NEXT STOP FOR THE HESS TRUCK: Yankees No. 5 prospect Ben Hess takes the ball today for Game 1 of the Eastern League Northeast Division Series. Over his last five starts since 8/17 @POR, Hess is 3-0 with a 1.63 ERA (5 ER/27.2 IP) with 35 K, 10 BB, a .151 BAA and 0.87 WHIP. Since making his Double-A debut on 8/6 vs. BNG, Hess ranks among the Eastern League leaders with a .172 BAA, 0.95 WHIP (3rd), 36.2 IP (5th), 41 K (T-6th), and 2.70 ERA (9th).

PATRIOTS PLAYOFF PEDIGREE: The Somerset Patriots have qualified for the Eastern League Playoffs for a fourth consecutive season, joining the Erie SeaWolves as the only other Double-A team to do so. The Patriots' 38 wins are the fewest they've needed to clinch a playoff berth in the four years they've qualified (2022-44, 2023-42, 2024-43).

DOUBLE-A SUBWAY SERIES: The Somerset Patriots and Binghamton Rumble Ponies are meeting in the playoffs for the second time in the last three seasons. In 2023, Somerset won both halves of the season, while Binghamton clinched the second half playoff berth and swept the Northeast Division Series 2-0. This season, Binghamton won both halves of the season, while Somerset clinched the second half playoff berth. Binghamton is the only Northeast Division team all-time to have a winning record against Somerset (38-36).

TOP OF THE HEAP: In five seasons since becoming the Yankees' Double-A affiliate beginning with the 2021 season, the Somerset Patriots have a record of 387-280. Their 387 wins lead all Double-A teams (ERI, 2nd, 380) and rank 6th in all of Minor League Baseball. Over that span, Somerset's 3.67 ERA as a pitching staff ranks 4th in MiLB, and is the lowest of any team in Double-A or Triple-A. Their 6,587 strikeouts also lead all Double-A teams (CHS, 2nd, 6,443). Offensively, in their tenure as the Yankees' Double-A affiliate, the Patriots lead all Double-A teams with 853 HR.

SOMERSETEMBER: Since the start of September, the Somerset Patriots are 9-3, tied for the best record in Minor League Baseball. The Patriots' 2.75 ERA this month is T-3rd lowest at Double-A/Triple-A, while their 1.09 WHIP this month is T-2nd lowest.

FEASTING ON THE NORTHEAST: During the second half, the Somerset Patriots combined to go 19-5 vs. the New Hampshire Fisher Cats and Reading Fightin Phils, making up for half of their 38 second half victories. Over the full season, Somerset has combined to go 13-23 against the three other Eastern League Playoff teams (Binghamton, Erie and Altoona).

THERE GOES MR. JONES: Brendan Jones ended his first full minor league season with 51 stolen bases, becoming the first Yankees minor leaguer to eclipse 50 steals in a season since Anthony Volpe (2022, 50). Over his final 18 games of the season since 8/26 @BNG, Jones went 20-for-68 (.294/.422/.382) with 18 R, 4 2B, 1 3B, 4 RBI, 15 BB, 15 SB and an .804 OPS. Jones leads all players in MLB and MiLB with 13 SB during September (12 games). Since making his Double-A debut on 6/6, Jones leads the Eastern League with six triples, 51 BB and 54 R.

JOORAY FOR JASSO: Dylan Jasso finished the Eastern League season with 76 RBIs to lead all batters. He is the second batter in Somerset Patriots Double-A franchise history to lead the league in RBIs, joining Oswaldo Cabrera (78, 2021). Jasso also ended the season T-2nd in the Eastern League with 123 H and 3rd with 191 TB.

HARDMAN'S HAMMER: On Saturday night, Tyler Hardman crushed his 20th home run of the season, eclipsing 20 HR for the third time in five minor league seasons. Since Hardman debuted in the Yankees organization on 7/29/21, he leads all Yankee minor leaguers with 82 HR and 263 RBI. Over his last 36 games since 8/1 vs. RIC, Hardman is 33-for-125 (.264/.366/.496) with 21 R, 16 XBH (8 2B, 3 3B, 5 HR), 19 RBI, 19 BB, 3 SB and an .862 OPS.

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafter. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.

Named to the Yankees' 2025 Spring Breakout roster, when he was the first reliever used in the game (relieved Carlos Lagrange) in Sarasota against the Orioles. Hess threw 2.0 IP, allowed 1 ER on 2 H, 1 BB and 3 K. Prior to the game, he was recognized by MLB Pipeline for having a 60-grade curveball, tied for the best among all Spring Breakout participants. Broke camp with High-A Hudson Valley for his pro debut, made 15 starts and went 4-3 with a 3.51 ERA over 66.2 IP with 94 K and 33 BB with a .179 BAA and 1.14 WHIP. He made his pro debut on 4/9 @BRK, posted 9 K in 4.2 IP, 0 R on 70 pitches. He took a no-hitter into the 7th inning on 5/8 @WIL, ended going 6.2 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 9 K, the only hit allowed was an infield single off his leg. Over his final five High-A starts from 7/8-8/1, he pitched to a 1.29 ERA (3 ER in 21.0 IP) with 28 K, 5 BB and 12 H for a 0.81 WHIP and .162 BAA. His 12.66 K/9 IP over 15 GS in HV was the highest by any High-A pitcher with 12+ GS. Earned a promotion to Double-A Somerset on 8/5. In seven starts with the Patriots, Hess went 3-1 in 36.2 IP over which he posted a 2.70 ERA, a 0.95 WHIP with 45 K. Hess gave up four hits or fewer in all seven starts and struck out six or more in five of his seven starts. Since he was promoted on 8/6, Hess ranked fourth in the Eastern League in K (45) and fifth in IP (36.2).

College

Over his college career at Alabama (2022-24), Hess posted a 12-6 record and a 4.81 ERA in 33 games (30 starts), while setting Alabama's career K per 9.0 IP record with 13.34 (205 K / 138.1 IP). He missed time in each of his first two college seasons due to injury (right flexor strain in 2023 limited him to seven games).

Grew up a Cubs fan in Moline, far west corner of the state on the border of Davenport, Iowa. Attended Charleston HS (IL), where he was ranked by Perfect Game as the No. 1 RHP in IL and No. 2 overall, No. 71 overall in the 2021 class.

Career Notes

Selected by the Yankees with their first round pick in the 2024 MLB Draft (No. 26 overall) signed for \$2,747,500. Hess was one of 7 straight college pitchers selected by the Yankees to begin the 2024 draft. He is the fifth Alabama Crimson Tide first round pick in MLB/school history (now six players after RHP Riley Quick, MIN, No. 36 in 2025). Other Alabama first round picks include: 1B Joe Vitiello (No. 7, 1991, KC), C Jeremy Brown (No. 25, 2002, OAK), LHP Taylor Tankersley (No. 27, 2004, FLA) and RHP Tommy Hunter (No. 54, 2007, TEX). Hess was the first pitcher taken by the Yankees with their first pick since they took Clarke Schmidt 16th overall in the 2017 MLB Draft.
