This Evening: The Lugnuts play a doubleheader in opening a six-game series tonight at the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the only six meetings between the two clubs this season as well as Lansing's only road trip at a West Division team this season. Lansing is coming off a six-game series split at home against the Great Lakes Loons, the Nuts' sixth split in seven series played this year.

On Deck: The Nuts and Kernels play night games through Saturday and a matinee on Sunday before Lansing returns home for a six-game series vs. the Dayton Dragons concluding on the 4th of July.

On the Air: Tonight's games are on MiLB.TV with Chris Kleinhans-Schulz on the call of the game, streaming online at <a href="http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing">http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing</a>, with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler.

Last Game, Sunday: Loons 7, Lugnuts 1. Pitching in relief, Lansing right-hander Stevie Emanuels set a new single-game franchise record with four home runs allowed, serving up roundtrippers to Deacon Liput and Andy Pages in the 3rd inning, and then again to Liput and Pages in the 4th inning, as Great Lakes cruised to victory in the series finale. In the loss, Lugnuts second baseman Ryan Gridley made his second scoreless appearance in relief this season, tossing 1 2/3 perfect innings and stranding the bases loaded in the 8th. Right-hander Leudeny Pineda enjoyed a successful debut in a no-decision, tossing two scoreless innings, but the Lugnuts' offense was held to just a trio of singles by six Loons pitchers.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

#### Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes

Alumni Report: 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., leads the Majors in OBP (.441), OPS (1.109), total bases (171) and slugging percentage (.668); is tied for 1st in home runs (23) and RBIs (60); and ranks 2nd in batting average (.340). Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette leads the Majors in runs scored (60).

Whither Weather: Yesterday's rainout marked the first time that the Lugnuts had a game affected by weather this season, whether in a rain delay or in a postponement or cancelation.

Man of Steal: Speaking of infielder Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University), he leads all of Minor League Baseball with 29 stolen bases, one more than South Bend's Delvin Zinn, and nine more than the Major League leader, Kansas City's Whit Merrifield. Schuemann is tied for second in the Minors with 12 HBPs and is second in the High-A Central with 35 runs scored.

A Bruising Series: The just-completed series against the Great Lakes Loons saw a total of 16 HBPs in six games, with Lugnuts batters getting struck by six pitches and Loons batters getting hit 10 times by Nuts hurlers, including Andy Pages three times in one game. Entering the series, Lansing had only plunked 22 batters in the first 36 games.

Hail to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.74 earned run average with the second fewest walks in the league (136) and third most strikeouts (435). The Nuts' success has led to the promotion of the team's top two relievers to Double-A, Jack Weisenburger and Aiden McIntyre.

Indicator of Success: When the Nuts outhit the opposition, they are 14-1 this season. When they get outhit, they are 3-20, with two of the wins coming last series vs. Great Lakes

So Many Starters: With Bryce Nightengale's start in Game 1 tonight, the Lugnuts will have now used 13 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

#### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2016:** In the opening game of the second half, Ryan Borucki struck out eight in eight innings, and the Lugnuts beat the West Michigan Whitecaps, 5-1, at Cooley Law School Stadium.

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Record-Setting, for Better or Worse: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons. On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three home runs served up in a game by giving up four homers to the Loons.

Familiar Settings: 10 of the 28 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut to hail from Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti. Earlier this season, the Nuts featured two Michigan Wolverines in Jeff Criswell (injured) and Jack Weisenburger (promoted).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg are all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 17 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

**Teammates Then, Teammates Now:** Several of the Nuts are more than a little familiar with one another. **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons; though **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year, Peluse hosted Simoneit on his visit and convinced him to attend Wake. Coincidentally, Peluse was hosted on his own Wake Forest college visit by 2019 Lugnuts infielder **Johnny Aiello**.





**Last Outing:** Appeared in relief in Lansing's most recent game: on Sunday, June 20 vs. Great Lakes, entering in the 7th and working 1 1/3 innings, allowing two runs on two hits, four walks and two HBPs, striking out two, before departing with the bases loaded... infielder Ryan Gridley relieved and stranded the bases loaded in a 7-1 Lugnuts loss.

#### 2021:

- After walking only five batters in his first 14 1/3 innings in the month of May, has walked four batters in three separate appearances in June... in total, has walked 13 and struck out 16 in 10 innings this month.
- 1.88 ERA in May (14 1/3 IP, 5 R, 3 ER) compared to 7.20 ERA in June (10 IP, 10 R, 8 ER).
- Two strongest, longest appearances were both vs. Great Lakes: May 29 3 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K, and June 16 3 IP, 3 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 6 K... has not pitched longer than three innings this season.
- Slashline vs. left-handers: .278/.409/.315... slashline vs. right-handers: .209/.358/.302.
- Has allowed four successful stolen bases in seven attempts.

**Personal:** Father Tim played basketball at Allegany CC and nearby Frostburg State, while sister Madi (short for Madison) played basketball at Allegany College of Maryland... father Tim is the celebrated head coach of boys soccer at Mountain Ridge H.S., winning 2010, 2011 and 2019 Maryland state titles... loves basketball in addition to hunting and fishing, playing four years of basketball in high school... coached in pitching growing up by longtime Chicago White Sox MiLB coach J.R. Perdew... chose George Mason over Miami (OH), Penn State, James Madison, Shippensburg and Frostburg State.

High School Feats: Honored with 2014 Skip Cook Memorial Award as the Player of the Year for the area... went 8-0 with a 1.30 ERA as a senior, batting .438, to lead the Allegany Campers to a 19-2 record (after the Campers finished as the state runner-up in his junior year)... named First Team All-Area in basketball as well, with the Campers finishing 24-2 and state runner-up in 2014... four years later, became the first Allegany pitcher/Player of the Year drafted since Aaron Laffey (16th round, 2003, Cleveland).

College Days: Did not play his freshman year at George Mason... made 10 appearances, five starts, as a redshirt freshman (10.86 ERA, 32 1/3 IP, 43 H, 43 R, 39 ER, 28 BB, 13 K)... 15 appearances, eight starts, as a redshirt sophomore (6.95 ERA, 45 1/3 IP, 55 H, 44 R, 35 ER, 26 BB, 29 K)... improved to 3.45 ERA in 15 starts as a redshirt junior (88 2/3 IP, 83 H, 32 BB, 80 K).

**Professional Report:** Debuted in 2018 with one appearance in the AZL followed by a season spent in the Vermont Lake Monsters' bullpen... opened 2019 working as a piggyback tandem with Adam Reuss for the Beloit Snappers, the No. 2 tandem in the Beloit starting rotation... allowed five steals in eight attempts... limited left-handers to .208 average in Midwest League (albeit with .356 OBP) compared to right-handers hitting .259 (with .365 OBP).

Hometown: Cresaptown, Md., is unincorporated, located in the western panhandle of Maryland very near to both West Virginia to the south and Pennsylvania to the north, with Cumberland, located to the northeast, the largest nearby city... Cresaptown is named for the family of Daniel Cresap, early colonizers of the area... Athletics great Lefty Grove hailed from nearby Lonaconing... others from the area include Leo Mazzone (Keyser, WV), Sam Perlozzo (Cumberland) and William H. Macy, who attended Allegany H.S.

**Last Outing:** Made Lugnuts debut on June 15, starting the series opener vs. Great Lakes... gave up a second-inning two-run double to Justin Yurchak but that was it: 4 1/3 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 5 K... removed after walking James Outman, yielding to Brady Basso with runners at 1st and 2nd and one out... Basso stranded the runners... Lugnuts went on to win, 9-7, with two runs in the bottom of the 7th.

#### 2021:

- Began the season with Stockton, appearing in relief on Opening Day, May 4 at Modesto, and tossing three scoreless innings.
- First three appearances with the Ports were all in relief, totaling 7 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 12 K.
- Received first start in series opener at Visalia, May 18: 4 IP, 4 H, 3 R (2 ER), 0 BB, 4 K.
- Worked six innings apiece in final two starts with Stockton, June 1 vs. Lake Elsinore (3 H, 0 R, 1 HBP, 0 BB, 5 K) and June 8 vs. San Jose (8 H, 3 R, 2 HR, 0 BB, 3 K.
- In all, walked just 1 batter of 106 total batters faced in the High-A West, spanning 26 2/3 innings
- Joined the Lugnuts on June 15 with relief ace Jack Weisenburger's promotion to Double-A Midland
