BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN The Portland Sea Dogs held on to win 3-1 over the Somerset Patriots last night at Hadlock Field. The Sea Dogs struck first in the bottom of the third inning after a sacrifice fly to center field from Allan Castro gave Portland a 1-0 lead. In the top of the fifth inning, Somerset scored a run on an error to even the game at one. Garcia countered by crushing his second homer at the Double-A level in the bottom of the second inning. A go-ahead two-run blast over the Maine Monster put Portland back on top, 3-1.

COFFEY IS PIPING HOT RHP Isaac Coffey was dominant again last night throwing 5.0 innings allowing one run (unearned) on four hits. He did not issue a walk. Coffey struck out 11 hitters for the second time this season. In August, he is 2-0 with a 0.60 ERA in three starts and has 31 strikeouts in 15.0 innings.

GARCIA DISPLAYS POWER Jhostynxon Garcia hit his first home run at Hadlock Field last night, breaking a 1-1 tie in the bottom of the seventh inning. He blasted it 408 feet over the Maine Monster with an exit velocity of 109mph. Garcia currently leads the Red Sox organization with 23 home runs this season across three levels. He has two with the Sea Dogs since his promotion from Greenville.

HENDRIKS AT HADLOCK Boston Red Sox pitcher Liam Hendriks made a Major League Rehab appearance last night out of the bullpen for the Sea Dogs. He recorded one out while allowing one hit and issuing a walk. He threw 12 pitches, seven for strikes. Hendriks signed the Red Sox prior to the 2024 season after pitching for the Minnesota Twins (2011-2013), Toronto Blue Jays and Kansas City Royals (2014), Oakland A's (2016-2020) and Chicago White Sox (2021-2023). He owns an all-time 33-34 record with a 3.82 ERA with 116 saves in 140 appearances. He has recorded at least 14 saves in five of his last six seasons.

FAREWELL OLD FRIEND Hunter Dobbins was promoted prior to yesterday's game to Triple-A Worcester. Dobbins dealt 6.0 shutout innings allowing just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in his last start at the level this series. This season Dobbins owns a 7-3 record and 3.17 ERA in 21 starts for Portland. He has been lights out this month. Dobbins has pitched 21.1 innings in four starts in August and has a 1.27 ERA. In 21.1 innings he has allowed three earned runs on 19 hits while walking six and striking out 19. He has not given up a home run.

NEW TO THE TEAM Prior to the series opener, the Sea Dogs made a host of roster moves. Max Ferguson was activated from the 60-day injured list and immediately made an impact in the field. He was Portland's shortstop and made a highlight-worthy double play in the eighth inning Tuesday. RHP Reidis Sena and RHP Bryce Bonnin were also promoted from High-A Greenville. Sena pitched in 28 games out of the bullpen for the Drive and was 6-4 with a 3.56 ERA. He recorded 67 strikeouts in 48.0 innings. Bonnin also pitched exclusively out of the bullpen in 19 games. He went 3-3 with a 4.04 ERA with 40 strikeouts in 35.2 innings. He gave up three home runs.

WHERE DO WE STAND The Sea Dogs remain in first place of the Northeast Division of the Eastern League, 4.5 games ahead of the second-place Somerset Patriots. The Binghamton Rumble Ponies and Hartford Yard Goats are tied for third place, 7.0 games behind Portland while the Reading Fightin Phils are 12.5 back and the New Hampshire Fisher Cats are in last place. In the Southwest Division, the Akron RubberDucks lead by 5.5 games.

PITCHING PREVIEW RHP Wikelman Gonzalez will take the mound for the Sea Dogs tonight. He last pitched on August 17th against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies and tossed 4.0 shutout innings allowing just two hits. In two starts against the Patriots this season, Gonzalez is 1-0 with a 2.00 ERA. He has struck out 11 Patriots hitters in 9.0 innings.

Sea Dogs Coaching Staff

CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final inning of a combined no-hitter for Inland Empire.

MICKEY JIANG - COACH

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

KYLE SASALA- COACH

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.

Recognized by the Red Sox as the organization's Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Year. Went 9-4 with a 3.96 ERA (49 ER/111.1 IP) and a .190 opponent AVG in 25 starts between High-A Greenville (15 GS) and Double-A Portland (10 GS). Led Minor League Baseball (min. 100.0 IP) with 13.58 SO/9.0 IP and a 35.2% strikeout rate (168 SO in 111.1 IP). Named an MiLB.com Organization All-Star. Recorded 10+ SO in a start 4 times, including a career-high 12 SO on 5/27 at Rome. Began the season with Greenville and went 0-2 with a 15.58 ERA, 3.00 WHIP, and .294 opponent AVG in 4 April starts (8.2 IP, 15 ER, 10 H, 16 BB). In 10 starts during May and June, went 6-0 with a 2.55 ERA, 1.11 WHIP, and .175 opponent AVG (49.1 IP, 14 ER, 31 H, 24 BB). Won 4 consecutive starts from 6/10-30 (1.29 ERA, 21.0 IP, 3 ER, 10 H, 8 BB, 36 SO)...Struck out 10 batters in consecutive outings on 6/23 at Bowling Green and 6/30 at Asheville. Promoted to Portland on 7/14... Allowed 4 ER in 2.2 IP on 8/19 at Binghamton, but posted a 1.77 ERA (9 ER/45.2 IP) in his other 9 outings with the Sea Dogs.

Is in his 6th professional season. Added to the Sox' 40-man roster on 11/14/23. Ranked by Baseball America as the Red Sox' No. 7 prospect and top pitching prospect...Also rated by BA as having the best curveball in the organization. Also ranked by Baseball America as a top Sox prospect entering 2022 (No. 13) and 2023 (No. 12). Has struck out 30.4% of batters faced (399 of 1,312) and averaged 11.63 SO/9.0 IP in his minor league career. Has twice been named his league's Pitcher of the Week: Carolina League (8/18-14/22) and Eastern League (7/17-23/23). Participated in the Red Sox Rookie Development Program in January 2024... The program included 2 workouts daily, seminars focused on assimilation into Major League life on and off the field, an RBI clinic with the Red Sox Foundation, and a visit to Boston Children's Hospital. Attended Red Sox Winter Weekend in January 2024, signing autographs and posing for pictures with fans.

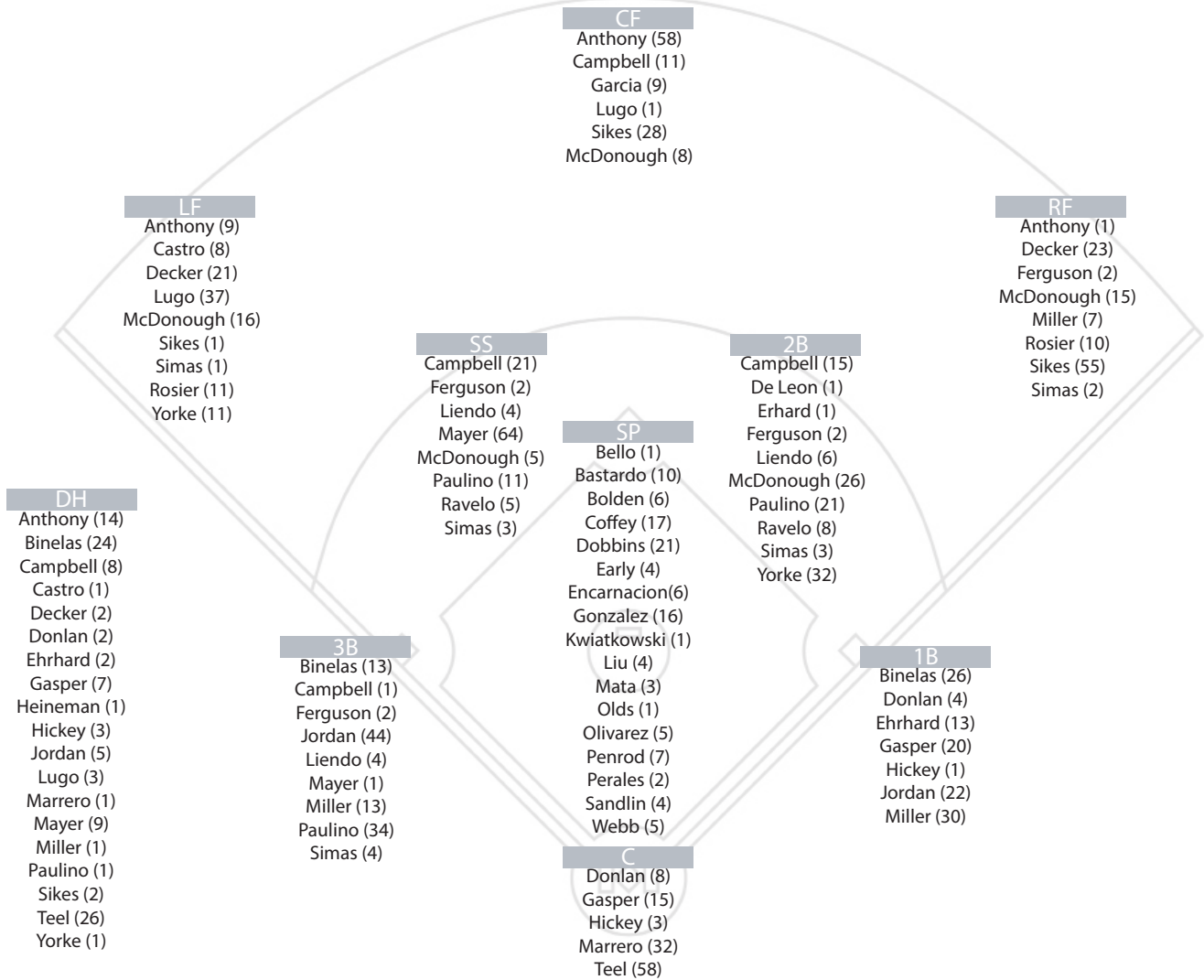
