Binghamton's eighth inning was highlighted by JT Schwartz's RBI walk, Jeremiah Jackson's two-run single, Rowdey Jordan's RBI double, and Mateo Gil's RBI double.

Just Drew It: Outfielder **Drew Gilbert** is riding a four-game hit streak and has recorded three multi-hit games in his last four games. He crushed his first home run as a member of the Mets' organiztion last night with a solo homer in the eighth inning. It was Gilbert's 13th overall home run this season and seventh in Double-A (6 with High-A Asheville, 6 with Double-A Corpus Christi). In 11 games with Binghamton, Gilbert is hitting .326 (14 hits), with a .848 OPS, six RBIs, six runs, a double, triple, and homer.

Action Jackson: Infielder **Jeremiah Jackson** has reached base safely in 11 of his first 12 games with Binghamton. He has 11 RBIs in his first 12 games with the Ponies. Jackson hit a two-run single last night and he singled and walked on Tuesday. He hit a three-run homer on Saturday night, which was his second long ball of the series at Somerset. He crushed his first home run as a member of the Mets' organization on Wednesday, with a go-ahead two-run homer. The former second-round pick in 2018 hit 15 home runs with Double-A Rocket City this year and now has 17 total homers.

Multi-Hit Madness: Five Rumble Ponies hitters recorded multi-hit games last night against Portland. Drew Gilbert led the way with his first three-hit game and fifth multi-hit game with the Ponies. Rowdey Jordan recorded his 17th multi-hit game, JT Schwartz recorded his 13th multi-hit game, Mateo Gil recorded his fourth multi-hit game and Jaylen Palmer recorded his second multi-hit game. Jeremiah Jackson had his third multi-RBI game in 12 games with Binghamton.

On the Farm: Former Rumble Ponies are showing out for the Triple-A Syracuse Mets. Joe Suozzi hit a solo homer, his third at Triple-A, last night in a 7-3 win against Columbus. Brandon McIlwain drove in a run, Carlos Cortes hit his 12th home run of the season and Wyatt Young hit a sacrifice fly. Brett Baty had a hit, Luke Ritter had a hit, Nick Meyer had a hit and scored twice, and Tomas Nido had a hit and a run scored.

Last Start: Moreno allowed seven runs on nine hits over 5.1 innings at Somerset on Friday night. Moreno allowed a two-run home run to Josh Breaux and three-run homer and RBI double to Ben Rice.

Moreno against Portland: In three starts against Portland, Moreno is 1-1 with a 6.57 ERA: 12.1 IP, 11 H, 9 ER, 7 BB, 20 K. In his lone home start against the Sea Dogs, Moreno earned the win with 6 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, and career-high 10 K.

2022: Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and went 4-0 with a 2.68 ERA in nine appearances and three starts. Was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on June 1, 2022, where he went 4-7 with a 2.92 ERA. He tallied 70 strikeouts in 77.0 innings for Brooklyn and totaled 107 strikeouts across the two levels in 2022.

BACKGROUND: Was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for his two appearances at Akron in June. Signed with the Mets as an international free agent on June 8, 2019. Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.
