ABOUT LAST SUNDAY: Brooklyn wrapped up the series with Greensboro with a 5-1 victory over the Pittsburgh affiliate to win the series and take four out of six games in Coney Island. On the mound, RHP **Junior Santos** allowed one run over six innings, while LHP **Nick Zwack** earned the save with three scoreless. Offensively, OF **Stanley Consuegra** went 3-for-5 with a double, a home run, and two runs scored. OF **Jaylen Palmer** delivered the lead with a two-run single in the bottom of the fourth. Greensboro used eight pitchers to cover the eight innings of the game.

WE'RE BACK: After the All-Star Break, the Cyclones head down to New Jersey for a three-game series. The four-day break was used as a short break in the minor leagues without an actual all-star game.

CONGRATS FELLAS: RHP **Garrison Bryant** and C **Matt O'Neill** were both promoted to Double-A Binghamton and join the team in upstate New York to start a series with Hartford at Mirabito Stadium. In two corresponding moves, the Mets promoted C **Juan Loyo** and INF **Gregory Guerrero** from Low-A St. Lucie. Guerrero is the nephew of Vladimir Guerrero and the cousin of Vladdy Jr.

CARSON COLLECTS 11 Ks: RHP **Carson Seymour** struck out 11 batters last Friday night against Greensboro, becoming the ninth pitcher in Brooklyn Cyclones history to fan 11 batters. It's the first time a Cyclones arm has struck out 11 hitters since 2016 when LHP **Thomas Szapucki** achieved the feat on August 6th at Tri-City. That year, three Cyclones struck out 11 batters between July 23-August 6: RHP **Nabil Crismatt** vs. Aberdeen, RHP **Harol Gonzalez** at Vermont, and LHP **Thomas Szapucki** at Tri-City.

CON SWAGGER: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has had a dominant start to his Brooklyn career, collecting eight doubles in 12 games with 10 RBIs.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies High-A farm club has the worst record in the league at 31-55 which is also one of the worst records in MiLB. Brooklyn has won 13 of the 18 games of the season series. The BlueClaws are home to eight of the Top 30 Prospects in the Philadelphia system. No. 1 RHP Andrew Painter and No. 2 RHP Mick Abel lead the pitchers while No. 6 OF Ethan Wilson leads the position players.

NIC KNOWS: C **Nic Gaddis** has enjoyed a power play stretch at the plate, homering four times in his past 15 games with a .522 slugging percentage. Since June 21, Gaddis has a .424 OBP and a .946 OPS, reaching in 20 of his past 22 games.

PEROZA POP: INF **Jose Peroza** has collected 33 total bases in his past 16 games with four doubles, one triple, and three home runs.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 43 home runs in the past 53 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

MLB DRAFT: This past week the Mets selected 22 new players in the 2022 MLB Draft, including five picks in the Top 90. The Mets selected No. 11 C **Kevin Parada** from Georgia Tech and No. 14 SS **Jett Williams** from Rockwall-Heath High School in Texas.

WELCOME TO HIGH-A: Carson Seymour makes his eighth High-A start today, facing Jersey Shore for the third time.

OKKKKKKKKKKK: In his last start against Greensboro last Friday, Seymour struck out 11 hitters. It's the first time a Cyclones are has struck out 11 hitters since 2016.

ST LUCIE STALWART: Seymour began his season with Low-A St. Lucie, tossing four consecutive scoreless outings. He finished his Florida State League experience with a victory over the Yankees affiliate in Tampa, striking out a career-high eight batters over 5 1/3 innings.

K-STATE: The 6-foot-5 righty transferred to Kansas State after one year at Darmouth, sitting for the 2019 season due to NCAA transfer rules before pitching for two seasons in the Big 12 Conference.

GOOD COMPANY: Seymour's college teammate at Kansas State, RHP Jordan Wicks, was selected 21st overall by the Chicago Cubs and signed for \$3.1 million.

DYNAMIC DAD: Carson's father Brian was a professional tri-athlete (swimming, biking, running), finishing the Hawaii Ironman competition four times.

FROM MANHATTAN (KS) TO QUEENS: Seymour was selected in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets and signed for \$291K. The last time the Mets selected a player directly from Kansas State, they drafted 2013 Brooklyn Cyclones OF Jared King who reached as high as Double-A Binghamton.
