Position Description

Bat Person

Summary Bat people are responsible for assisting the clubhouse attendant with any clubhouse related duties, making dugout/bullpen coolers, setting up dugouts and bullpens prior to game time, breaking down dugouts and bullpens after games, etc. Primary duties include retrieving bats, balls and providing assistance to umpires and coaches when needed. Bat people normally report two hours and 15 minutes before game time and stay at least 30 minutes after game concludes.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following: assisting clubhouse attendant. Making dugout and bullpen coolers as well as setting up dugouts and bullpens. Retrieving bats and foul balls. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. Other duties may be assigned.

Qualifications To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Must be at least 16 years of age, prior batboy experience preferred.

Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to use hands to finger, handle, or feel and talk or hear. The employee is frequently required to reach with hands and arms. The employee is frequently required to stand; walk; sit and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. The employee must frequently lift and /or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision and ability to adjust focus.

Work Environment

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to outside weather conditions, which may include heat, cold and various forms of precipitation. The employee is occasionally exposed to moving mechanical parts. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.

Hours vary according to the game and event schedule.
