- Beloit started its 12-game road trip with a loss in a pitchers duel with Lake County, 2-1 on Tuesday night at Classic Park.
- The Captains jumped ahead early, scoring on a Joe Lampe RBI single in the bottom of the first inning. Jared Poland would limit the damage, retiring the next two batters to strand runners on second and third.
- Lake County made it 2-0 with Joe Donovan's solo homer in the 4th inning.
- On the other side of the scorecard, Captains starter Aaron Davenport looked dominant, allowing just two hits through five innings.
- Beloit got on the board in a big way in the sixth, as Osiris Johnson belted a 468 foot solo homer to cut the deficit to 2-1.
- Davenport didn't allow another hit, retiring the final six batters he faced to finish seven innings of one run ball.
- The Carp couldn't manage a comeback, tallying just a Yiddi Cappe single in the ninth.

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A GAME MAKES

After posting a season-high 15 runs in Sunday's win, Beloit managed just one run on four hits on Tuesday - their lowest output of the second half.

WE'RE A SECOND HALF TEAM

Beloit's .273 batting average in the second half is tops in the Midwest League. Their .778 OPS ranks 3rd. Through 24 games, the team is averaging 5.7 runs per game and 9.9 hits per game. In the first half, the Sky Carp averaged 4 runs and 7.4 hits per game.

Today's 11 am (10 AM CT) scheduled start time is Beloit's earliest scheduled game this season.

CAN'T PUT THIS JUICE IN A BOX

After reaching base five times on Sunday (3-3, 2 BB), Osiris Johnson (nicknamed OJ, or Juice) clobbered his fifth home run of the season 468 feet last night. The homer extends Johnson's strong stretch, as the outfielder is hitting .429 (12-28) with a 1.127 OPS over his last 10 games.

THE BIG (FIRST) THREE

The Sky Carp have allowed at least one run in the first three innings in 10 of their last 11 games. Of Beloit's 495 runs allowed this season, 39% (198) have come in the first three innings. When the Sky Carp keep the opponent scoreless through 3, they are 19-6.

NICE AND CLOSE

15 of Beloit's first 25 games in the second half have been decided by 3 or fewer. The Sky Carp have gone 9-6 in those contests. The Sky Carp's record in games decided by three or fewer is 26-23 following last night's loss.

LEFTY ON LEFTY

Entering today's matchup with LHP Steve Hajjar, many of Beloit's lefthanded batters have hit well against southpaws. Tanner Allen is hitting .308 with a .910 OPS vs lefties. Davis Bradshaw boasts a .394 average and .929 OPS. Joe Mack is hitting .280 vs lefty hurlers.

STAYING UP LATE

In each of Beloit's last 12 wins, the team has scored at least one run in the 7th inning or later. In six games last week with Quad Cities, the Sky Carp tallied 17 runs in the 7th inning or later, including three runs on Sunday.

HELLO, OHIO

Beloit will spend their entire 12 game road trip in the state of Ohio, marking the team's only two-week road trip of the 2023 season. The Sky Carp's 460 mile trip to Eastlake from ABC Supply Stadium marks their longest road trip by distance of the season.
