TODAY'S GAME: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos play their final game of the 2025 season against the Columbus Clingstones, Double-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves, on Sunday afternoon.

LAST TIME OUT: The Blue Wahoos beat the Clingstones 4-3 on Saturday...they set a new team record with seven stolen bases, surpassing the previous record of six set three times (including a month ago in Montgomery)...Fenwick Trimble tied the club's individual record with four stolen bases, last set by Billy Hamilton in 2012...Jacob Miller struck out a season-high eight batters over 5.0 innings of one-run ball...Evan Fitterer earned his team-leading seventh win...Jesse Bergin earned a five-out save.

GRAND FINALE: The Blue Wahoos are 7-5 all-time in their final game of the regular season...they have ended the season at home every year since 2022, winning each time...last year, the Blue Wahoos walked off Montgomery 6-5 in 10 innings with a Josh Zamora single.

THANK YOU, PENSACOLA: Saturday night's announced attendance of 5,038 was Pensacola's 23rd home sellout of the 2025 season...with one game remaining, their paid attendance in 68 openings is 266,829...that figure, as well as their 3,924 average, is third-best in the Southern League...they have sold out at least 20 games every year since 2018.

FIGHT FOR .500: The Blue Wahoos are 68-69 with 1 game remaining in the regular season...with a win today, they will finish at .500...the Blue Wahoos were below .500 their first four seasons (2012-15), but had a winning record eight consecutive seasons from 2016 to 2024.

MEET THE CLINGSTONES: The Blue Wahoos are 17-12 against the Clingstones in their first Southern League season...the two teams will meet 24 times in 2026: May 19-24 in Pensacola, June 9-14 in Columbus, July 21-26 in Pensacola, and September 1-6 in Columbus.

OFF AND RUNNING: The Blue Wahoos have stolen 199 bases this season, second-most in the Southern League...they passed the 2022 team (168 SB) for the most in team history on August 21...Marlins affiliates are stealing bases at record paces, as High-A Beloit finished the regular season tied for the MiLB lead with 334 steals, Jacksonville is second among Triple-A clubs with 292 and Single-A Jupiter finished with 276.

20-26 VISION: The Blue Wahoos announced their 2026 home schedule last Thursday...they will open the season at home on Friday, April 3 against the Montgomery Biscuits...they will be home for Easter weekend (April 3-5), Mother's Day weekend (May 8-10), Memorial Day weekend (May 22-24), Juneteenth, and Father's Day weekend (June 19-21).

CARP-E DIEM: The High-A Beloit Sky Carp fell 7-1 to the Twins-affiliate Cedar Rapids Kernels in the decisive game of the Midwest League Division Series on Friday...the Kernels will advance to the Midwest League Championship Series against the West Michigan Whitecaps (DET), who swept Lake County in the East division series and went 92-39 in the regular season...20 players currently on Pensacola's roster played for the Sky Carp at some point this season.

GET 'EM NEXT YEAR: The first half champion Biloxi Shuckers will face the second half champion Montgomery Biscuits in the Southern League Division Series starting on Tuesday...in the North Division, the first half champion Chattanooga Lookouts play the second half champion Birmingham Barons...the Shuckers have never won a Southern League title, the Biscuits last won in 2007, the Lookouts last won in 2017, and the Barons won in 2024.

FALL STARS: The Marlins announced rosters for the Arizona Fall League on Wednesday, with three Blue Wahoos players set to suit up for the Mesa Solar Sox: RHP Carson Milbrandt, OF Fenwick Trimble and RHP Xavier Meachem...the AFL season runs October 6- November 15.

MEACHEM? MEET 'EM: Right-handed pitcher Xavier Meachem joined the Blue Wahoos from High-A Beloit on Tuesday, and made his Double-A debut on Wednesday...he took a blown save and a loss, allowing two ninth-inning runs in a 6-5 defeat...he had spent the entire season with the Sky Carp, going 1-2 with a 2.63 ERA in 34 relief appearances.

NEW-LOOK 'HOOS: 66 different players have suited up for the Blue Wahoos this season...only five players (Evan Fitterer, Jacob Miller, Orlando Ortiz-Mayr, Luis Palacios and Sam Praytor) remain from the Opening Day roster...the team record is 67 different players in the 2019 season, followed by 65 players in 2023, though in each case MLB rehab assignments (5 in 2019, 4 in 2023) inflated their totals.

ALUMNI REPORT: Eight different former Blue Wahoos made their MLB debuts in 2025 (RHP Luarbert Arias-MIA, LHP Patrick Monteverde-MIA, LHP Cade Gibson-MIA, OF Victor Mesa Jr.-MIA, LHP Josh Simpson-MIA, 1B Troy Johnston-MIA, OF Jakob Marsee-MIA, C Will Banfield-CIN)...150 have risen from Pensacola to make their MLB debut since 2012.

IN THE PIPELINE: Pensacola has 2 players on MLB Pipeline's Marlins Top 30 Prospects list: RHP Karson Milbrandt (#18) and RHP Fenwick Trimble (#26).

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Kemp Alderman is second in the Southern League in slugging (.447), third in total bases (184) and triples (5), fourth in OPS (.784), sixth in batting average (.282), tied for sixth in homers (15) and seventh in hits (116)...Josh Ekness is tied for fourth in saves (10), and Evan Fitterer is tied for ninth in wins (7).

TODAY'S START: Alex Williams makes his ninth Double-A start of the season on Sunday, September 14 versus Columbus.

LAST TIME OUT: Williams last pitched for Pensacola on September 1 at Biloxi...took loss (4.0 IP, 7 H, 6 H, 4 ER, 2 BB, 3 K)...departed trailing 6-1, Wahoos lost 6-3...made Triple-A debut on September 7 with Triple-A Jacksonville at Charlotte (4.2 IP, 7 H, 6 ER, 2 BB, 2 K).

AGAINST THE CLINGSTONES: Williams has pitched against Columbus three times this year...combined 2-0 with 0.00 ERA (13.1 IP, 0 ER) across two starts and one relief outing...last pitched against Clingstones on August 19 at Synovus Park (5.0 IP, 5 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 4 K).

WELCOME BACK: Williams joined the Blue Wahoos on May 11 from High-A Beloit...pitched to 3.93 ERA across six appearances (one start) and 18.1 IP with Sky Carp to begin season...in 2024, Williams made two relief appearances with Pensacola to mark his first career games in Double-A.

LAST YEAR: Williams began the year with High-A Beloit...promoted to Double-A Pensacola on June 9, marking Double-A debut...made first career Double-A appearance in relief on June 9 versus Mississippi (3.1 IP, 5 H, 3 ER)...placed on 7-day injured list on June 11, re-assigned to Beloit on July 6...spent remainder of Midwest League regular season with Sky Carp before another promotion to Pensacola on September 14...pitched in Wahoos' season-finale versus Montgomery on September 15 (0.2 IP, 4 ER)...between both High-A and Double-A, posted a combined 5.04 ERA across 25 appearances (9 starts) and 69.2 IP...walked 23, struck out 82.

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Full name is Alexander Dayton Williams...selected by Marlins in 11th round (322nd overall) in 2022 Draft out of Stanford University...named 2022 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year, National Collegiate Baseball Writers' Association All-America Second Team during senior season.
