**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels closed out the road trip with a 4-0 win against the Reading Fightin Phils at FirstEnergy Stadium. **Matt Frisbee** pitched seven scoreless innings and allowed one hit, a lead-off single by Daniel Brito in the first inning, before retiring the next 21 straight batters. He finished his outing with a season-high eight strikeouts. **Jose Marte** and **Norwith Gudino** each worked a scoreless inning to finish the game. **Andy Suglio** gave the Flying Squirrels at 1-0 lead in the first inning with an RBI single. In the second, **Kyle Mottice** scored from third when **Bryan Torres** stole second base. The Flying Squirrels doubled the lead in the eighth inning an RBI groundout and an error.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, at FirstEnergy Stadium. This series marks the only trip to Richmond this season for the Curve. The Flying Squirrels play six games at Altoona's Peoples Natural Gas Field from August 24-29.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won five of the last six games. They are in fourth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 3.0 games behind first-place Bowie. Over the last six games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .256 (44-for-172) with four homers. The Flying Squirrels have outscored the Fightin Phils, 26-17 in the last series.

**THE CURVE** have lost two straight games after picking up wins in the previous three. They are currently in fifth place in the Double-A Northeast, a half-game behind Richmond and 3.5 games behind first-place Bowie. Altoona's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects, including Oneil Cruz (4), Ji-hwan Bae (14), Mason Martin (15), Cal Mitchell (18), Roansy Contreras (20) and Canaan Smith-Njigba (26).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Gerson Garabito** makes his fifth start of the season. Last time out, he allowed three runs over 3.0 innings in a no-decision at Reading in the first game of Thursday's double-header. He was with the Kansas City Royals organization from 2013-2019, reaching as high as Double-A. He spent 2019 pitching in the Texas League with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals, going 6-12 with a 3.77 ERA in 26 starts. Garabito's performance in 2019 earned him a selection as a Texas League Mid-Season All-Star. He signed as a minor league free agent with the Giants on November 20, 2020. **For more on Garabito, see page two.**

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Roansy Contreras makes his fifth start of the season. He last pitched last Tuesday in Altoona against Erie and was charged with his first loss after allowing five runs in 4.0 innings. Over his first three starts of the year, Contreras combined for 17.2 scoreless innings against Bowie, Binghamton and Harrisburg. He was originally signed by the New York Yankees as an international free agent in 2016 before being traded to the Pittsburgh Pirates along with SS Maikol Escotto, LHP Canaan Smith and RHP Miguel Yajure for RHP Jameson Taillon on January 24, 2021. Entering tonight's start, Contreras is ranked seventh in the Double-A Northeast in ERA (2.08), sixth in strikeouts (34), third in BAA (.149) and tied for third in WHIP (0.78). Contreras is ranked by MLB.com as the Pirates' No. 20 prospect and No. 13 by *Baseball America*. In 2019, he was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the South Atlantic League after going 12-5 with a 3.33 ERA in 24 starts for the Charleston River Dogs.

**ADDING IT UP:** Over his last seven games since May 23, **Shane Matheny** has hit .400 (8-for-20) with three doubles, a homer and six RBIs. He has a .520 on-base percentage in that span with five walks. On Saturday at Reading, Matheny hit the first home run of his Double-A career, a go-ahead shot in the Flying Squirrels' 2-1 win. Matheny is currently riding a 13-game on-base streak since May 15, during which he is batting .297 (11-for-37) with 11 walks. For the season, Matheny is ranked tied for eighth in the league with 15 walks.

**RAMOS RAKING:** On his current 11-game on-base streak since May 18, **Heliot Ramos** is batting .364 (16-for-44) with three doubles, one homer and seven RBIs. For the season, Ramos is currently ranked ninth in the Double-A Northeast in batting average (.314), fourth in hits (27), tied for eighth in doubles (7) and tied for fourth in total bases (43).

**STRONG ARMS:** This season, the Flying Squirrels rank third in all of Double-A in ERA (3.04), which is second in the Double-A Northeast. The Richmond pitching staff also ranks first in Double-A in saves (10), third-fewest in hits (150), fourth in WHIP (1.14) and third in BAA (.202). Starting pitcher **Matt Frisbee** leads the Double-A Northeast in ERA (1.24), wins (4), innings pitched (29.0), BAA (.112) and WHIP (0.41) and sits seventh in strikeouts (32).

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the third-best bullpen ERA in all of Minor League Baseball at 2.20 on the season, which is second-best in Double-A. The bullpen is tied for third in the minors and first in Double-A with 10 saves. Richmond relievers have allowed the second-fewest runs (29), second-fewest hits (52) and have the best BAA (.159) in the minors. **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for second in the Double-A Northeast with four saves.

**ANTI-THEFT SECURITY:** The Richmond catchers have combined to throw out 63.2 percent of stolen base attempts, which leads all of Minor League Baseball. The Flying Squirrels have thrown out a total of 12 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for fourth-most in Double-A. **Andres Angulo** is leading all Double-A catchers in caught stealing percentage (min. 10 attempts) at 63.6 percent (7-for-11).

**STRONG START:** The Flying Squirrels' 15-9 record is tied for the best start in team history through 24 games, matching the start of the season in 2010. If they pick up a win tonight, the team's 16-9 record would be the best start through 25 games in franchise history.

**A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS:** The Flying Squirrels have sold out their maximum capacity crowds at The Diamond for 10 of their 11 openings this year. For the first homestand, the Flying Squirrels drew the maximum allotted crowd of 2,943 for all five openings. In the second homestand, the maximum capacity was 3,448. After drawing 3,057 fans on May 18 (89%), the Flying Squirrels sold out their next five home games. Tonight's game marks the first of the year with 100 percent capacity allowed at The Diamond, which is 9,560 fans.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

**GOING FOR GOLD:** Flying Squirrels manager **José Alguacil** is taking an absence from his position in Richmond to manage the Venezuelan national team for the WBSC Baseball Americas Olympic Qualifier at Clover Park in St. Lucie, Fla. and The Ballpark of the Palm Beaches in West Palm Beach, Fla. Venezuela is playing in Group B with Canada, Colombia and Cuba. After scrimmage games against the Dominican Republic and the United States, Venezuela will play its first game of the Qualifier on May 31 against Cuba in West Palm Beach. The top two teams from each group will play in a super round on June 4 and 5, with the team holding the best record from that round earning a spot in the Olympics in Japan. **Tony Diggs** managed the team for its six-game series in Reading from May 25-30, going 5-1. **Jason Wood** is managing the Flying Squirrels during this week's series. He spent the last 10 seasons as a manager in the Texas Rangers organization. He was with High-A Myrtle Beach from 2011-2013, Double-A Frisco in 2014, Triple-A Round Rock from 2015-2018 and Triple-A Nashville in 2019. Wood is currently the Giants' Coordinator of Infield Instruction. Catcher **Andres Angulo** is also away from the team in Richmond, heading down to Florida to play for his home country, Colombia, in the Qualifier.
