FROM THE CROWS NEST

SEARCHING FOR THE LONGBALL: The Bradenton Marauders entered Friday night without a home run, and were just one of eight teams in the Minor Leagues without one. The Marauders ended up clubbing three on the night including a game-tying two-run HR from Esmerlyn Valdez in the seventh inning. Omar Alfonzo's 436 ft home run in the first inning tied Jose De La Cruz (LAK) for the furthest on the night across all Single-A games.

BACK ON TRACK: INF Garret Forrester had tallied just one hit on the season entering Friday night's contest against the Lakeland Flying Tigers. The former Oregon State Beaver collected two hits in his first two trips at the plate including a double in the third inning. Per Statcast, the exit velocity on his double was 106.2 MPH, the fourth-largest among all Single-A games on Friday.

BUT HE GET'S ON BASE: Marauders **UTIL Jesus Castillo** has reached base safely in each of the first seven games of the season. He is the only Marauder and just one of three players in the Florida State League to do so, joining Josue Briceno (LAK) and Geoge Lombard Jr (TAM).

WALK THIS WAY: Jesus Castillo's walk streak came to end at 11 games on Wednesday night in Lakeland. **Castillo** was one of just eight players in Minor League baseball last season to work 100 or more walks. The Marauders infielder is currently ranked second in FSL with 10 walks on the year only trailing the New York Yankees No. 7 prospect in George Lombard Jr.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to Thursday's game, the Pittsburgh Pirates the promotion of **OF P.J. Hilson** from the FCL Pirates roster. **OF Braylon Bishop** was placed on the 7-day injured list while RHP Joaquin Tejada was reassigned to the FCL Pirates. The Marauders also added **C John Lopez** who was placed on the Development List.

STRIKEOUT KINGS: In last Friday's loss against Clearwater, the Marauders pitching staff collected 15 strikeouts. Last season, Bradenton's staff struck out 15 or more batters in a game eight times. The 15 punchouts were also the fourth-most across Single-A on Opening Day. The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A, HOU) racked up 19 K's against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC).

ROSTER IS HERE!: Last Thursday, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced the break camp roster for the rest of their Minor League affiliates. The roster features six Top 30 prospects between Baseball America and MLB Pipeline. 10 players selected in the 2023 draft are featured on the roster which includes 3rd round pick **Garret Forrester**, 4th round pick **Carlson Reed**, and 6th round draft choice **Hunter Furtado**.

MARAUDERS IN THE SHOW: 25 former Bradenton players were represented on Opening Day rosters. In Pittsburgh, the list was headlined by 2019 Marauder infielder Oneil Cruz, Gold Glove Award-winning infielder Ke'Bryan Hayes, and 2023 All-Star pitcher Mitch Keller. Other notables include 6x All-Star and CY Young Award winner Gerrit Cole (NYY), RHP Tyler Glasnow (LAD), and Silver Slugger award winner Josh Bell (MIA).
