Looking Back

Reading fell 5-2 on Sunday to New Hampshire to finish the week with a 1-5 record. Josh Hendrickson started for Reading and went six innings, and allowed three-earned runs. Cody Roberts hit a solo home run in the fifth and Madison Stokes knocked in the other run with a single that plated Oliver Dunn in the sixth. The Fightin Phils bullpen was strong, as the group combined to pitch three innings, allow no runs, and just one walk and one hit a piece.

A Strong Week

Baron Radcliff and Oliver Dunn each turned in strong weeks for Reading against New Hampshire. Radcliff hit .286 with two home runs and an OPS of 1.161. His two home runs traveled 409 and 427 feet respectively on Wednesday and Thursday. In the middle four games of the series last week, Dunn 5-15 (.333) overall with two extra base hits. He had an OPS of .750 for the series.

Reading's defense have been double play machines as of late. Over the last 30 days, the R-Phils have turned 24 double plays, which ranks tied for second in the Eastern League. Last week, they turned eight, which was most in the league. After sitting in the bottom of the league in double plays turned most of the season, the R-Phils now sit tied for seventh in the league with 90 double plays in 2023.

Parkinson Continues to Roll

It was another quality start Saturday night for David Parkinson as he went six-strong frames. Dating back to July 7, Parkinson now owns a 6-1 record with 1.73 ERA over ten starts. His Eastern League ranks now stand at the following after last night: ERA (4th), Wins (T5th), Strikeouts (T7th), IP (T3rd), BAA (T7th), WHIP (8th) and Winning Percentage (T4th).

The Phillies defeated San Diego 9-7 last night to win their second-stragiht game as Trea Turner hit another home run. Lehigh Valley begins a big six-game series tonight at Buffalo as the IronPigs sit tied for first place in the International League second half standings. Jersey Shore begins its final series of the regular season at Hudson Valley as the BlueClaws are tied for a playoff spot and hold the tiebreaker. Clearwater kicks off their final regular season series at Palm Beach as the Threshers begin the playoffs next week after winning the first half division title.

Thompson allows 4 hits, walks none and strikes out 7 in his final start of the regular season. Rene Garcia accounts for most of the offense, going 3-for-4 with an RBI and run scored.

Welcoming the Dogs

Portland enters tonight with a 28-29 record in the second half, which is third in the Northeast Division and five-games back of Binghamton. Overall, the SeaDogs are 68-58 after narrowly missing out on the first half title. Last week, Portland won two-of-six against Somerset and close the regular season against Hartford at home next week. Portland has the following Red Sox top prospects on its team: Marcelo Mayer (1), Nick Yorke (6), Wikelman Gonzalez (9), Blaze Jordan (12), Nathan Hickey (15), Angel Bastardo (16) and Chase Meidroth (20).

CJ Liu gets the start tonight for Portland. It will be his fourth start of the season against Reading, and the previous three have not fared well for him. Against the R-Phils, Liu is 0-3 with a 9.45 ERA (13.1 IP, 14 H, 14 ER, 10 BB, 19 SO), Overall in 2023, Liu is 5-7 with a 5.47 ERA across 23 starts (103.2 IP, 105 H, 55 BB, 129 SO). Last time out, Liu went four innings in a no decision against Somerset on Wednesday last week. He allowed two hits, two runs, four walks and four strikeouts. Liu split 2022 between High-A Greenville and Portland, going 4-11 with a 6.06 ERA over 26 games. In 2021, Liu began his pro career between the FCL Red Sox and Single-A Salem. Boston signed Liu in 2019 as an International Free Agent out of Taiwan.
