**LEBLANC, FORTES LEAD JUMBO SHRIMP TO WIN**  
Charles Leblanc had three hits and three RBIs and Nick Fortes homered and scored twice Friday in Jacksonville's 7-4 win over Charlotte. Carlos Perez opened up the scoring with a two-run shot in the first. Fortes' solo shot came in the second, but Dwight Smith Jr. homered for the Knights to go up 3-1. Leblanc notched a two-run double to tie in the fourth and followed a two-run JJ Bleday two-bagger with an RBI single in the fifth inning that put the Jumbo Shrimp ahead. Matthew Kent yielded just one run in 5.2 strong innings of relief.

### A (NEAR) PERFECT 10

The Jumbo Shrimp have won 10 of the past 13 games, outscoring their opponents during this stretch by a whopping 86-56 margin and compiling a 135-106 advantage in hits and 20-9 margin in home runs. Since this roll began on April 15, the Jumbo Shrimp are hitting .291/.372/.484/.856 as a team and rank tied for third out of 120 Minor League Baseball teams in hits, tied for seventh in runs and tied for eighth in home runs.

### TO THE MAX

Max Meyer makes the start on Saturday at Charlotte, and the University of Minnesota product is hoping to continue an outstanding beginning to his season. Among the 146 pitchers in the International League with at least 10.0 innings pitched this season, Meyer owns the circuit's second-highest swinging-strike rate (19.5 percent), helping him strike out 36.0 percent of opposing hitters thus far, a figure that ranks seventh in the IL, and post a 29.3 K-BB%, which ranks sixth. When opponents do put the ball in play, Meyer has registered the IL's 13th-highest ground ball rate (60.0 percent) and 14th-lowest fly ball rate (22.5 percent). Consequently, Meyer is third in the league in xFIP (2.45) while placing fourth in FIP (1.69) and 29th in ERA (1.83).

### SIX & DIP

Heading into play on Saturday, Jacksonville has scored at least six runs in nine of their last 14 games, and 11 of the club's 22 contests this year. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered at least six tallied in only 48 of their 130 games (36.9 percent). When scoring at least six runs this year, Jacksonville is 9-2.

### CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Charles Leblanc went 3-for-4 with a double and three RBIs on Friday, continuing a fantastic start to 2022. The Laval, Quebec City native has already reached base multiple times in 10 of his 18 games this year. On the season, Leblanc ranks third in the International League in batting average (.364), fourth in on-base percentage (.442), seventh in OPS (1.048), tied for eighth in hits (24), ninth in slugging (.606) and tied for 13th in RBIs (16). Among the 132 qualified hitters in the circuit, Leblanc also places fourth in both wOBA (.456) and wRC+ (178).

### THIS CUBAN IS CRUSHING MISSILES

Over his last nine games, Lorenzo Quintana has gone 15-for-39 at the plate, slashing .385/.442/.821/1.263 with five doubles, four home runs, 13 RBIs and nine runs scored. This hot stretch has pushed Quintana up the International League leaderboards on the season; the native of Pinar del Rio in Cuba ranks in the top 15 of the league in batting average (7th; .333), slugging (7th; .638), RBIs (T-7th; 17), home runs (T-8th; 5), extra-base hits (T-9th; 11), OPS (10th; 1.011) and hits (T-15th; 23). Of the 132 qualified hitters in the International League, Quintana has posted the 12th-lowest strikeout rate (13.3 percent). He places 10th in both wOBA (.432) and wRC+ (163).

### THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 30 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking fourth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast in recent years; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers. Heading into play on Saturday, the Jumbo Shrimp have homered in seven consecutive games, their best such streak of the young season.

### SHRIMP SPECK

Erik González leads the IL in average (.395) while ranking tied for first in hits (30), tied for ninth in doubles (8), 11th in on-base percentage (.420) and 15th in OPS (.946).

### ABOUT MAX

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortened season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.
