-A Sacramento River Cats. Spending the remainder of the year with Sacramento, he was 0–3 in five starts with a 9.22 ERA over 13.2 innings in which he gave up seven home runs and struck out 16 batters.
