where he struck out a career-high five in five innings. Connor Oliver struck out six in four innings to complete the shutout and record a save. Esmerlyn Valdez and Solomon Maguire paced the Marauders offense, each collecting two hits.

> BLANKED: In an 8-0 victory over the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels on Thursday, the Marauders pitching staff hurled their third shutout of the season with the other two coming against the Clearwater Threshers. The three shutouts are tied for the third most in the FSL, trailing the Daytona Tortugas who have five. Bradenton finished with seven shutouts last season, the fourth-most in FSL.

> FINDING THEIR GROOVE: Since April 17, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff owns the second-best ERA in the Florida State League at 2.58, only trailing the Daytona Tortugas who sport a 2.05 ERA. It's the third-best ERA in Single-A during this span, with the Carolina Mudcats (Single-A, MIL) in

> HE GETS ON BASE: INF Garret Forrester has reached base in 11 straight games in which he's collected a hit in nine of his those 11 contests. Over this span, Forrester is hitting .417 (15-for-36) with 4 doubles, a HR, 6 RBIs, 6 walks, and 6 runs. It's currently the longest active on-base streak for the Marauders with Forrester raising his season batting average from .139 to .261. The former Oregon State Beaver has also recorded five multi-hit games in this span with the highlight being a 3-for-3 night at the plate versus Fort Myers on Tuesday night.

> HEATING UP: Over the last five games, Esmerlyn Valdez is hitting .389/.450/.611 with four doubles, three RBIs, and one walk while also reaching base in seven straight contests. Valdez leads the Marauders with six doubles on the year and a .271 AVG

> A GOOD DAY ATTHE OFFICE: RHP Tyler Kennedy set a new career-high, striking out six batters in two scoreless innings of relief on Wednesday night against Fort Myers. The six strikeouts were also the most by a Marauders reliever this season until Connor Oliver matched that total the next night on Thursday.

> IN HIS GROOVE: With another scoreless outing on Tuesday night, LHP Hunter Furtado has extended his season-long scoreless streak to 5.2 innings. Over his last three outings, the 2023 Sixth-Round pick has struck out seven and walking one while allowing just three hits.

> ROSTER MOVE: Priot to Tuesday's contest, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced OF Joshua Palacios was to begin his Minor League rehab assignment with the Bradenton Marauders. Palacios was acquired in the Minor League Rule 5 Draft by the Pirates in Dec. 2022. He went on to appear in 9 year for the Buccos, hitting .239 AVG with 10 HR and 40 RBIs. He was originally drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft. Palacios spent almost the entire season with the Dunedin Blue Jays in 2018 where he was named a Post-Season All-Star. In 125 games, the left-handed hitter slashed .292/.357/.418 with 30 doubles, 8 HR, 78 RBIs while stealing 15 bases.

> CLOSE QUARTERS: Saturday night's loss marked their 10th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 3-7 record in those games with 18 of their first 24 (75.0%) games having been decided by three runs or less. In last week's series against Clearwater, all six games were by a total of eight runs. The series featured four-one run contests with another two decided by two runs each.

> GOT EM!: Hunter Furtado picked off Aidan Miller in the sixth inning on Saturday night for the Marauders eighth pickoff of the season. As of Friday, the Marauders currently sit tied for second in all of Mil B only trailing the Hudson Valley Renegades (High-A, NYY) and Fredericksburgh Nationals (Single-A,
