Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound tonight, looking to give Andy Tracy his 400th win as manager (will become fourth to achieve the feat). Omaha will counter with LHP **Bailey Falter**. Columbus is 7-16 (.304) versus left handers this year. Falter has pitched against Columbus three times in his career, going 1-0 with a 1.23ERA (7.1IP, 7H, 1R, 1ER, 3BB, 9K).

vs. the Storm Chasers

Columbus has lost 50 of the last 81 regular season games against Omaha, dating to 5/5/22. Of those 81G, the Clippers are 10-47 (.175) when they allow at least four runs to Omaha (3-4 in last 7G), while going 21-3 (.875) when they hold the Storm Chasers to three or fewer. Individually, **CJ Kayfus** has played 14G against Omaha in his career, hitting .333 (17x54) with 1HR and 8RBI.

Funday

From 9/1/24-4/12/26, Columbus was 8-24 on Sundays, posting the worst winning percentage in MiLB (.250). However, the Clippers are 8-2 in the last 10G on Sunday (last Sunday snapped 7G win streak). The last six times the Clippers have entered the final game of a series looking at a 2-3 deficit, they have secured a victory to attain a tie (3-0-7 in last 10 series; last loss was 4/7-4/12 at Worcester).

On the Low

Coming into the series finale, the Clippers have mustered only 14 runs in 5G (scored at least 28 runs in all previous 6G series this year). That low output includes a single homer (solo HR to Juan Brito on Thursday), after collecting at least 3HR in every previous series, including the 3G set at Iowa to start the year. Columbus is hitting .218 (12x55) with RISP this week (46LOB; Omaha is 10x30, 29LOB).

To the Top

Angel Genao is 1x9 with a walk in his first 2G at the leadoff spot with Columbus, having spent his first seven and a half weeks batting between 6-8. Beginning the season in Akron, Genao started every game as the leadoff hitter (.839OPS, including a .446OBP with 22BB in 23G). Genao's walk rate has dipped to 9% in Triple-A (18% in Double-A), but he does own 8BB in his last 55PA (15%).

Brito Slump

Juan Brito is hitting .171/.310/.229 in his last 19G, with a third of his hits coming on 6/13 at Indy (4x5). Thursday's homer was his first since homering in back to back at bats on 5/8 at Iowa (140AB between) and he has 3RBI in the last 19G (27RBI in first 38G). He has not scored more than once in a game since 6/2 vs. Omaha (20G) and his last multi-RBI game was 5/29 at Toledo (23G).

Fourth and One

Ralph Velazquez will be making his 30th start at the cleanup spot tonight (all 36 starts with Akron were #2). His bomb on 6/7 vs. Omaha is the only homer from the #4 Clipper in the last 48G (only team in MiLB without multiple homers since 5/2). While the .361SLG produced in that time ranks 19th in the IL, Columbus cleanup hitters have still managed the 6th best exit velocity (90.9mph).

Another Personal Best

Kody Huff reached on an RBI walk, while also scoring a run Friday night to establish new career highs in on base streak (18G; .382OBP since 6/2), runs (46) and RBI (48). In addition, Huff has already hit top marks in triples (3) and HR (10) this season (one steal from a high; 7SB in 2024). **Ralph Velazquez** a game short of tying his career best with a current 19G on base streak (.378OBP since 6/3).

Left Out

Columbus will face a lefty starter for the fifth time this series, with only five hitters from the left side. On the year, the Clippers have managed a line of .243/.341/.395 off lefties (11th, 13th and 12th in the IL) after hitting .228/.307/.390 last year (20th, 20th and 14th). **Milan Tolentino** is 14x45 (.311) vs. LHP (11x60, .138, last year), but has never homered off LHP in his IL career (30HR vs. RHP).

Frias Feeling It

Dayan Frias is hitting .333 (9x27) in his last 8G, after having gone 2x27 (.074) in his previous 15G (5/6-6/16). Friday was his 100th career game as a Clipper and his 18th in the outfield this year (3G prior to 2026). Frias will be at his natural spot on the infield tonight, while **Milan Tolentino** gets his second professional start in the outfield (**Kody Huff** is catching for the third time in his last 24G).

This Date in Clipper History

6/28/1999

Brian Raabe powered an 8-5 Columbus victory over the Mud Hens in Toledo, going 2x3 with 2 runs, a HR and 4RBI. Raabe's only season with Columbus would prove to be a memorable one, as he hit in a then Clipper record 24 consecutive games. He finished the year tied with his double play partner, SS **D'Angelo Jimenez**, for the team lead in batting at .327. Both would be named to the IL postseason All-Star team.

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,447 to 1,396).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 111-98 (.531) in pitch reviews, with batters going 58-65 (.472) and pitchers/catchers going 53-33 (.616). They have run out of challenges in 36G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 4-3 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 54-36 when playing past regulation (.600, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 90G to require extra play, 71 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 809, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 97 through the first 79G (on pace for 183SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 25CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 4th most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (47; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 121 runs while crafting a .922OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 59 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +62 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 192-124 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,948RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.29 through the first 79G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 174HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 10th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 42G this season (26-16, .619), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino bunted the winning run into scoring position in an extra-inning win at Indianapolis on 6/14. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 88-23 (.793) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 5-2 mark this season (.714, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 2nd most last at bat wins this year (12, Syracuse at 13) while playing in the 2nd most games decided in the last at bat (20; Scranton/WB has played 21). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 94G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 46-48 (.489, 15th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 429-442 (.493), 399-396 with Columbus (.502).

Unfortunate Run:

Prior to 3GS from 4/19-5/1 (14.2IP, 16ER), Avila had only one stretch of consecutive games with at least 5ER in his previous 248G as a professional. That run came with El Paso in 2023, as he surrendered at least 5ER in each of 5G to end April (19.0IP, 27ER). In total, he has given up at least 5ER on 24 occasions, maxing out at 7ER with both Fort Wayne in 2017 and San Diego in 2023.

From the 'Pen:

After 10GS to start the season, Avila began June by pitching in relief on starter's rest. He gave up 3ER in both outings, 6/5 vs. Omaha and 6/11 at Indianapolis, turning in a 7.1ERA (7.0IP, 8H, 8R, 6ER, 2BB, 6K).

Out of Here:

Giving up 9HR in his last 6G (117BF, most in the IL since 5/23), Avila ranks tied for 4th most allowed in the IL this season (14HR to 266BF). Most of that damage has been done at Huntington Park (9HR to 136BF, .574SLG; 5HR to 130BF on the road, .414SLG).

2026 Spring Training:

Avila pitched six times for Cleveland in spring training, turning in a 3.24ERA (8.1IP, 10H, 4R, 3ER, 1BB, 4K). He was released on 3/17, then signed a new minor league deal on 3/22 and assigned to minor league camp.

Last Season:

Pitched for Yakult in Japan... in the Central League (Majors) went 7-8 with a 4.04ERA in 15G (82.1IP, 70H, 41R, 37ER, 30BB, 61K)... in the Eastern League (minors) was 0-1 with a 1.33ERA in 6G (20.1IP, 12H, 3R, 1ER, 12BB, 13K).
