ENCARNACION, ALCANTARA LEAD 7-0 WIN

Jerar Encarnacion blasted two home runs and drove in a career-high six and Sandy Alcantara dazzled over 4.0 innings in a rehab start as Jacksonville blanked Nashville 7-0. The Jumbo Shrimp jumped out to a huge lead in the first inning. Jordan Groshans walked with the bases loaded and Encarnacion followed with a grand slam to make it 5-0. The score remained that way until the eighth, when Encarnacion smacked a two-run shot to widen the gap to 7-0. Alcantara ceded only one hit in his four innings, and Jacksonville's bullpen completed the fifth shutout of the year.

THE EAGLE HAS LANDED IS STRANDED

Jacksonville has stranded 29 runners on-base in 27 offensive innings thus far in their series in Nashville, going just 6-for-30 (.200) with runners in scoring position during these two games and exacerbating a huge issue of late for the club. Over the last 24 games, the Jumbo Shrimp have stranded 171 runners, an average of 7.1 per game, mainly by hitting a woeful 39-for-193 (.202) with runners in scoring position. Jacksonville has had multiple hits with runners in scoring position in just 10 of these 24 games, with more than two hits over these situations in only six affairs of this stretch.

ODDS & ENDS ON 2023

After five straight losing seasons from 2015-2019, Jacksonville earned consecutive winning campaigns in 2021 and 2022. However, with three games remaining in the 2023 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are sitting at a 70-76 (.479) record, unable to record its third straight winning season. The Jumbo Shrimp also finished the 2023 home slate with a 35-39 (.473) record. The last time Jacksonville suffered a losing home record was in 2018, when they went 27-41 (.397).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

From Opening Day through August 15, 61 of Jacksonville's 114 games (53.5 percent) were decided by three runs or fewer. However, in the 32 games since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have played 22 affairs (68.8 percent) determined by no more three runs. Over these last 32 games, Jacksonville has posted a 9-13 (.409) record in these narrowly decided affairs. In comparison, through August 15, the Shrimp were 30-31 (.492) in contests decided by three runs or fewer.

'PFN PALS

Over the last month-plus, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 38 games the club has played since August 8. Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 67 runs. 56 earned, on 124 hits (8.0 H/9) in 139.2 innings for a 3.61 ERA. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp relief corps has combined to strike out 160 batters (10.3 K/9) against 87 walks (5.6 BB/9).

BROKEN BATS

Since beginning a series with Charlotte on August 29, the Jumbo Shrimp offense has been mired in a massive slump. Jacksonville has scored three runs or fewer in 14 of their last 21 games. Moreover, the club has mustered a meager .209/.312/.303/.615 batting line as a team, figures that respectively rank 29th, 28th, 30th and 30th in Triple-A during this stretch. Not coincidentally, the Jumbo Shrimp's 67 runs (3.2 per game) also rank last in Triple-A during this span. Despite getting outscored 78-67. Jacksonville has posted a 10-11 record during this stretch. Eight of those 10 victories have been decided by three runs or fewer

ROAD RAGE

From 2015-19, Jacksonville failed to post a winning record on the road in any campaign from, going a combined 137-210 (.395). However, upon joining the Triple-A level in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp's road fortunes rapidly improved. In 2021 and 2022, the club posted a combined mark of 81-58 (.583) on the road. However, in 2023, Jacksonville has registered a 35-37 (.486) mark away from 121 Financial Ballpark. Interestingly, while the club has posted nearly identical OPS' at home (.749) vs. on the road (.752) in 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp have pitched much better at home. At home, Jacksonville has allowed the sixth-fewest runs (365) in the IL with a 4.56 ERA. On the road, the club has ceded the thirdmost runs (434) in the league with a 5.67 ERA.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville recorded its fifth shutout of the season, and second in the last four games, on Thursday at Nashville. Three of those five shutouts have come in the month of September... Jordan Groshans has reached base in 13 of his last 16 plate appearances, going 6-for-9 with three RBIs and seven walks over the last three games.

ABOUT DANIEL

-Castano was included by the St. Louis Cardinals along with right-handers Sandy Alcantara, and Zac Gallen and outfielder Magneuris Sierra on December 14, 2017 in a trade with the Miami Marlins for outfielder Marcell Ozuna.

-Castano was originally selected by St. Louis in the 19th round of the 2016 draft out of Baylor.

-A product of Lake Travis High School, one of Castano's teammates in high school was Baker Mayfield, formerly the quarterback of the Cleveland Browns. Castano threw a no-hitter in the District 4A playoff series against Crockett in 2013.

-Castano starred at Baylor University, earning All-Big 12 Honorable Mention in 2015, as well as a spot on the 2014 Big 12 All-Freshman Team. That 2015 season saw Castano post a 3.48 ERA, the 25th-lowest in school history. He tied for first on the team in strikeouts (45) and wins (four), while finishing second in innings pitched (77.1).

2023 SEASON

-Placed on the 7-day IL on April 17 and missed 63 games before being reinstated on June 28.

2022 SEASON

-Castano began the season with Miami but was optioned to Jacksonville on April 28.

2021 SEASON

-In his final start of 2021, Castano no-hit Gwinnett for 7.0 innings before yielding a leadoff single to Chadwick Tromp in the eighth. He ultimately ceded two hits in 8.0 shutout frames.

-Castano made four starts with the Marlins before being optioned on May 9 to Jacksonville.

2020 SEASON

-Castano made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 8, 2020 at the New York Mets' Citi Field in Queens.

-After posting a 4.11 ERA in his first four starts (15.1 IP, 16 H, 8 BB, 8 K), Castano went 1-0 with a 1.88 ERA over his final three outings, including two starts (14.1 IP, 14 H, 3 BB, 4 K).

2019 SEASON

-Castano began the season with High-A Jupiter before earning a promotion on May $28\ \text{to}$ Jacksonville.

-The left-hander worked a minimum of 6.0 innings in each of his six starts from July 15 through August 16. During that span, Castano went 5-0 with a 1.73 ERA in 41.2 innings. He whiffed 40 against three walks and 26 hits against.

-Castano majored in pre-business at Baylor University.
