This Day in Baseball

2015 - Alex Rodriguez of the Yankees joins the 3,000 hit club with a 1st-inning homer off Justin Verlander of the Detroit Tigers. He becomes the 29th member of the club, and the third to do so with a long ball, after Wade Boggs and his former teammate Derek Jeter, who had been the last player to collect the milestone hit in 2011.

2019 - One day after fouling a bunted ball in his face during batting practice and breaking his nose, Max Scherzer takes the mound for the Nationals against the Phillies sporting a prominent black eye. He still stymies the opposition with seven scoreless innings in a 2-0 win.

2025 - Fort Wayne defeated Dayton 12-1 at Day Air Ballpark to conclude the first half of the campaign. The 11-run deficit was the largest margin of defeat for the 'Caps in 2025, with right-hander **Miguel Mendez** tossing 5 1/3 innings in his third win of the season.

APPLE SLICES

PACK THE HOUSE: Fort Wayne fans packed Parkview Field Thursday night to round out the first half of the Midwest League season. The 'Caps attendance of 7,901 was the second-largest in all of Minor League Baseball. The second sellout of the season is the largest crowd of the year by over 1,300 people. It was also the largest announced attendance on a non-July 4th Thursday since 2018.

A FRESH SLATE: Friday night's game marks the beginning of the second half of the 2026 Midwest League season. Fort Wayne's last playoff berth came in the second half of the 2023 campaign, with current manager Jonathan Mathews at the helm. The TinCaps finished the 2023 second half with a 37-29 record after being 32-34 in the first half. The postseason all-star team that season featured two 'Caps, Nathan Martorella and Jakob Marsee.

WALK IT OFF: Fort Wayne first baseman **Jack Costello** put a bow on game one of Thursday's doubleheader with a walk-off infield single in the eighth inning. It's the second walk-off winner of the season for Costello, with the other being a three-run homer to defeat Dayton on May 24. The walk-off blast was the first for Fort Wayne since Joshua Mears did so on June 21, 2024, against Wisconsin. The TinCaps had 4 walk-off victories in 2025, three of which were by Brandon Butterworth, including the last, which came on July 30 against Great Lakes.

EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT: The TinCaps played an extra-inning contest for the second time this season in the first game of Thursday's twin bill. It was the team's first win in extra frames this season, with the other instance coming in a loss at home in the series finale against Beloit on May 10.

MIRALLES MAGIC: Fort Wayne right-hander **Maikel Miralles** tossed five scoreless innings in game one on Thursday. Miralles has gone five frames one other time this season, on May 13 on the road against Cedar Rapids. The 20-year-old allowed two hits in his 11th start of the campaign, and his best since he struck out a career-high 9 batters in the home opener on April 7 against Lansing.

SWEET-SWINGING ALEX MCCOY: TinCap outfielder **Alex McCoy** gave Fort Wayne the lead for good with his two-run single in the sixth inning in game two on Thursday. The 2024 undrafted free agent launched his 11th home run of the season in Tuesday's series opener. It was McCoy's first round-tripper since May 29 at Four Winds Field in the 9th inning of a 9-8 comeback win against the Cubs. The No. 19 Padres prospect had not homered in back-to-back series, with the 13-game skid being the longest stretch without a long ball for him this season. McCoy leads the Midwest League in doubles (21) and is tied for the lead in extra-base hits (33). He is also sixth in the league in total bases (118) and 10th in SLG (.529).

THE COMEBACK 'CAPS: Fort Wayne has come from behind in their last nine wins following Tuesday night's doubleheader sweep. The TinCaps split the first three doubleheaders that they played in this season, with the most recent one coming back on May 6 at Parkview Field against Beloit. Fort Wayne now has 18 comeback victories in 2026.

CUNNINGHAM CLOBBERING: TinCap outfielder **Jake Cunningham** hit his 15th home run of the season in game one of Thursday's twin bill, tying him for second in the Midwest League. Cunningham made history when he hit 3 home runs in a game on June 5 against Lake County. He became the fourth player in franchise history to accomplish this feat, being the first to do so since Robert Hassell III did so in 2021. Hassell's was the first by a TinCap since Jonathan Galvez hit three on July 22, 2010, vs. Peoria. The only Wizard to accomplish the feat was Jon Benick (July 3, 2002, vs. Quad Cities).

JACK ATTACK: Fort Wayne first baseman Jack Costello has driven in 3 runs in as many games to begin this series. The 25-year-old is slashing .286/.466/.500 with a .966 OPS against Cub pitching this season in 42 at-bats. Costello has 3 doubles and 2 homers to go with his 13 RBI when facing South Bend this year.

WATERING THE WELL: Fort Wayne center fielder **Kasen Wells** had his team-leading 9-game hit streak come to an end in the second game of Thursday's doubleheader. Wells is hitting .325 in 13 games in June after slashing .310/.400/.379 in 26 May contests. The 2024 16th-round pick is hitting .309 in his last 20 games, while getting on base at a .405 clip in that stretch. Wells has 15 multi-hit games this season and leads the team with 33 walks.

EVANS ELEVATING: Fort Wayne third baseman **Zach Evans** has a hit in 8 of his last 9 games and in 15 of his last 18. Dating back to May 24, Evans is slashing .311/.364/.459 with six doubles (three of which came in the Dayton series last week). The 23-year-old is second in average on the team behind Kasen Wells in this stretch and is tied for the team lead in doubles with Alex McCoy.

DUGIE KEEPS CLIMBING: Fort Wayne third baseman **Rosman Verdugo** hit his tenth home run of the season on Friday, his first round-tripper since last Saturday at Parkview Field against Lake County. The 21-year-old's 3-for-5 showing in the win marks the second time he has picked up 3 hits in a game this season. The other instance came on May 15 against Cedar Rapids, where he also homered. Verdugo now has 24 across his TinCaps career, passing Fernando Tatis Jr. for eighth in career home runs, and is one shy of Tom Knauss (1993-94, 96-97) for seventh. Verdugo is the 10th player in Fort Wayne franchise history to hit the 20-career home run mark. After leading the 'Caps with 13 home runs in 2025, 8 of Verdugo's 10 home runs in 2026 have come on the road.

GOOD WILL HUNTING: TinCap reliever **Will Varmette** picked up the win in the finale of Thursday's twin bill. The righty tossed two hitless and scoreless frames in the victory, his third straight outing not allowing a run in June. Varmette collected his first High-A save last Friday at Day Air Ballpark in his 40th appearance with the club across the last four seasons. The 23-year-old is tied with fellow TinCap bullpen arms Braian Salazar and Clay Edmondson with 22 appearances this season, which tops the Midwest League.

FOURTH OF JULY FIREWORKS: The City of Fort Wayne announced that the top of the Harrison Square parking garage that's attached to Parkview Field in downtown Fort Wayne will be the location for this year's Fourth of July fireworks show on Saturday, July 4. MAKING HISTORY: TinCaps outfielder **Jake Cunningham** tied a franchise record, hitting three home runs on Friday, June 5. **Cunningham is the 4th player in Fort Wayne franchise history to hit three long balls in a contest, being the first to do so since Robert Hassell III did so in 2021.** Hassell's was the first by a TinCap since Jonathan Galvez hit three on July 22, 2010, vs. Peoria. The only Wizard to accomplish the feat was Jon Benick (July 3, 2002, vs. Quad Cities). Cunningham had as many home runs on Friday as he did in 76 games in High-A Aberdeen in 2025 and is now second in the Midwest League with 14. The 23-year-old began the scoring with a three-run home run in the first, then followed it up with a two-run blast in the third, and capped it off with a solo home run in the fifth. The total distance of the three home runs was 1,184 feet, 22.4% of a mile.

- **FROM:** Centerville, IA
- **COLLEGE:** Indian Hills Community College (Iowa) and the University of New Orleans
- **PLAYING CAREER:** Drafted in the 42nd Round of the 1994 MLB Draft by the Colorado Rockies, played one season
- **COACHING CAREER:** Mathews returns to Fort Wayne for his third stint with the organization and second as the team's manager. Began coaching career at the University of Iowa and then in the Minnesota Twins' organization after his playing career. Became the hitting coach for the High-A Fort Myers Miracle in 1997, before managing the rookie-level Elizabethton Twins in 1998 and '99. Returned to alma mater, coaching at Indian Hills and taught economics from 1999-2012 before returning to professional baseball. Mathews coached in the Baltimore Orioles' farm system in 2013, and Arizona Diamondbacks' system from 2014-2016 before joining the Padres organization in 2017 as their major-league outfield coach. He first spent time in Fort Wayne as the TinCaps hitting coach from 2018-2021 before assuming the same role with Triple-A El Paso in 2022. He took over as the Fort Wayne manager in 2023, leading the TinCaps to a second-half east division title and first playoff appearance since 2017. He has spent the last two years as a minor league hitting coordinator.

Pitching Coach

Age: 41

- **FROM:** Maracay, Venezuela
- **SIGNED:** July 19, 2000 (Florida Marlins) as international free agent
- **CAREER:** Made 25 big league appearances, including eight starts across four seasons from 2005 to 2009. He also played 10 seasons in the minor leagues, accruing 1,112 innings pitched and a 3.91 ERA. He ended his playing career in 2017 after multiple seasons away from the states in Venezuela, Mexico, and Italy.
- **COACHING:** Became a pitching coach in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization in 2018, acting as a pitching coach in the DSL before going stateside in 2021. He then joined the Padres organization in 2023 and spent 2025 as the pitching coach for Single-A Lake Elsinore.
- **RELATIONSHIP:** Older brother of Seattle Mariners reliever Eduard Bazardo, who made nine appearances in the playoffs in 2025.

About Parkview Field

- **BACKGROUND:** In 2007, the Fort Wayne City Council approved the Harrison Square Project to build a new ballpark downtown as well as other amenities.
- **DEBUT:** Opening Day for Parkview Field took place on April 16, 2009. The TinCaps played in front of a sold-out crowd and beat the Dayton Dragons 7-0.
- **CAPACITY:** 8,100
- **RECORD CROWD:** 9,508 (July 4, 2019)
- **DIMENSIONS:** 336 feet to the left-field foul pole... 377 feet to left-center field... 400 feet to straight-away centerfield... 383 feet to right-center field... and 318 feet to the right-field foul pole.
- **WALLS:** Range from 10 feet tall, from center to right-center field, up to 15 feet tall in the outfield corners as well as a small section of left-center field.
- **MORE THAN BASEBALL:** Parkview Field hosts hundreds of special events yearly, including concerts such as Florida Georgia Line, Dierks Bentley, Zac Brown Band, and Nelly.
