**ABOUT LAST NIGHT...** The Vancouver Canadians couldn't handle the high-powered Everett AquaSox (Mariners) Saturday night, as they trailed early and came up short in a 12-4 loss Saturday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

Everett, who leads all of Advanced-A in nearly every offensive category, scored three runs on three hits in the top of the first against starter Sam Ryan (L, 0-2) and only added on from there.

The Canadians answered with two runs in the bottom of the first thanks to a hit by pitch, singles by Phil Clarke and Cameron Eden, an error and a Spencer Horwitz sacrifice fly that made it 3-2, but that would be the closest they would get.

The AquaSox pulled away for good in the top of the second with a pair of runs and would score another in the fourth, three in the fifth and three in the seventh for 12 runs on 13 hits.

Vancouver mustered single runs in two more innings. Eden doubled with one out, went to third on a passed ball and scored on a Horwitz ground out in the third frame, and singles from Eden and Horwitz in the sixth put men on base before a double play brought home their final tally of the night.

**FEELING FROGGY:** Everett returns to Hillsboro this week for their second series of the season with Vancouver. The 'Sox last hopped into town May 25-30 when the C's split a six-game set. The Mariners affiliate has been ranked as one of the most prospect-laden rosters in all of baseball and have lived up to that billing; they have outscored the Canadians 71-45 this season and have plated a league-best 267 runs.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ON THIS DATE IN BASEBALL HISTORY:** June 20, 2004 - On Father's Day with his dad in attendance, 34-year-old Ken Griffey, Jr. blasts a sixth-inning Matt Morris fastball over the right-field wall at Busch Stadium for his 500th career home run. The Reds' center fielder becomes the twentieth major leaguer and the sixth youngest to reach the milestone.

**UNCLE:** Everett has scored 21 runs on 25 hits in the last two games.

**FAVORITE SONS:** The Canadians lead the Blue Jays system in winning percentage (.561), stolen bases (65), on-base percentage (.344) and batting average against (.219).

**PRAISE BE:** Vancouver is perfect 6-0 on Sundays this season.

**GO DEEP:** The C's are 11-6 when they hit at least one home run but are 12-12 when they're kept in the ballpark.

**START HOT:** The Canadians have scored 40 runs int eh first inning this season, the most in any frame.

**HE'S GOING STREAKING:** With three hits last night, Cameron Eden has now recorded a hit in eight consecutive games to match a team high.

**ON THE HILL:** Paxton Schultz climbs the hill for Vancouver tasked with leading the C's to a series split this afternoon. In his last turn on June 13 in Spokane, his string of three consecutive quality starts came to an end when he gave up a season-high six runs on five hits in four innings pitched. Schultz walked a season-high four and struck out a season-low three that night. The former Utah Valley standout has otherwise been the most consistent arm in the rotation this year and leads the team in strikeouts (39).

MLB.com's #5 Mariners prospect George Kirby will go for Everett. In his last turn on June 12 against Eugene, Kirby earned the win with five innings in which he allowed one run on four hits with no walks and three strikeouts. The 20<sup>th</sup> overall pick in the 2019 draft out of Elon, Kirby made his pro debut with Everett in 2019. The right-hander has yet to face the Canadians this year.
