LHP Wes Benjamin (0-1, 7.11) vs. RHP Anthony Molina (0-2, 11.81)

TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque holds a 2-1 series advantage after an 11-8 triumph yesterday afternoon ... Anthony Molina is expected to take the hill for the Isotopes while Wes Benjamin is slated to start for El Paso.

DUKE CITY HR RECORD: Sam Hilliard homered with two outs in the first inning Tuesday, his 79th in an Isotopes uniform – which ties Mike Busch (Dukes, 1993-96) the most in Albuquerque professional baseball history.

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Hilliard has 221 RBI with Albuquerque, which ranks third among career leaders in team history. Jordan Patterson (2016-18) is second with 229 RBI.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard swatted two hits Wednesday, including a double, to extend his on-base streak to 11, every game he's played in 2025. It's tied for the sixth-longest active on-base streak in the Pacific Coast League ... It was his third multi-hit performance of the year.

XBH: Albuquerque compiled eight extra-base hits yesterday, their most since recording nine on Sept. 13, 2024 vs. Las Vegas

THREE-BAGGERS: Aaron Schunk and Jordan Beck tripled for the Isotopes yesterday, making it the club's first game with multiple three-baggers since they had three on Aug. 11, 2024 vs. Sacramento.

FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Isotopes scored in double-digits for the third time in nine home games yesterday ... They also racked up a double-digit amount of hits in consecutive games for the first time since Sept. 12-14, 2024 vs. Las Vegas (three straight).

KEEP IT CLEAN: The Isotopes have 10 miscues for the year. the fifth-fewest among Triple-A teams and fewest in the PCL.

VS. EL PASO: The Isotopes are 13-6 against El Paso all-time in the month of April, including 6-1 at home. They swept a four-game set from April 15-18, 2014, the Chihuahuas' first-ever visit to the Duke City.

DINGERS: The Isotopes hit three home runs off one pitcher (Kolek) for the second time in 2025 yesterday. They also belted a trio against Salt Lake's Mason Erla on April 5 (Zac Veen, Sam Hilliard, Braxton Fulford).

MULTI-HOMER GAME: Luis Campusano blasted two home runs for the Chihuahuas yesterday, the second opposing player to record a multi-homer game against Albuquerque this season (also: Jacob Melton, April 11 at Sugar Land).

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel produced the seventh multihomer game of his professional career yesterday, and first since July 4, 2023, when he belted a pair in a rehab contest against the ACL Diamondbacks ... Has five multi-hit games in 2025

KEST DADDY: Keston Hiura's home run yesterday was his first extra-base hit of the season, in what was his 67th plate appearance. Hiura is 3-for-9 over the last two ballgames after suffering through an 0-for-23 stretch.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson doubled twice yesterday, the fifth time in his pro career with two doubles and first since Aug. 27, 2023 at Somerset. ... Five of his eight hits have gone for extra bases (four doubles and one homer).

PALMA: Ronaiker Palma was 3-for-3 yesterday with a double and walk, and has reached base in eight of 17 plate appearances this year

RITTER: Ryan Ritter was 0-for-3 Thursday, striking out three times in a contest for the third time in 2025 (also: April 4 vs. Salt Lake, April 13 at Sugar Land) ... Is 4-for-25 in last seven games.

MR. VOLUNTEER: Jordan Beck tripled in the eighth inning yesterday, just his second extra-base hit in his last 78 plate appearances. His homer on April 9 at Sugar Land was the only other time he recorded a non-single since doubling on Sept. 17, 2024 vs. Arizona.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk finished 3-for-3 yesterday with a triple and two RBI. It was his first three-hit performance since June 14, 2024 vs. El Paso. Additionally, he laid down a Sacrifice bunt, only the second of his professional career (also: June 23, 2024 at Oklahoma City).

7, 8, 9: The bottom three hitters in Albuquerque's lineup yesterday (Bernabel, Palma, Schunk) all recorded multiple hits in a game for the first time since July 5, 2024 at El Paso (Maclver, Stovall, Carreras).

TURN TWO: Albuquerque turned three double plays yesterday the first time with three DP's since Sept. 15, 2024 vs. Las Vegas, in their home finale.

EL PASO TIES: Veteran first baseman Matt Adams played for the Isotopes on a rehab assignment in 2021, and is El Paso's in 19 total games for the Chihuahuas in 2021 and 2023 ... Albuquerque native **Carlos Olivas** is now the Chihuahuas' head athlatic trainar

Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
